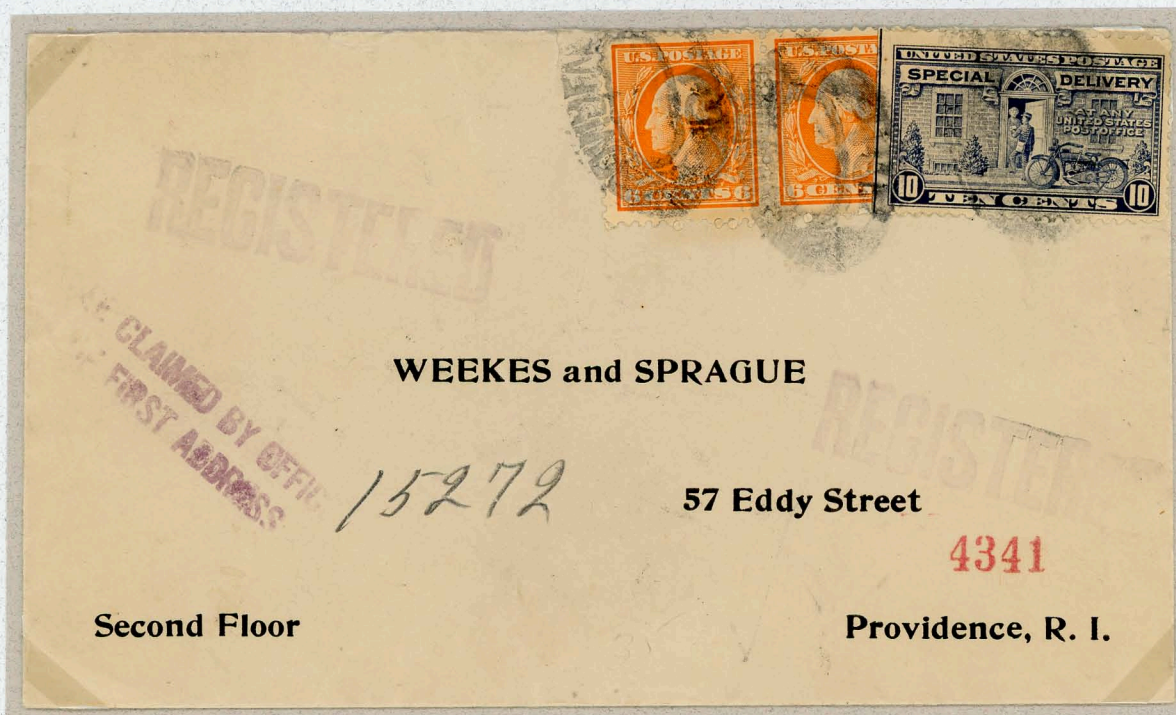

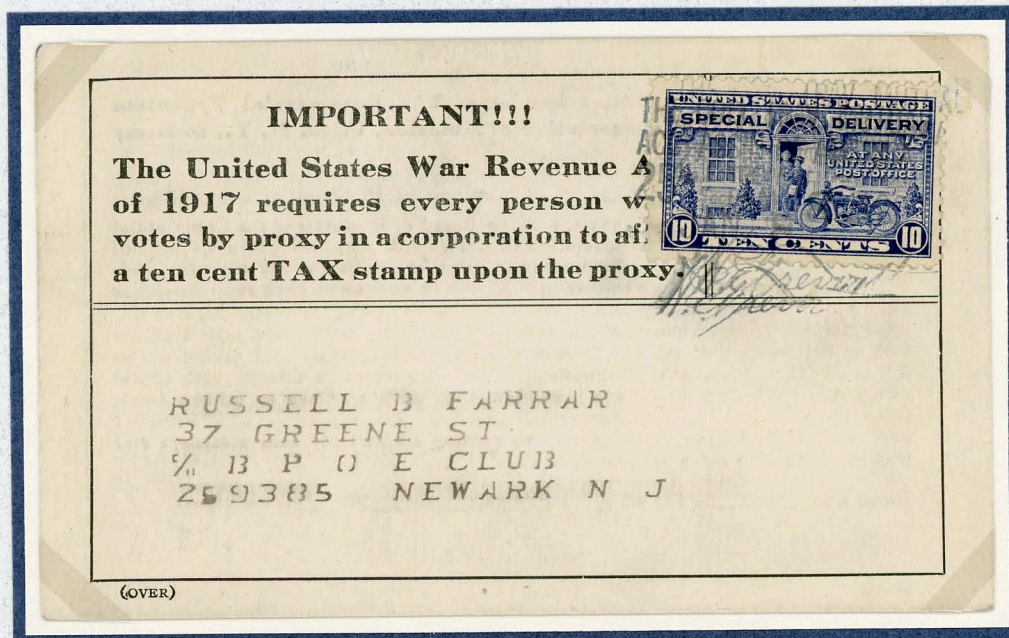

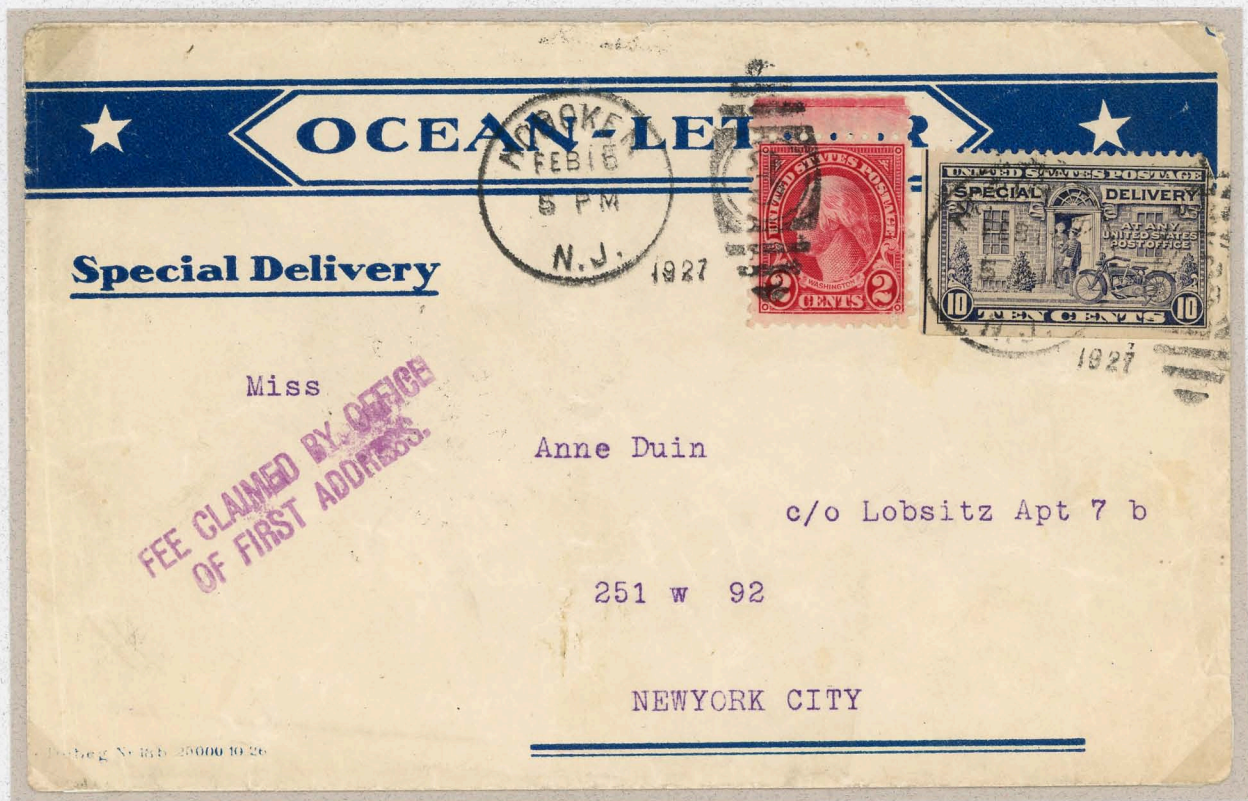
After February 1, 1927, airmail rate changed to 10¢ per 1/2 oz. on any route
