There are only two recorded manuscript markings coming from Brooklin. The first postmaster, David Sibbett served in the postal service for over thirty years and served as postmaster in Barnard in 1871 and was also the first postmaster of Cobb in 1882 (name changed to Boicourt 1882).

In Thoburn's HISTORY OF OKLAHOMA page 319 he states "Colonel W.A. Phillip's was
on (JULY 30, 1864) ordered to report to Fort Smith to be relieved of his command
He was kept off duty for a month and then assigned to court martial duty at FORT
SMITH untill the end of the year and then assigned to COMMAND the INDIAN BRIGADE
at FORT GIBSON which would be the CHEROKEES This letter he wrote 30 days before
being relieved of his command, addressed to JOHN ROSS who was Principal Chief of
the CHEROKEE INDIAN NATION was no doubt to tell of his feelings against the
practice of organised parties stealing the Indians cattle and driving them over
the line into Kansas. ----- CIVIL WAR-"FORT" cover----- 125.00
