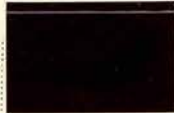

# SAMOA

GOVERNMENT—Formerly a kingdom. Annexed by Germany and the United States in 1899. The German portion was occupied by British forces in August, 1914 and placed under the administration of New Zealand. As a kingdom: AREA—About 1,100 square miles. POPULATION—34,000. CAPITAL—Apia. KING—Malietoa Laupepa. German possessions: AREA—About 1,000 square miles. POPULATION—About 35,000. United States possessions: AREA—About 95 square miles. POPULATION—About 7,550.

STANDARD COIN—Same as in Great Britain and Germany

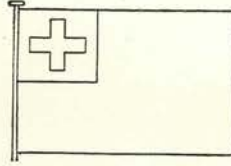



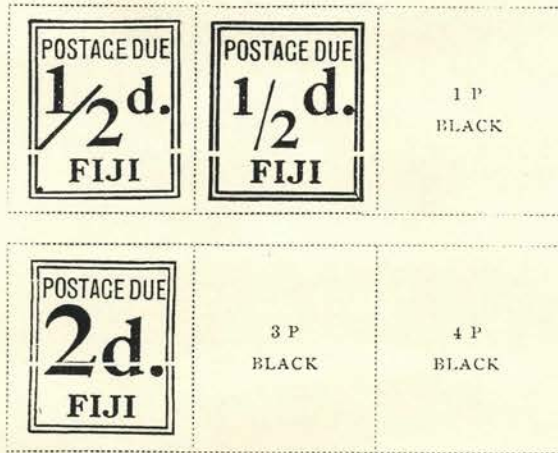
