Fifth row — impressions generally clear. One consistent plate mark is present in this row. There is a circular dot of color shading the space above the tail ribbon of the "2"; ordinarily a small triangle or dash is present. This circular mark is consistent in the fifth row, but is noted also in some copies of positions 1 and 18, and the shading is almost circular in position 39. Both the D flaw and the R flaw are clearly evident in this row, except for position 5 which has no D flaw and a faint R flaw; Comma flaw or short comma flaw present in all positions.

Sixth row — impressions generally clear. One quite distinct row mark is recognized in the sixth row. There is a small colorless projection at the lower left corner of the "E" in "NEW". Large R flaw on position 14; R-2 flaw on other positions. Comma flaw present in all positions, but may be faint.

Seventh row — impressions generally somewhat blurred. One consistent row mark is present. The shading in the upper curve of the "S" in "ORLEANS" is slightly narrower than normal, but is distinctly tapered, forming a narrow triangle of color within the upper curve. The shading of other positions is clearly parallel at the sides, not tapered. R flaw in positions 7, 15, and 23; R-2 flaw in 31 and 39. Faint comma flaw in position 7; short comma flaw in positions 23 and 31. The bottom of the "P" in "POST" is clearly rounded rather than square in the seventh row, but this is not considered a definitive row mark as this characteristic may occur in other rows, especially in somewhat blurred impressions.

Eighth row — impressions generally blurred, resulting in indistinct areas in some parts of the design, especially the upper name tablet and the lined background in the central area. The impressions are better than those of the first row, however. One combination of plate characteristics is consistent. The eighth row has the large R flaw in all positions but no trace of the comma flaw is discernible. Also, the period at the end of the lower name tablet is very small but still clearly visible, except for position 40 where this period is normal size.






