I have examined the enclosed stamp, submitted as New Zealand 1873 2d vermilion, used, perf 12½ on paper watermarked lozenges, and with portion of letters "Invicta" (Scott 50, Campbell Paterson A2x(Z), S.G. 142),

and in my opinion it is not the variety with letters "Invicta," but is the equally scarce variety showing the space between the patterns.
