

MERIDA

This rare cancel is also the stampless era Yag-Bash **MR2**, a colonial era postmark in use since 1804! The first shipment of stamps to Merida were used *without district name*, indicative of very early usage in 1856, and with the ancient colonial-era postmark. Rare!

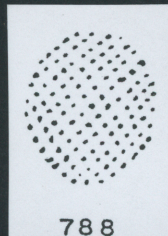
