When the Spanish-American War tax first went in effect in 1898, the government was unable to supply Dr. S. A. Kilmer & Co., manufacturer of proprietary medicines in Binghamton NY, with the Battleship revenue stamps they needed. They printed these stamps to use as revenue-stamps from July 5-14, 1898.
