The Raleigh Provisional was prepared by handstamping envelopes with a prewar intregal "5" Post Mark. Which had the rim removed, and "Paid" inserted in place of the date logo.

There are two types of this provisional: One in "Blue" which is rare. And One "Red" which is more common.

The earlest known date of use for #68Ul, is June 11, 1861.
