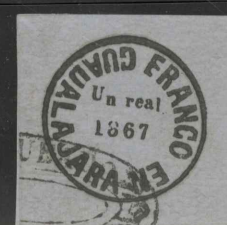

GUADALAJARA PROVISIONAL ISSUES

The Guadalajara Provisional issues are some of the most interesting stamps of Mexico to collect. During the turbulent 1867-68 period – when the postal authorities of Mexico did not have enough stamps to supply any district outside of Mexico City– , most districts simply used *Sello Negro* (“Black Stamp”) handstamp markings on otherwise stampless covers to postmark the mail. The large postal district of Guadalajara, however, was one of the few districts that produced their own provisional stamps during this period. Four separate printings resulted -- with numerous varieties of paper types, colors, and even serrated perforations.

Very fine single GDA#16 of the Third Printing on large piece, namely the "**2. reales**" laid batonne (y) on rose paper. Postmarked with Sz. #296 "*Franqueado Guadalajara.*" Attractive and quite fine additional handstamp at left of the "*Republica Mexicana Commandancia Militar del Estado de Jalsico*" in black -- *a striking symbol of the new Republic and a rare usage*. Postmarked at the Guadalajara post office with a normal Sz. 296. This attractive and large piece is a most unusual provisional stamp used for the military mails. Pd \$65.00

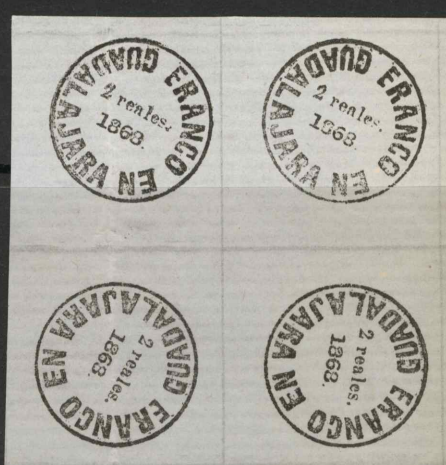

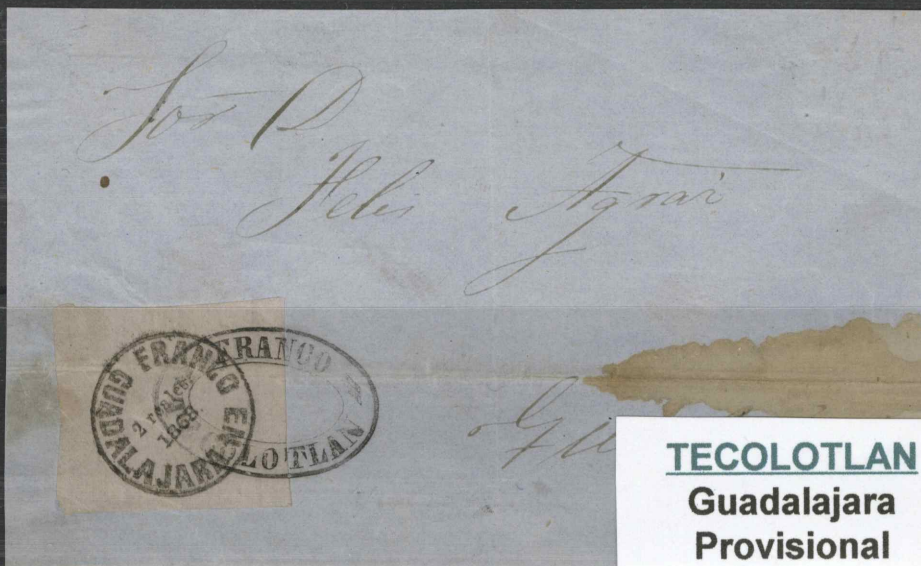
