INTRODUCTION



PON this page appear illustrations of two postage stamps printed by Waterlow & Sons Limited: the one of British Guiana 1852, the other of the highest value in the current issue of Great Britain.

Between the printing of these two stamps lies a century of development in the art and practice of stamp production by Waterlows, who

hold the record of having produced postage stamps earlier than any other British printers in the world to-day. The stamps mark the beginning and end of a century of a highly specialised

form of security printing by a firm equipped with outstanding resources.

When Waterlow & Sons Limited produced the essentially simple and outstanding issue for British Guiana, they first stepped into the front rank of Postage Stamp Printers; this position has



been maintained and consolidated with the passing years, and to-day Waterlows stand in the very forefront when security, integrity and beautiful designing and printing are the first considerations.
