Frame Design Differences in Plates Peso Values

The Peso values were rarely used. Less than 40 covers are known from the \$1 peso, and only 2 with the \$2 peso. \$5 and \$10 peso were used for gold shipments. They were printed with blue ink and issued in 1884. They ran out in 1892, when a re-issue in Blue Green was ordered. Only 200 and 100 of the \$5 and 10 Peso were issued then, in watermarked paper. The frames of each value also show extra lines of shading.



Perforation Varieties & Errors

The perforations were 12 X 12. However a few other perforation sizes exist, although they are rare and probably caused by error in the use of the machine. The very few imperforate and imperforate between were due to sheets at the bottom of the pile during perforation or misplacement of the needles . All the known perforation errors are presented in this exhibit in the section of their denomination.


