Letter carried on 22nd Cunard mail voyage to the U.S. under the retaliatory order. Prepayment in Germany covered all transit fees through French and British mail system to U.S. port. Retaliatory order applied to mails from all foreign countries transiting through G.B., carried to U.S. by foreign vessels. Retaliatory rate covers from anywhere other than G.B. are uncommon.
