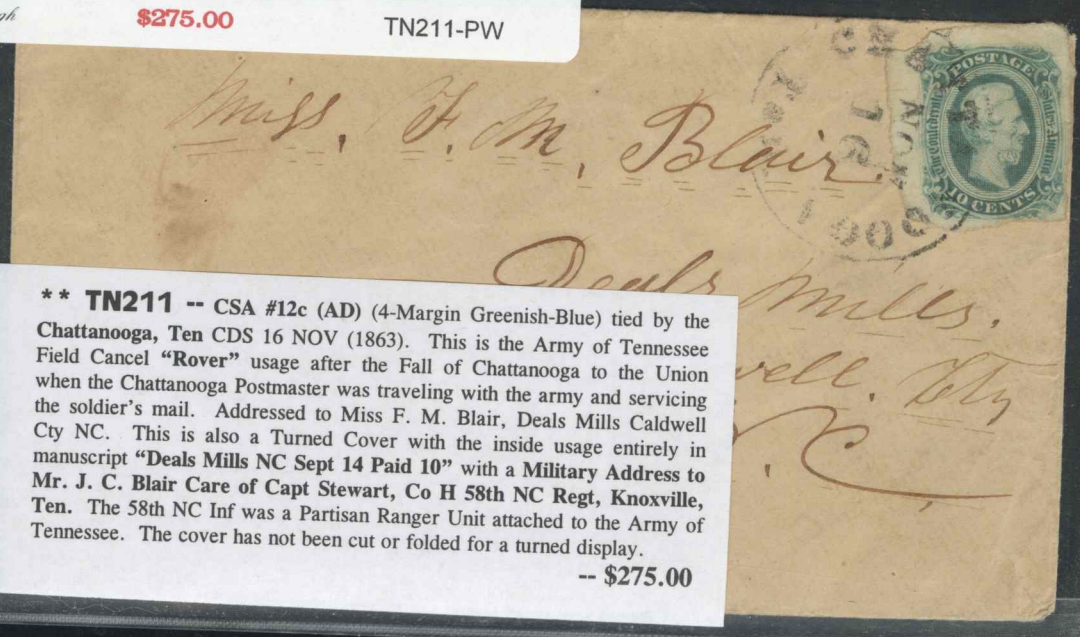
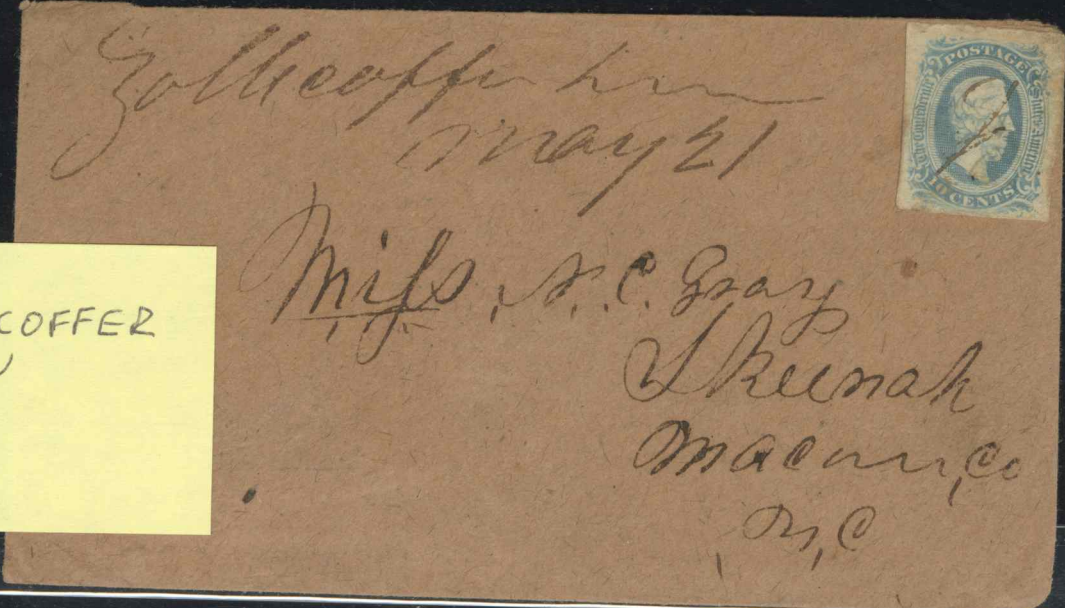

 Chattanooga, Ten CDS 16 NOV (1863). This is the Army of Tennessee  
 Field Cancel "Rover" usage after the Fall of Chattanooga to the Union  
 when the Chattanooga Postmaster was traveling with the army and servicing  
 the soldier's mail. Addressed to Miss F. M. Blair, Deals Mills Caldwell  
 City NC. This is also a Turned Cover with the inside usage entirely in  
 manuscript "Deals Mills NC Sept 14 Paid 10" with a Military Address to  
 Mr. J. C. Blair Care of Capt Stewart, Co H 58th NC Regt, Knoxville,  
 Ten. The 58th NC Inf was a Partisan Ranger Unit attached to the Army of  
 Tennessee. The cover has not been cut or folded for a turned display.
