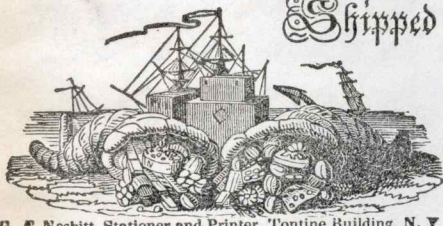

One Hundred and Fifty Bales Cotton

being marked and numbered as in the margin, and are to be delivered in the like order and condition, at the Port of *Providence* (the dangers of the seas only excepted,) unto *Miss [illegible]* or to *their* assigns, he or they paying freight for the said

Five Eighths of one cent per pound for *square & round* *rights* *per pound* with *5* *primage and average* accustomed. In witness whereof, the Master or Purser of the said vessel hath affirmed to *5* Bills of Lading, all of this tenor and date; one of which being accomplished, the others to stand void.

Dated in APALACHICOLA, the *11th* day of *January* 18*44*
