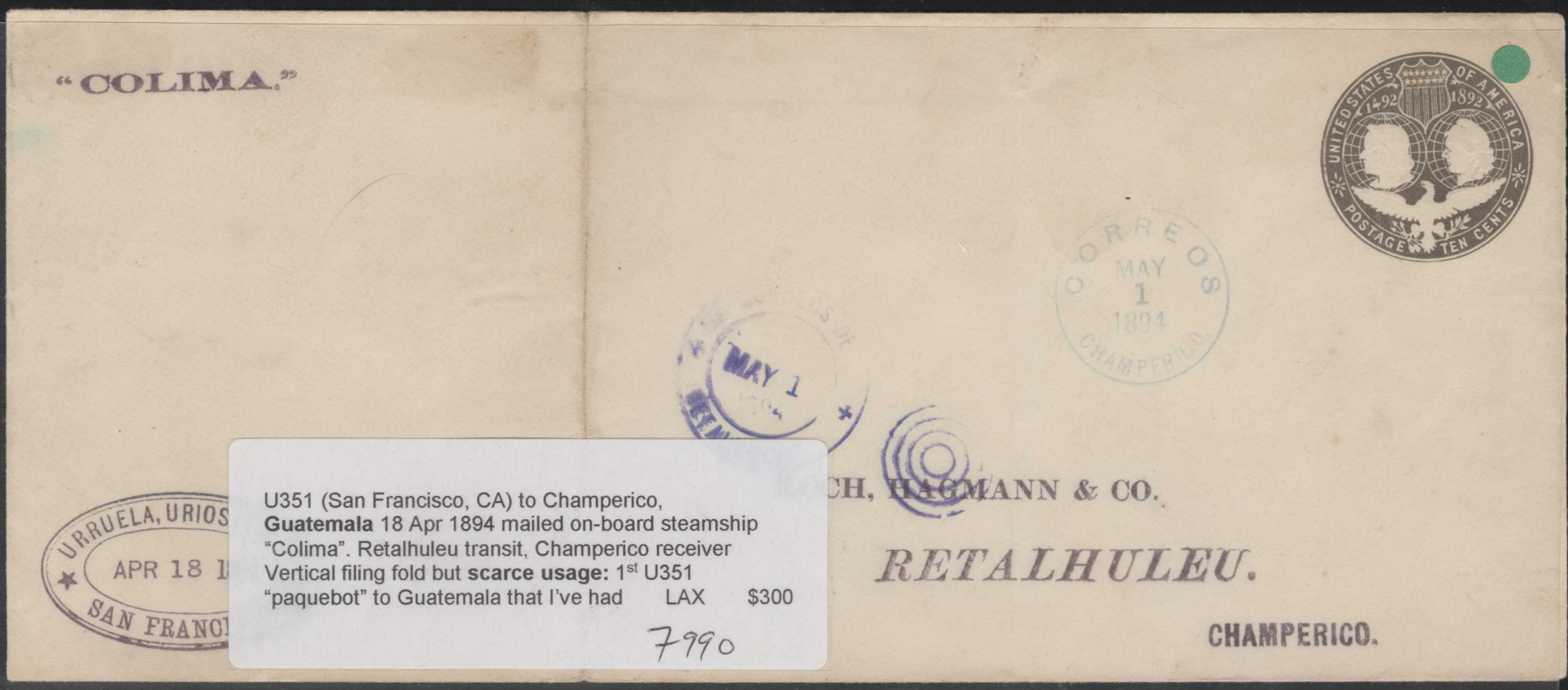
10¢ Columbian envelope, paying 5¢ overseas rate to Guatemala. Hand carried by private postal firm Parrott & Co from San Fransisco and put in the Guatemalan mail stream in the port city of Camperico. Parrott was recognized as a legally contracted private carrier for mail from US, so stamped in Camperico March 13, 1903 and delivered by Guatemalan postal authority to Mazatenango. The Parrott fee was likely 5¢ accounting for the 10¢ envelope usage. Envelope size Q, 9.5 x 16 cm. (Haeseler size 11). Very rare usage.





U350 privately carried to **Guatemala** 26 Oct 1893  
& accepted as fully paid. Champerico transit  
Damage to back of cover (possible paste-back usage)  
Scarce usage & destination
