USA 1913 (Oct) Washington 2c red stationery envelope sent to France without added franking underpaying 5c UPU foreign letter rate and taxed with T / CENTIMES 30 opera-glass cachet, French Postage Dues 10c brown (3) affixed but invalidated when forwarded with another three 10c Dues affixed over top and again invalidated, eventually forwarded to England where tax cachet obliterated as item paid the correct 68 2/3 treaty rate \$132.00
