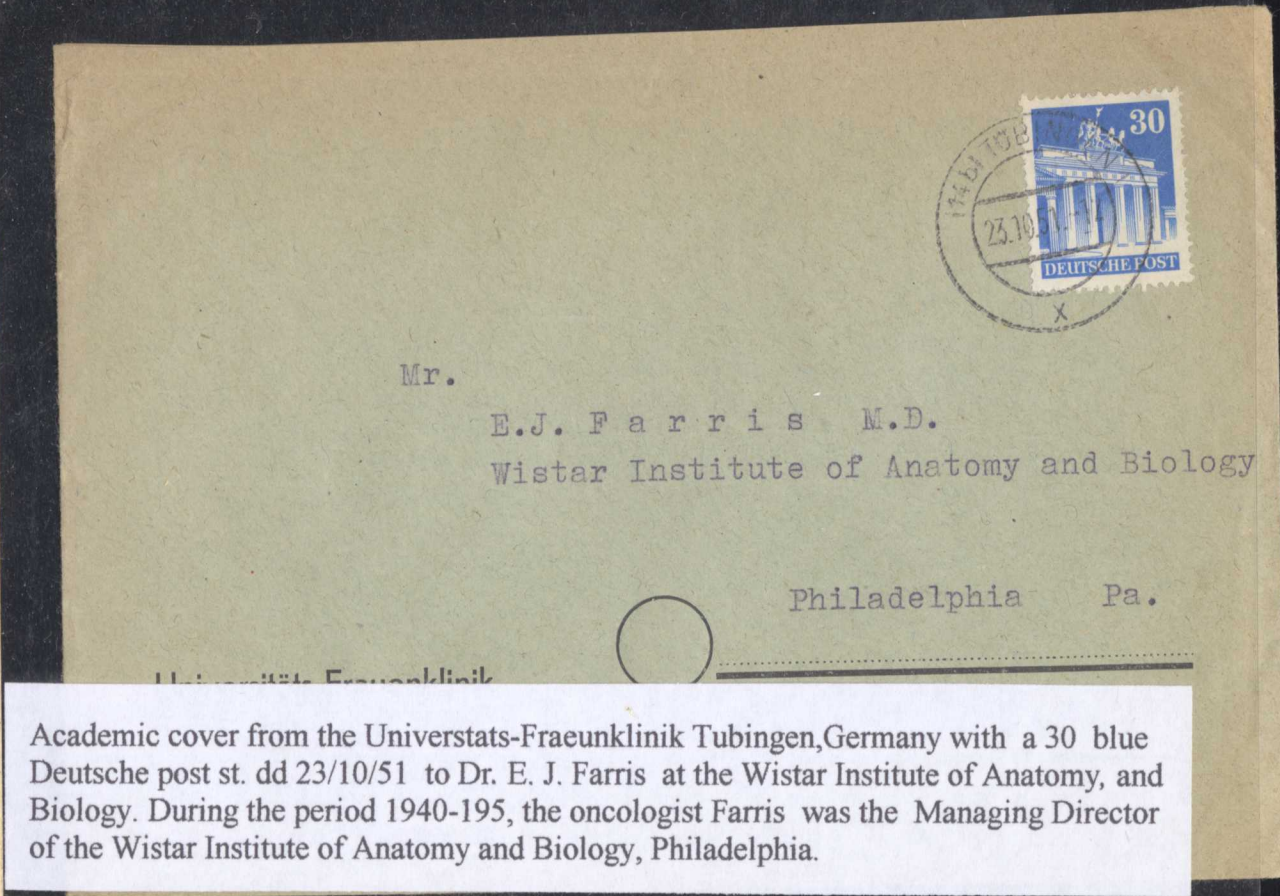

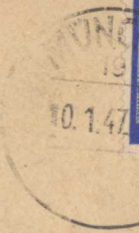

Academic cover from Herr Hans Dieter Berger, Bayern, Germany to the Rector of the University of Philadelphia, with 75 Pf blue violet st., censored tape and the left side with censor circular cachet N 10714. Letter probably sent requesting for an academic position during the Germany post war era.

Cover from the displaced persons camp in Geislingen, Germany, camp # 615, in the US occupation zone of Germany to the headmaster of Dartmouth college. Postmarked October 1, 1947. What is unusual is most of these DP camp covers are stampless and mailed with free franking, postage stamps on DP camp covers are unusual. In excellent condition. Priced to sell. Nice postal history cover. The sender was a detainee or resident of the displaced persons (DP) camp. Sender was famous botanist and expert on American plants Dr. Leonid Enari who later emigrated to the USA. Offered at Ebay at US\$ 70.00 (10<sup>th</sup> June 2014).

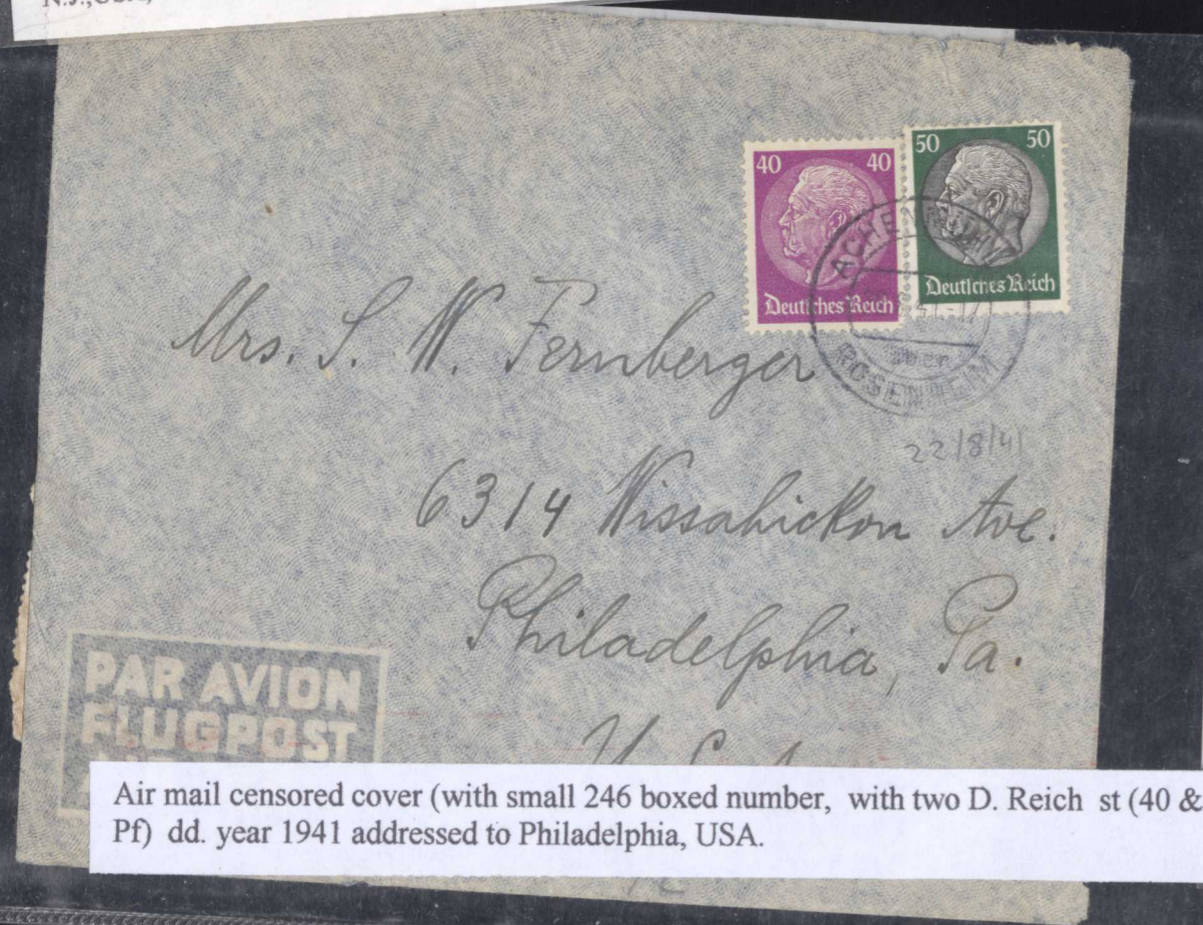
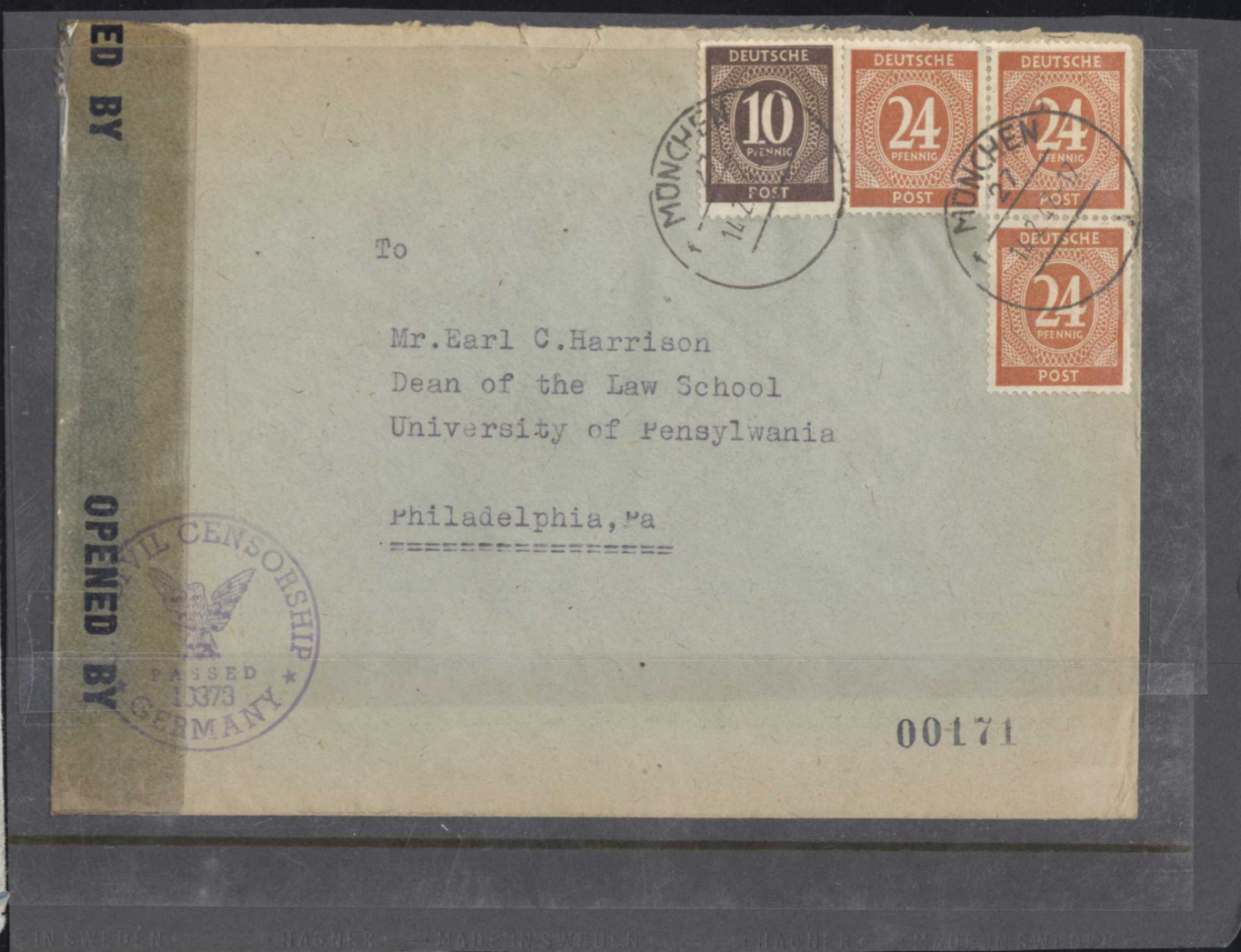

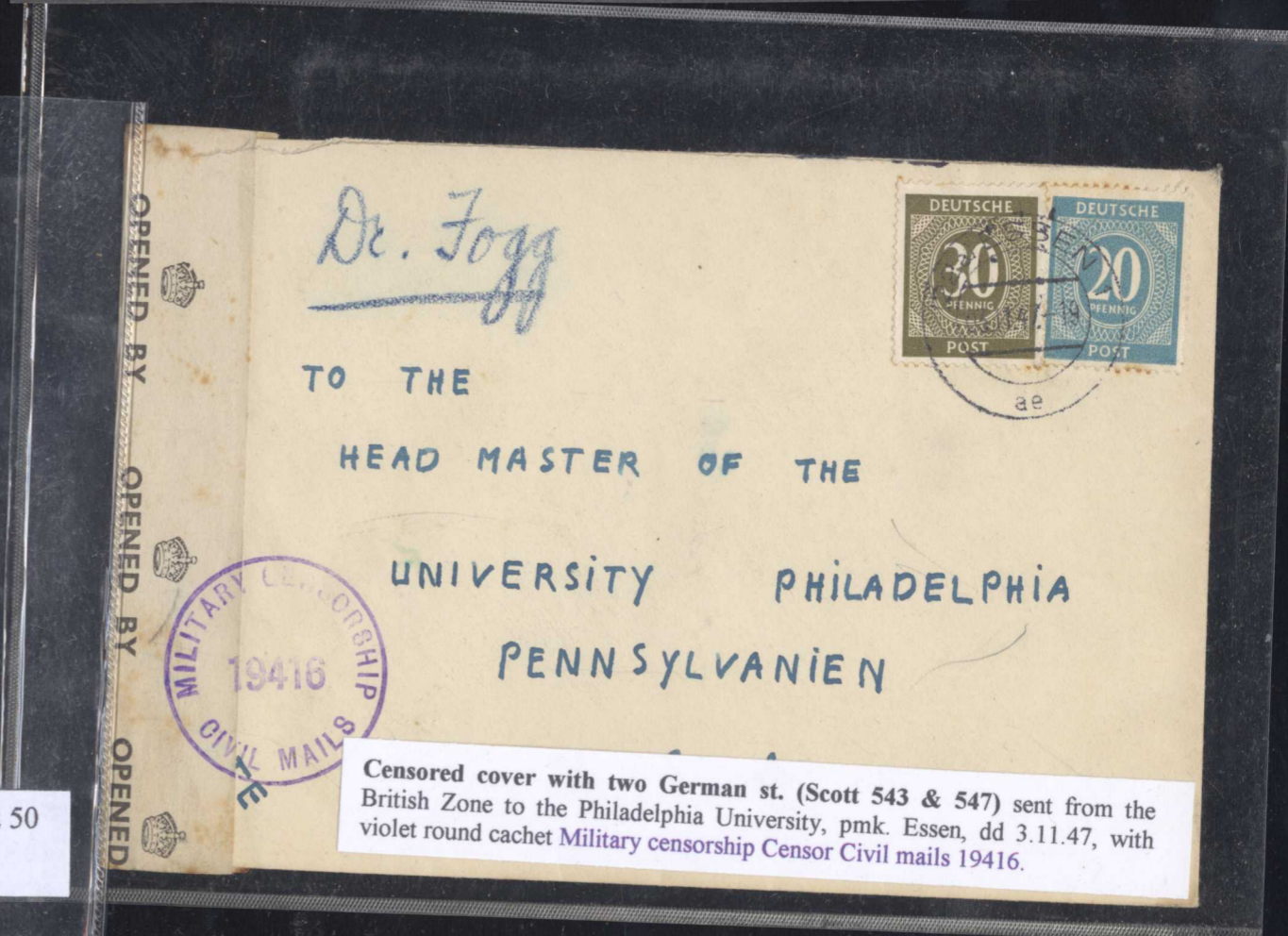

Registered (Einschreiben) air mail printed cover (Zeppelin and Lufthansa plane) from Berlin to Buenos Aires, Argentina, with three D. Reich airmail stamps (100 Pf x 2, and 5 Pf) dd. 5.10.35 with rubber cachet pmks (Certificados 825) in the front, also Expresso pmk, in the back and Buenos Aires dd 13 10 35. The letter was probably sent to company Ferrostaal, S.A. with offices at Av.de Mayo 145 Buenos Aires, known to have trading links with Nazi Germany during the war, and whose funds were confiscated by the Argentine government during the Perón's War Declaration to Germany at the end of the 2<sup>nd</sup>.WW.
