C., Sept. 12, 1865, the aforesaid property is hereby restored to *his* possession, it being understood that such restoration does not include the rents or other profits that may have accrued to the U. S. Government during the time said property has been in its possession, and that the aforesaid *Mr. James Ferguson* relinquishes all claims against the U. S. Government for damages, and that any land now under cultivation by loyal refugees or freedmen, will be held by them until the crops now growing, or yet unharvested, shall be secured for their sole use and benefit, unless a full and just compensation for their labor and its products, to their satisfaction, be made, with the written approval of the Assistant Commissioner.

Dear Sir

I went to Murrells yesterday to pay Robt & Dunlapp's accts, that I might forward to you, as usual, his annual Bill of expenses; But his accounts were not made out, & I did not succeed. I have directed his accts, or rather that part of them which I have not paid to be sent to me at Washington, & I will make out his general account & forward it to you from that place, in time for you to make your annual return.

In the mean time I must beg you to look to the vouchers of his acct for last year, and send me the amount, the time it began to run, the time at which the last item in it was charged, & the date at which it was paid by me, of R. S. Sims & Co's acct. I want this statement of R. S. Sims & Co's acct against Robt because they have failed to give him credit for having paid the account of last year, when I feel confident that I paid it up to the time I left home for Washington. Will you
