Bonds may be given for all Provincial Duties when amounting to £50 Currency, with conditions for payment at Six Months from date, if the same shall be dated on or before the 1st day of September—and if dated after the 1st September, then they become due on the 1st April next ensuing.

Ten per cent. is added to all Invoices paying Imperial per centage Duties, and Duty is paid at Currency rate.

Provincial per centage Duties are also paid in Currency rate.

All Specific Duties are paid in Sterling.

The Subscribers in again tendering their services to the business public as Custom House, Forwarding and Commission Agents at this Port, will on their part, promise prompt and faithful attention to the interests of their employers, and at satisfactory charges. 
