I wrote you the 3rd June last concerning
The various masters Sale of the Stone foundation of
my house as they stood after the last fire for fear the
Underwriters wd. make difficulty in paying the
Insurance money without it. The originals and
Duplicats. were sent by the Hankey now land
and the Simon's Capt Mathews which I hope
came safe to hand. Some that many vessels
arrived here from your port. without any letters
from you or Mr Hunt. which surprizes me
a good deal. I hope the Underwriters. has payed
Mr. Hunt the Insurance money. according
to their appointment. and that Mr Hunt
payed you the six or seven hundred pounds.
according to my Instructions to him. Pray write
me particularly about this matter. by very first
