

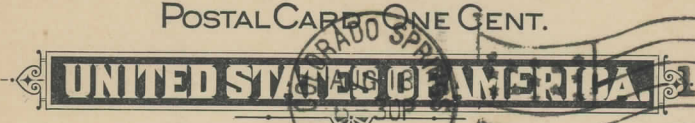

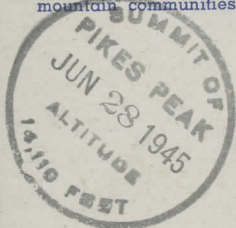

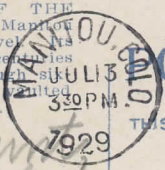

STEPLADDER ON PIKE'S PEAK COG ROAD

One may travel several hundred thousand miles of steel rail in America, and find nothing like the eight and three-fourths miles of cog railroad which connects Manitou with the top of Pike's Peak. The cars are so built that the wonderful view is not in the least obstructed, and the seats are so arranged that the occupants have a level sitting at all times. The steepest grade is 25 per cent, and the sharpest curves are 16 degrees.

This beautiful suspension bridge, constructed in 1929, stretches like a silver cobweb over the dark chasm of the Royal Gorge. It is a masterpiece of engineering, so impressive as to attract world-wide attention. The bridge is supported by cables nearly 6 inches thick, weighing 300 tons. The towers are 150 ft. high, the main span 880 ft. in length, and it is 1053 feet above the bottom of the Gorge.
