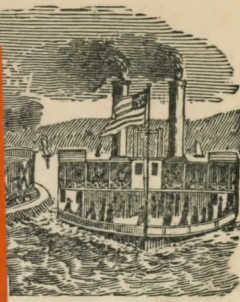

EASTERN EXPRESSES COME WEST

UNITED STATES EXPRESS

IOWA - 1862

The United States Express Company was organized in 1854 with capital stock of \$500,000 to operate west on the New York & Erie Railroad. Soon this railroad began their own express, but it was merged into the United States Express Company in 1858 and their lines were extended across the Mississippi River into Missouri, Iowa, Kansas and Nebraska.

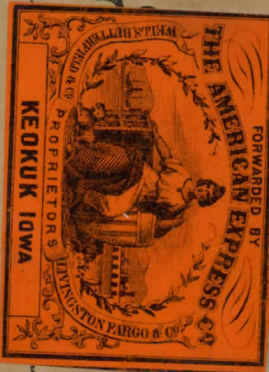

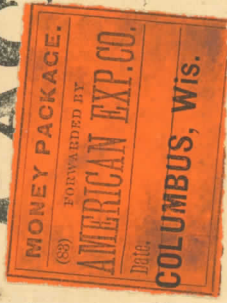

AMERICAN EXPRESS "TREE"

In 1850 three expresses merged to form American Express – Wells & Co., Livingston & Fargo and the recently formed Butterfield, Wasson & Co. American Express at first functioned as two divisions, Livingston, Fargo and Wells, Butterfield. In 1867 Merchants Union Express, a competing express, was formed – the following year it merged with American Express, the new company being renamed American Merchants' Union Express Company. That name lasted until early 1873 when it was changed back to American Express Company. All these companies except Butterfield, Wasson & Co. used labels – all are shown below.

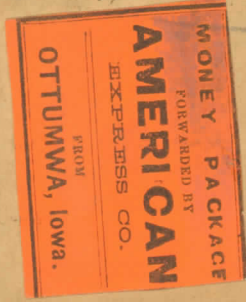
