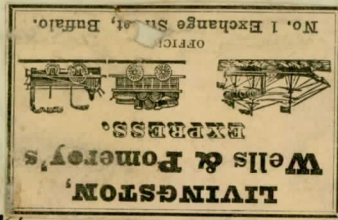

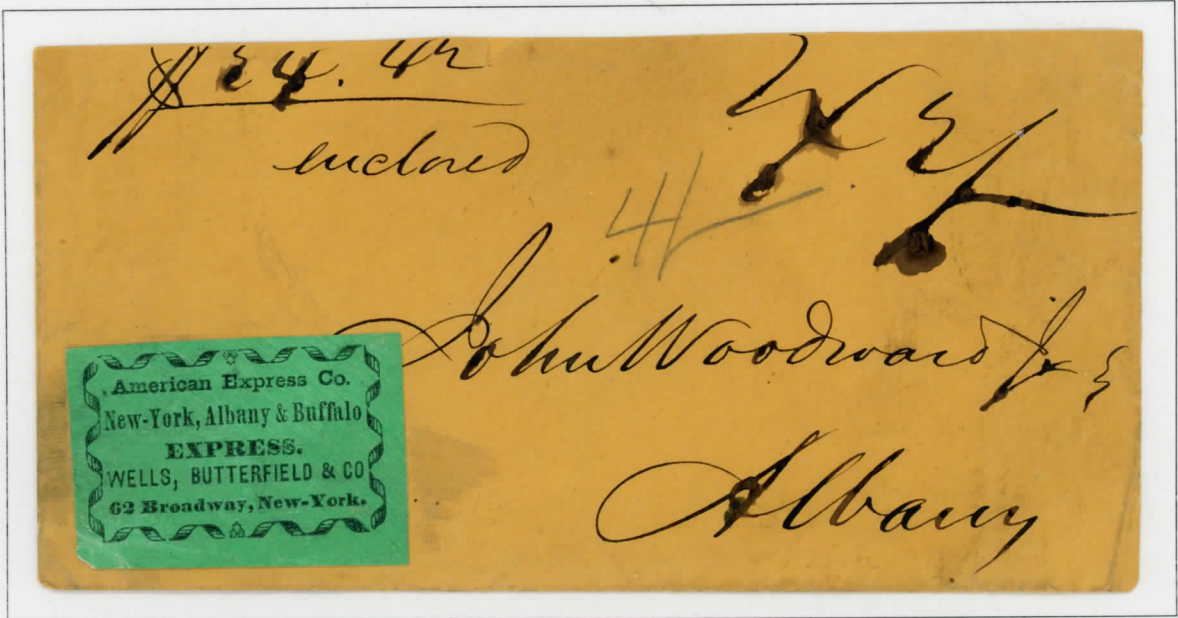

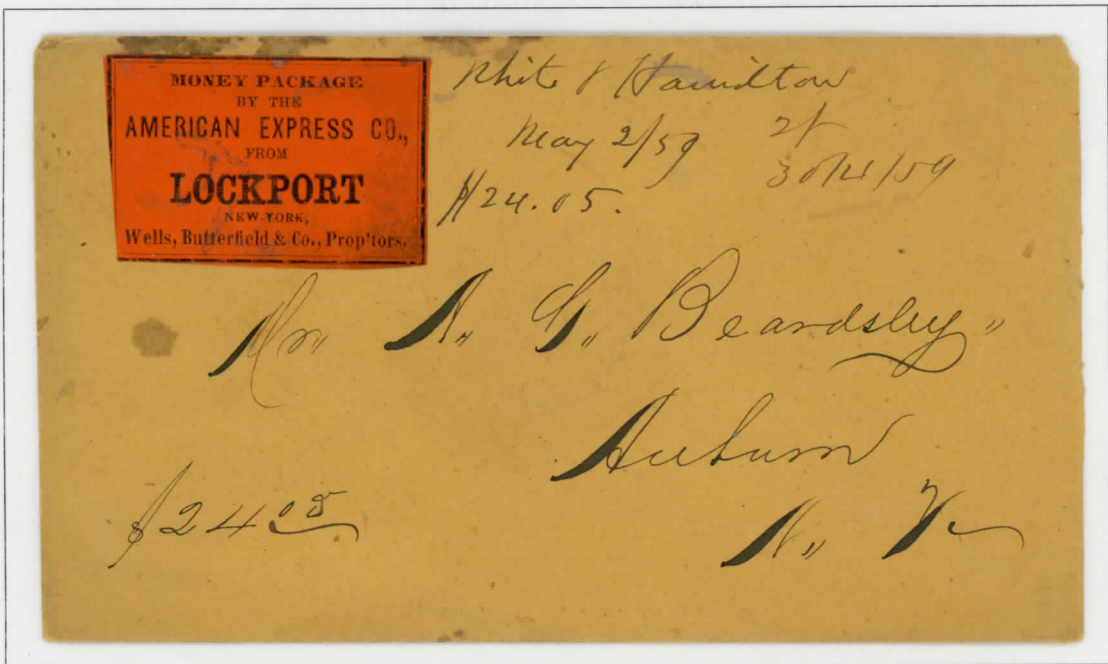
AMERICAN EXPRESS "TREE"
