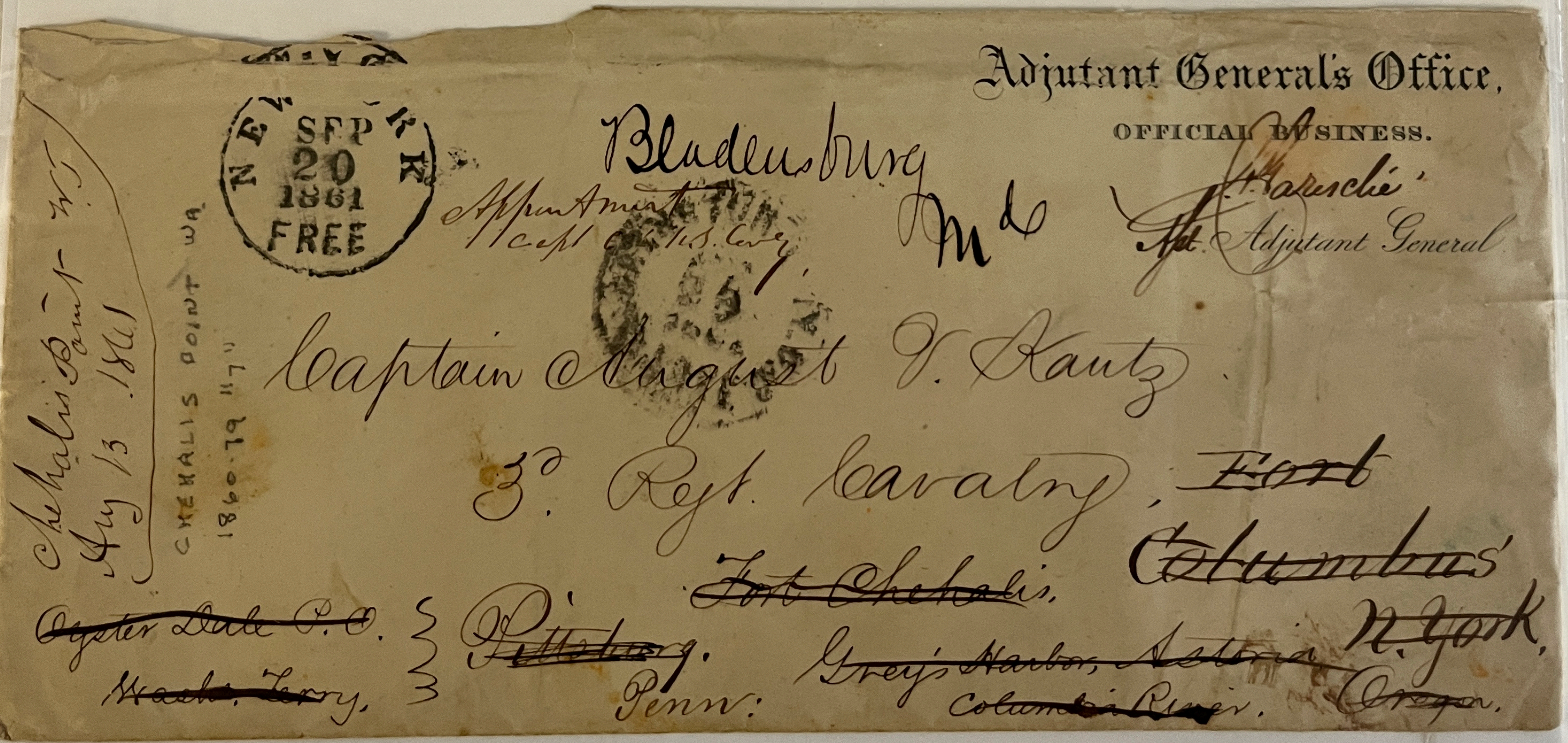


Adjutant Generals Office Official Business

Appiontment of Captain

Docketed Chehalis Point, August 13, 1861 where there was an Army camp between February 1860 and June 1861, then again in August, This letter made many stops. Sent by ship via Panama it was returned from New York September 20, stop- ping in Pittsburgh, then overland delivered back to Chealis on Greys Habor.

No Post Office existed ntil 1874.



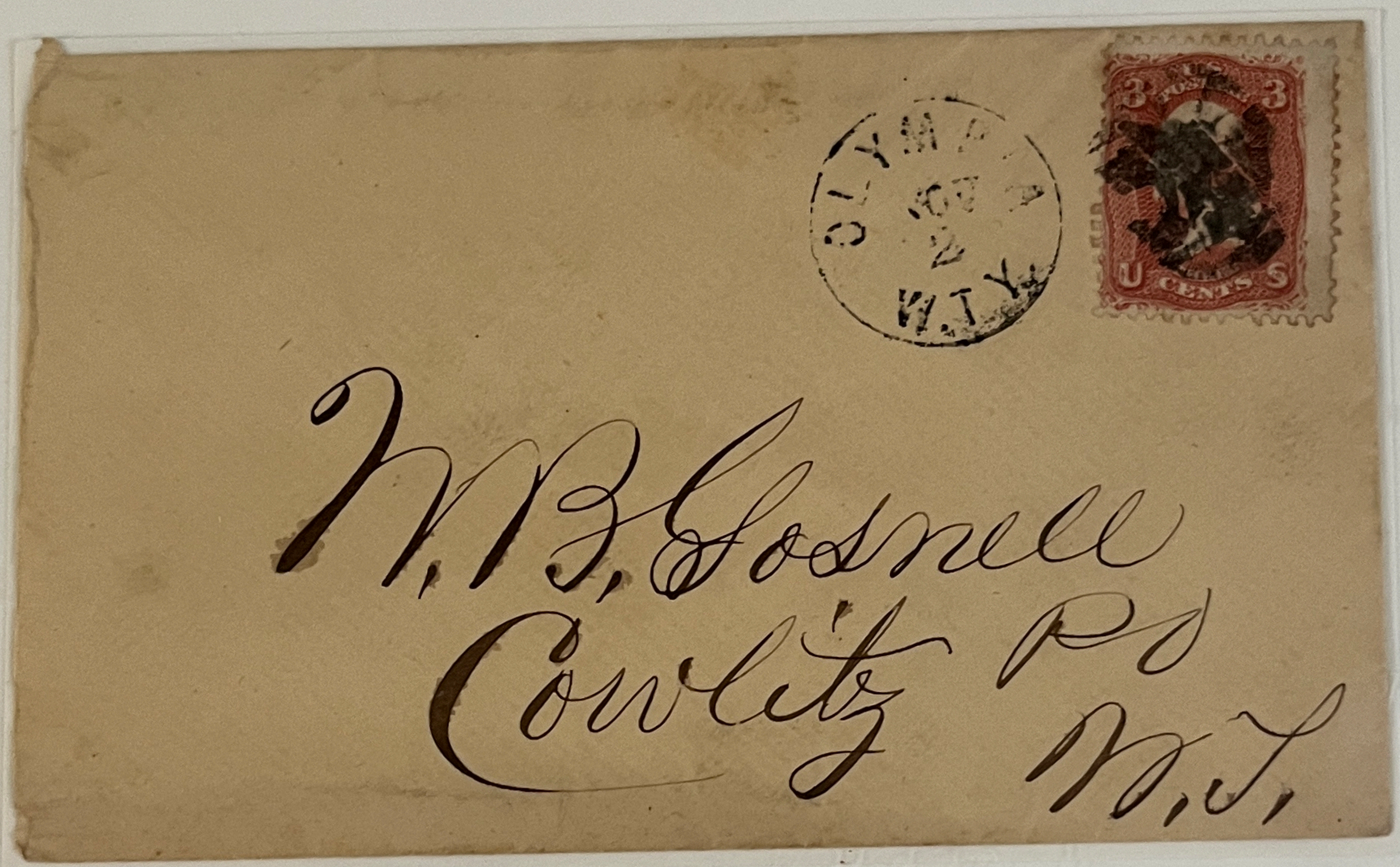

Dear Brother

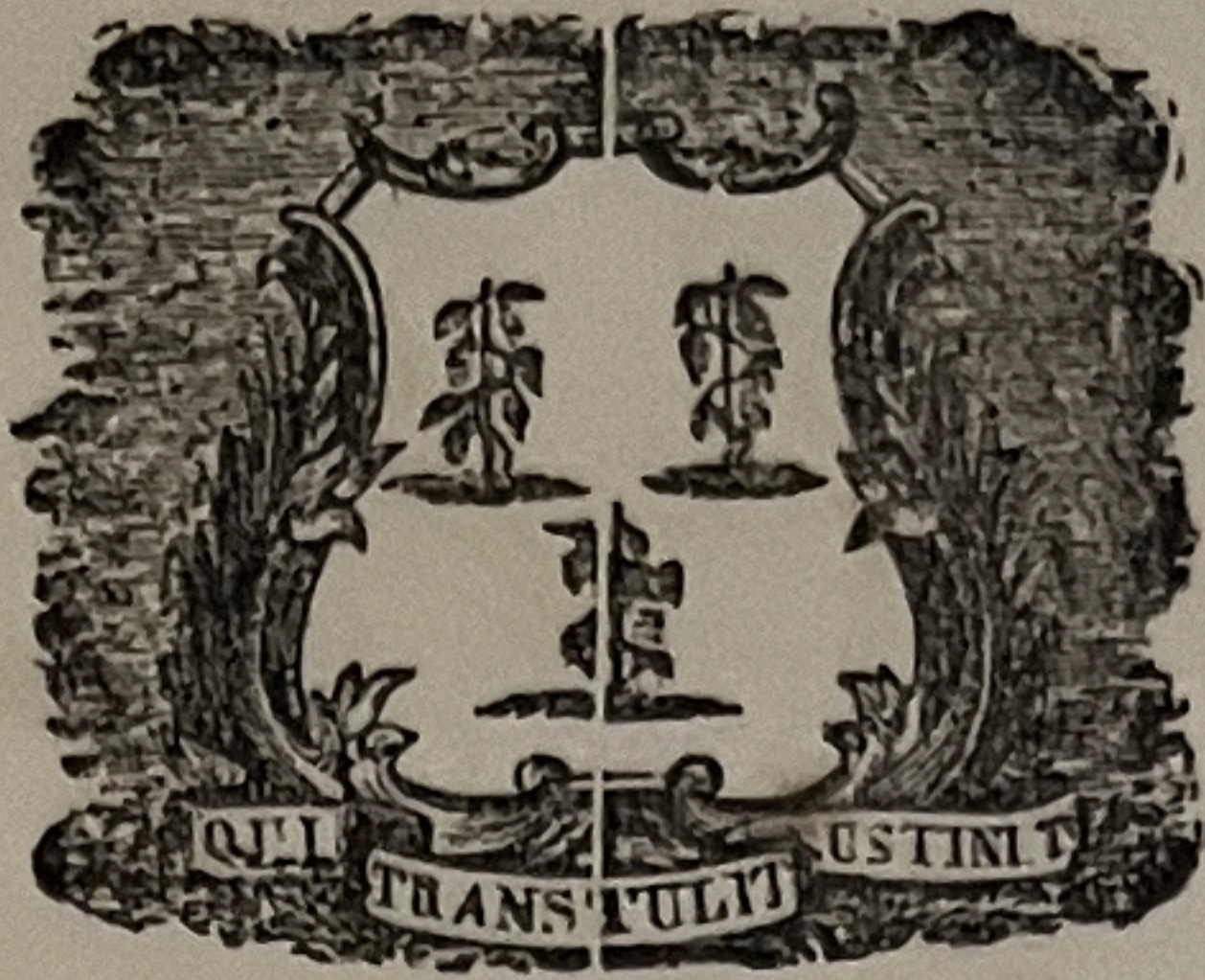

I tried for three weeks to get some hauling done but couldn't get it done for less than five dollars per day and have concluded to give it up doing anything on our land this summer and have been trying to get in some ^{other} business but haven't yet and don't expect I can if I don't get something to do within a week I will leave here I was up north and every thing is very dull but here nothing a whole evening on I am very glad I didn't get started making fence
