THEMUNG CANAL LOAN—Extract from the minutes of the Commissioners of the Canal Fund, at their meeting, June 10, 1830:-

Resolved, pursuant to the directions of the act entitled "an act authorising the construction of a canal from the head of the Seneca lake to Elmira," passed April 15, 1829, that the following proposals for a loan for the construction of the canal authorised by the said

act, be issued, viz: The Commissioners of the Canal Fund, in pursuance of the authority in them vested by the said act, will receive sealed proposals until the 20th day of July next, at four o'clock in the aftern on of that day, for a loan of one hundred and fifty thousand dollars, to be paid at such bank in the city of New York as the commissioners shall designate, on the first day of August next, at which time the stock is to be issued. The proposals may be for the whole or any part of the said loan, not less than \$20,000, at 5 per cent. interest, to be paid quarterly, and the principal to be reimbursible at the pleasure of the state, at any time after the first day of August 1850. The officer appointed for the purpose in the city of New-York will issue transferable certificates of stock to the lenders, and attend to the transfers thereof. It is to be understood that the commissioners will be at liberty to take a less sum than the \$150,000 proposed, if the offers are not such as they may consider advantageous to the state.

The stockholders residing in the first and second senate districts of the state will receive their interest at the Manhattan Bank in the city of New-York, and all the others at the New-York State Bank in the city, of Albany. All proposals to be addressed to the comptroller, and to be endorsed "Proposals for Chemung Canal Loan." By order of the Board.



CSA Civil War Soldier

Three-Cent Yellow Stamped Envelope (U10) Addressed to Eugene Davis, Esquire, Charlottesville, Virginia with Blue, Circular Martinsville, Virginia Cancel. Per a handwritten note on the cover, the sender was likely Rev. R. J. Davis. The issue date of the Stamped Envelope indicates it was mailed prior to the Civil War.

Eugene Davis, (Mar. 26, 1822 - May 19, 1894), a descendent of Thomas Jefferson's sister Martha Jefferson Carr and a University of Virginia graduate, was a lawyer in Charlottesville, Virginia prior to the Civil War. Upon outbreak of the War, he was commissioned Captain of Company K, 2nd Virginia Cavalry, Confederate States of America, on 5/20/1861 but resigned on 11/20/1861 due to ill health. He later enlisted as a private in Company D 6th Virginia Cavalry, CSA on 8/15/1863. He was a volunteer aide to General Pendelton. Davis was captured War at the Battle of Yellow Tavern, Va. on 5/11/1864, where feated CSA General Jeb Stuart, and was confined at the oldiers during its 15-month existence. Following the War, Davis lie. He is buried at the University of Virginia Cemetery and
