Fine strike of Type 5 "East Las Vegas N. Mex. Oct 16 1888" on two-cent oriental buff PSE with "blob" killer. Mailed to Mrs. Mary Prince in Santa Fe, thence redirected to Flushing, New York. Backstamps of Santa Fe and Flushing. Type 5 was only used for two years. Todsens Type 5 for East Las Vegas has a scarcity rating of R-2/1. Ex Kriege Collection.

SAN MIGUEL, N. MEX. TERRITORY~TYPE 2 Ms. DATE

San Miguel County

Rare Todsens Type 2 (scarcity rating of R-6) circular postmark "San Miguel N. Mex." with manuscript date added by postmaster of "4/19/1895." on Scott #UX11. The community of San Miguel del Bado is one of the classic and historic settlements of the Hispanic homeland of New Mexico. Founded in 1794 by *genizaros*, San Miguel was a large community in 1844 when it served as county seat for the vast, newly created, and eponymous San Miguel County. The post office apparently opened in 1851, but operated intermittently in later years before closing in 1910 with mail service passing to nearby Ribera. Examples are scarce. *Ex Kriege Collection.*

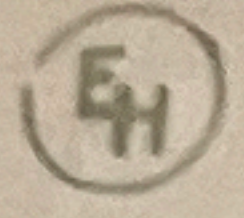

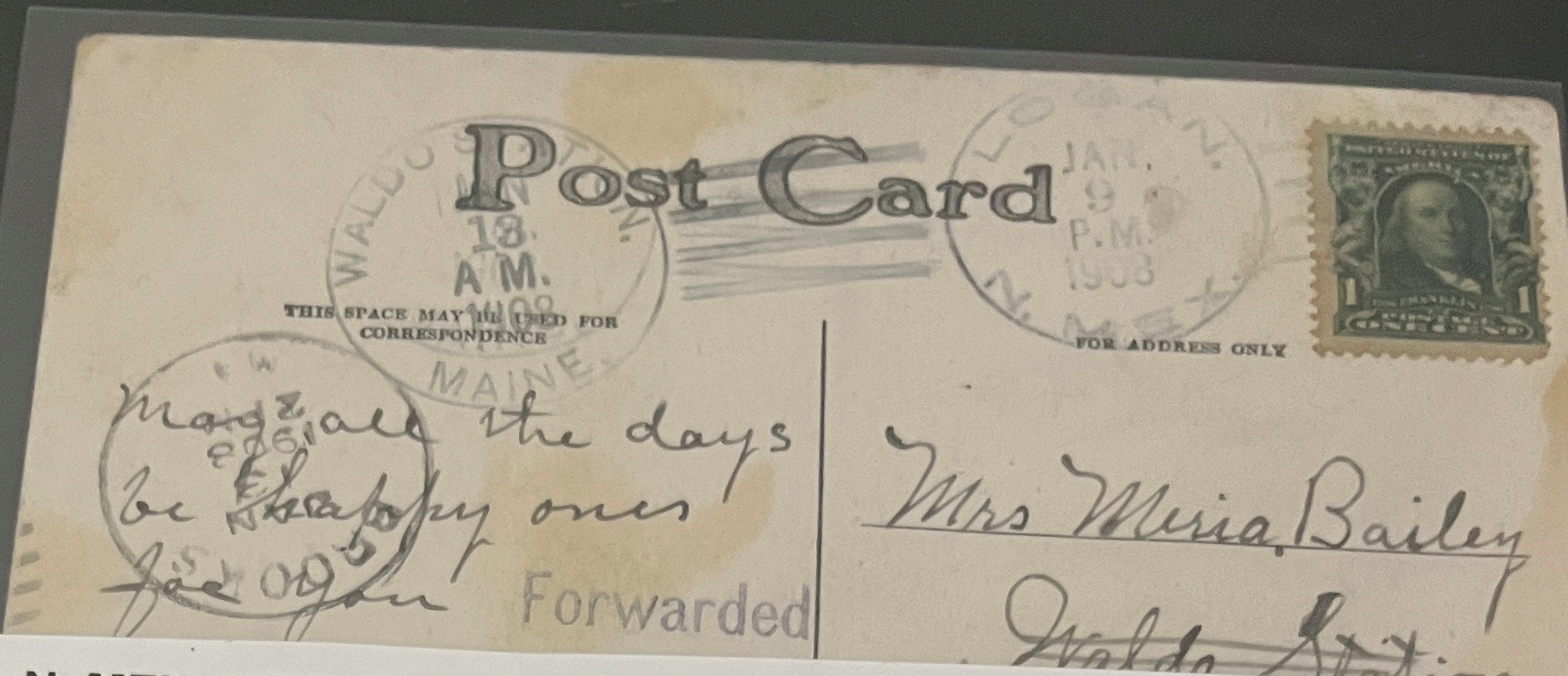
Fine and rare cds of "Largo, N. Mex. Jan 11 [ca.1885-86], the first canceler for this town in remote San Juan County. Clear postmark with unusual, possibly fancy killer on cent Scott U#281, fawn stamped envelope, mailed to Herkimer, New York with Jan Herkimer backstamp.

The original 1883 Largo is said to be the first non-native settlement in the vast r Officially the post office opened in 1883, but Todsens records type 1 postmarks starting January 30, 1885 to ? March ? Unrecorded but probably either ECU (Earliest Usage) or LKU (Latest Known Usage) for Todsens Type 1, that is either January of January of 1886. Rare with a Todsens scarcity rating of R-6.

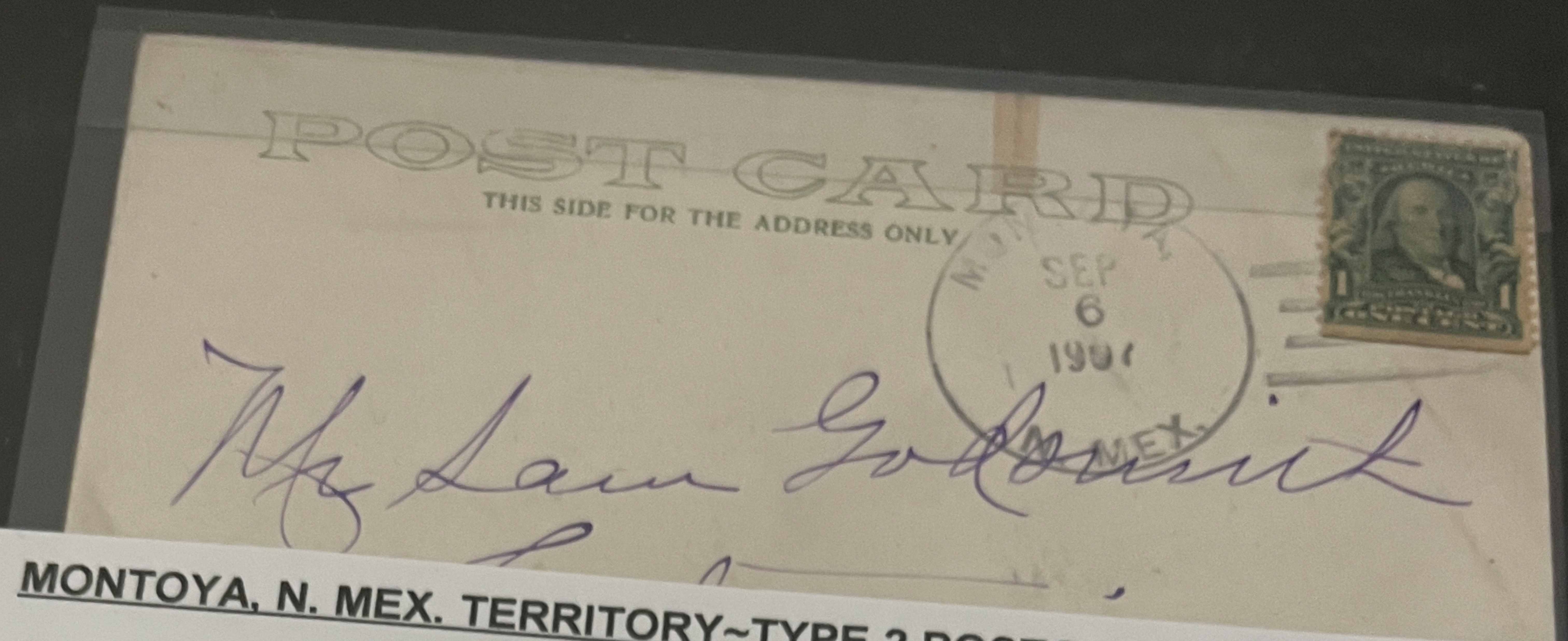

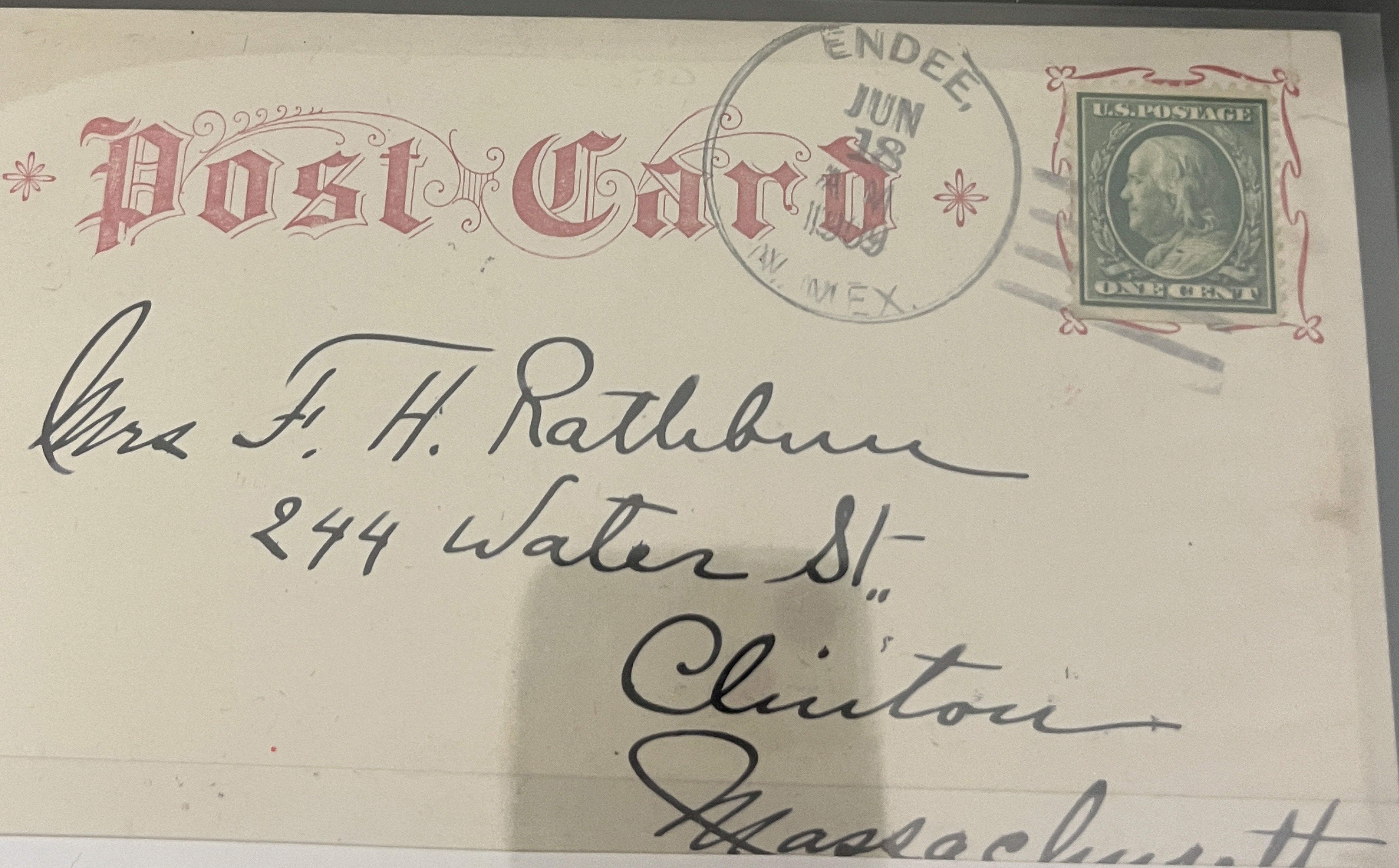




**MONTOYA, N. MEX. TERRITORY~TYPE 2 POSTCARD (1907)**

Fine Type 2 cds of "Montoya N. Mex. Sep 6 1907" on picture postcard of Taos native mailed to Estancia, New Mexico. Todsens Type 2 for Montoya was used between June and October of 1907, some six months of known usage. Type 2 has a scarcity rating of R-4.

Extra fine 4-bar cds of "Endee N. Mex. Jun 18 1909" on very fine picture postcard mailed to Clinton, Massachusetts. Todsens Type 7 (scarcity rating of R-4.) Unrecorded but latest known usage (LKU) of type 7. Endee was a former Quay Co. cowtown named for the nearby N. Branch. A scarce town and ex Kriege Collection.
