1/4 anna ultramarine; probably issued in the 1880's or early 1890's; irregular blocks totaling 32 stamps, with the six cliché types mapped out; from columns 8 to 12 on the sheet with part sheet watermark "C" of COWAN; ex Couvreaux and probably ex Dawson.

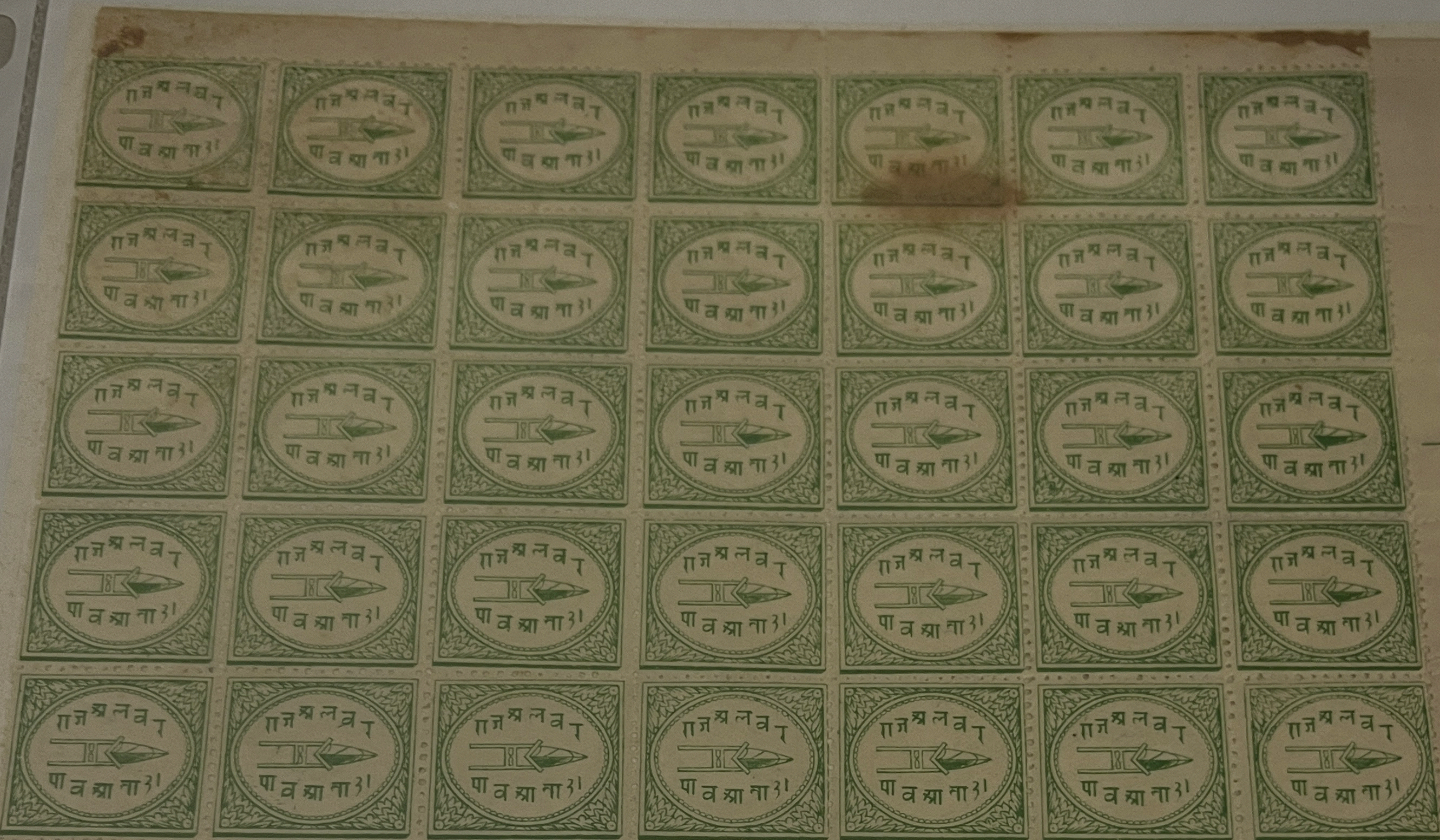

1/4 anna pale yellow green blue lower right corner block of 35 (7 x 5) with very wide margins right and bottom. Three stamps and margin stains but probably second largest multiple known.

In blocks of six from sheet of 150 which Stanley Gibbons split up. The differences are minute, but

- Type 1. There is a short hair-line through the solid shading of the outer left thick frame line nearly at the top. This in many specimens can only be seen as a dot where it impinges on the plain margin to the right of the thick frame line.
- Type 2. In the pearl opposite the point of the dagger there is a distinct dot.
- Type 3.

- Type 4. Three or four very fine specks in plain oval on the left opposite the two shafts of the dagger.
- Type 5. In the plain oval there is a dot opposite end of lower lotus leaf.
- Type 6. White flaw in middle stroke of first character in lower row.



This is the right top corner of the sheet.

This Transfer is clean and free from the dots and dashes of subsequent Transfers and in it Type 6 shows the flaw in paw, i.e., first character in bottom row. None of the other Transfers show this defect.



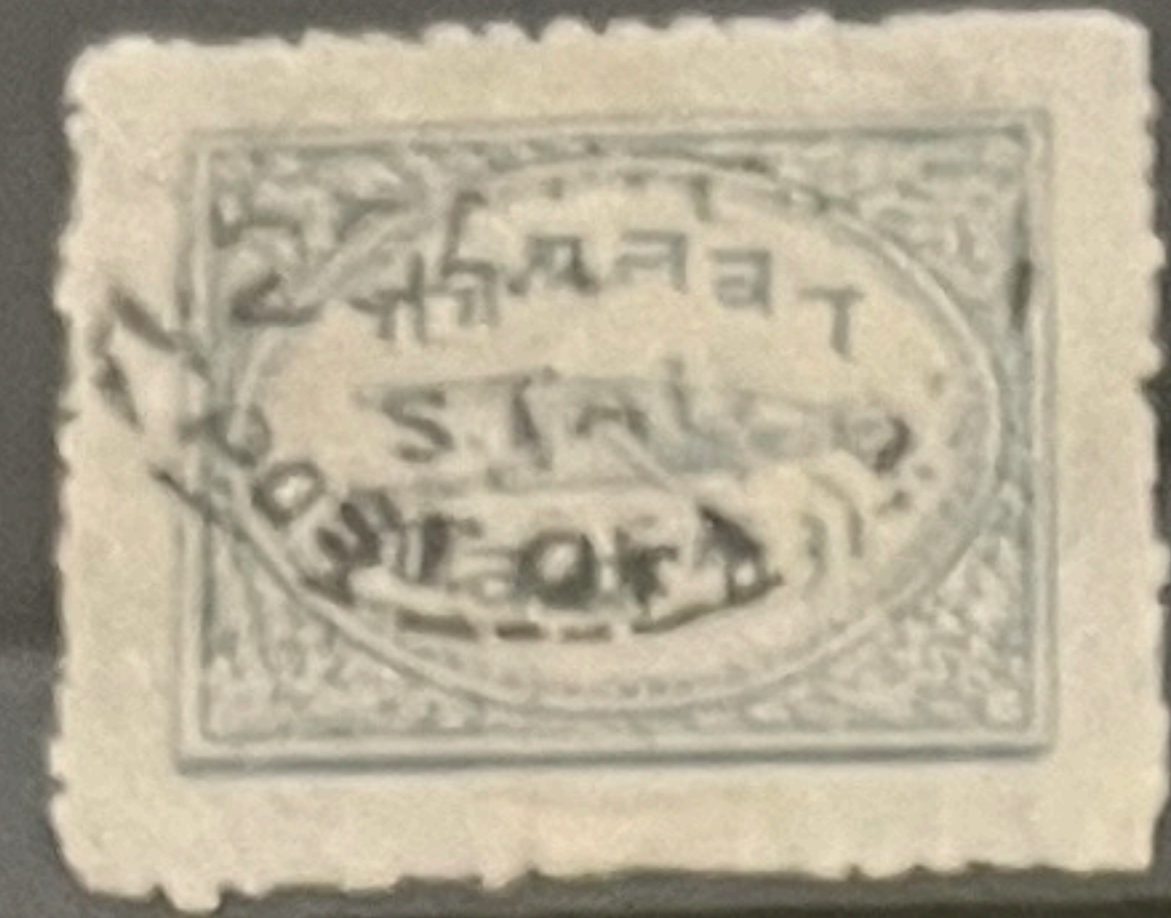
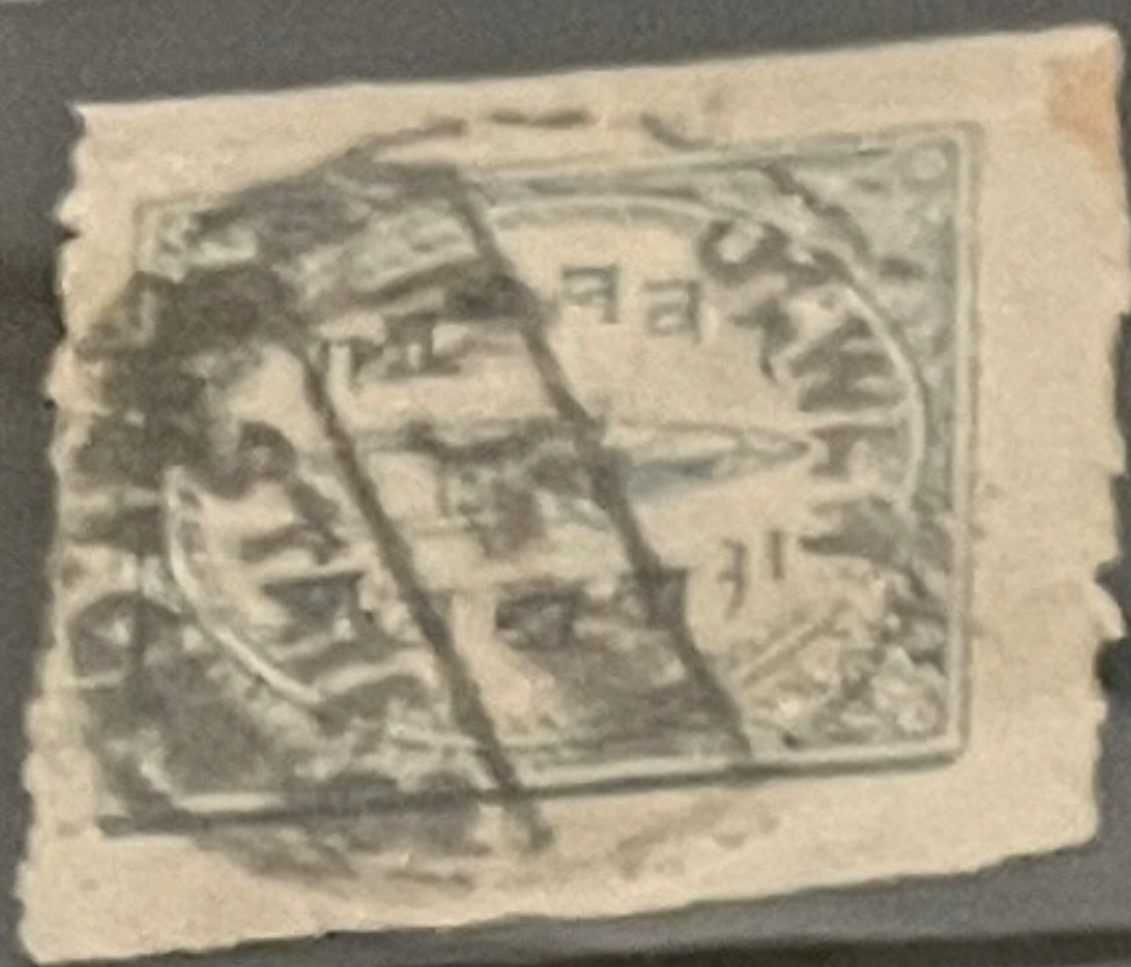
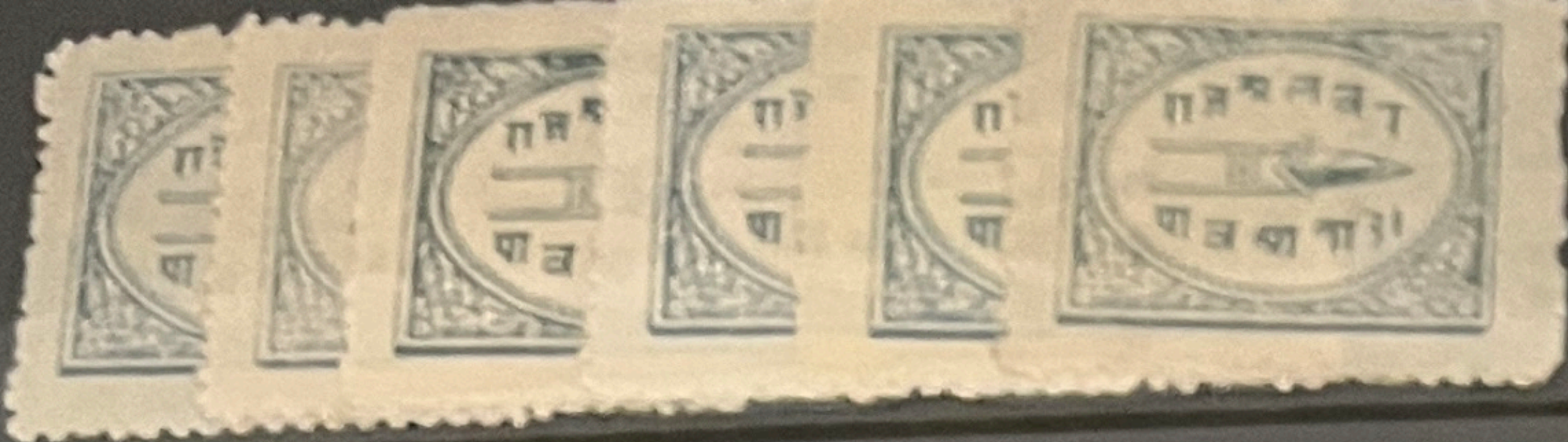
