

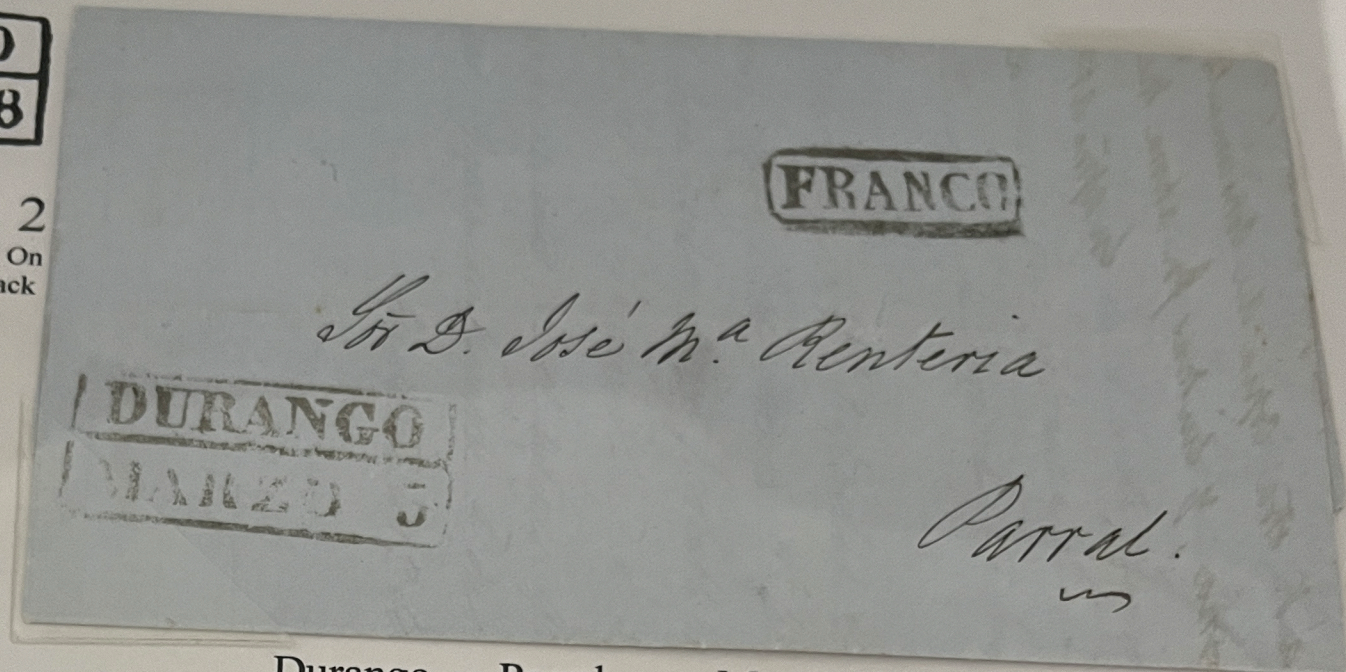

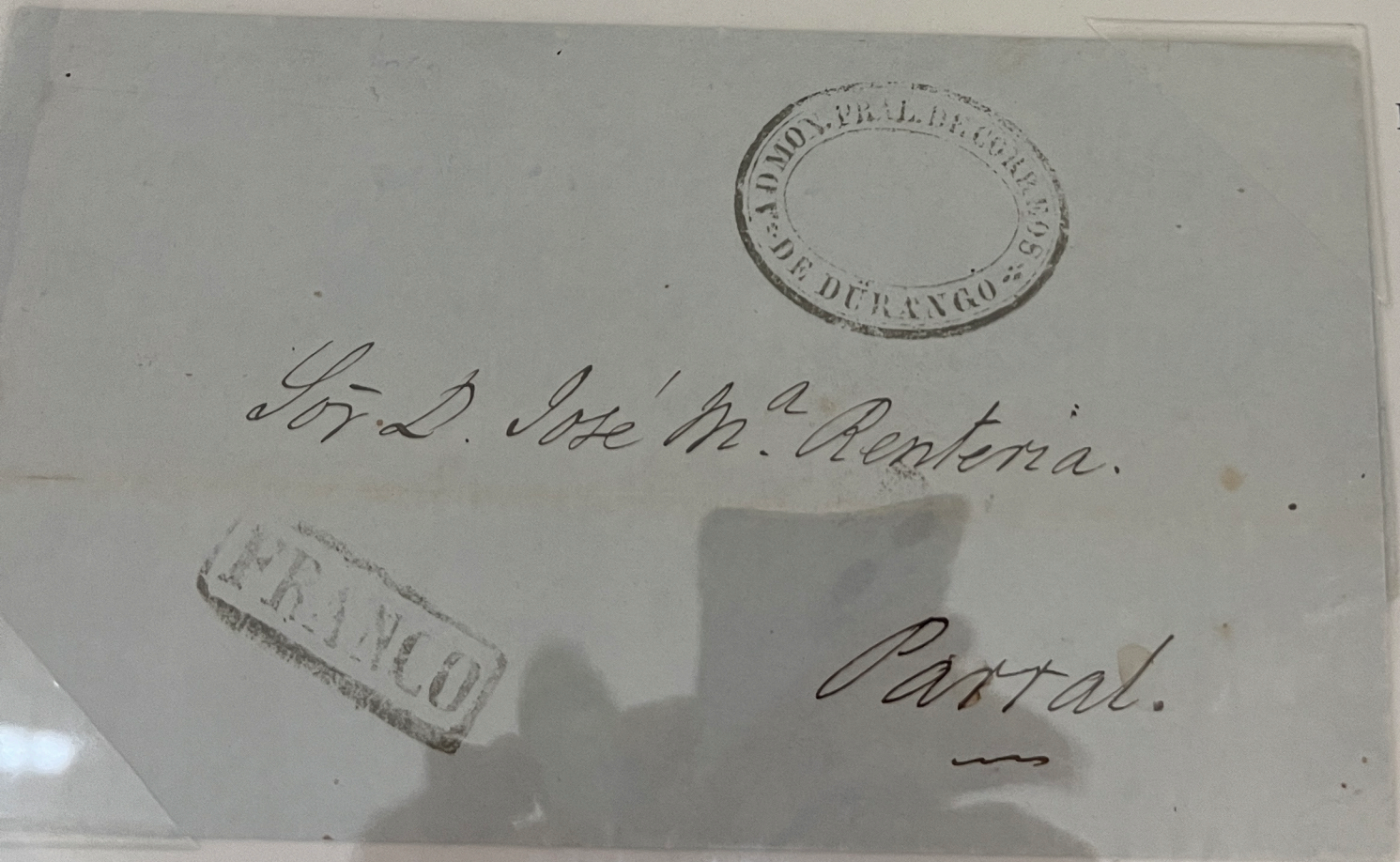


Durango --- Parral March 19, 1862
