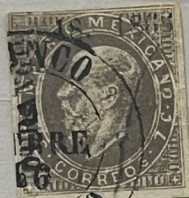
On April 10, 1864 Archduke Ferdinand Maximilian Joseph of Austria was declared and crowned Emperor of Mexico; on May 28, 1864 he arrived in Vera Cruz; and on June 17, 1867 he was executed by Liberal forces led by Benito Juárez.

For the district specialist, Durango is limited in scope

The Maximilian Issue ran from August 1, 1866 until April 23, 1867

No Durango usage is known after October 21, 1866.



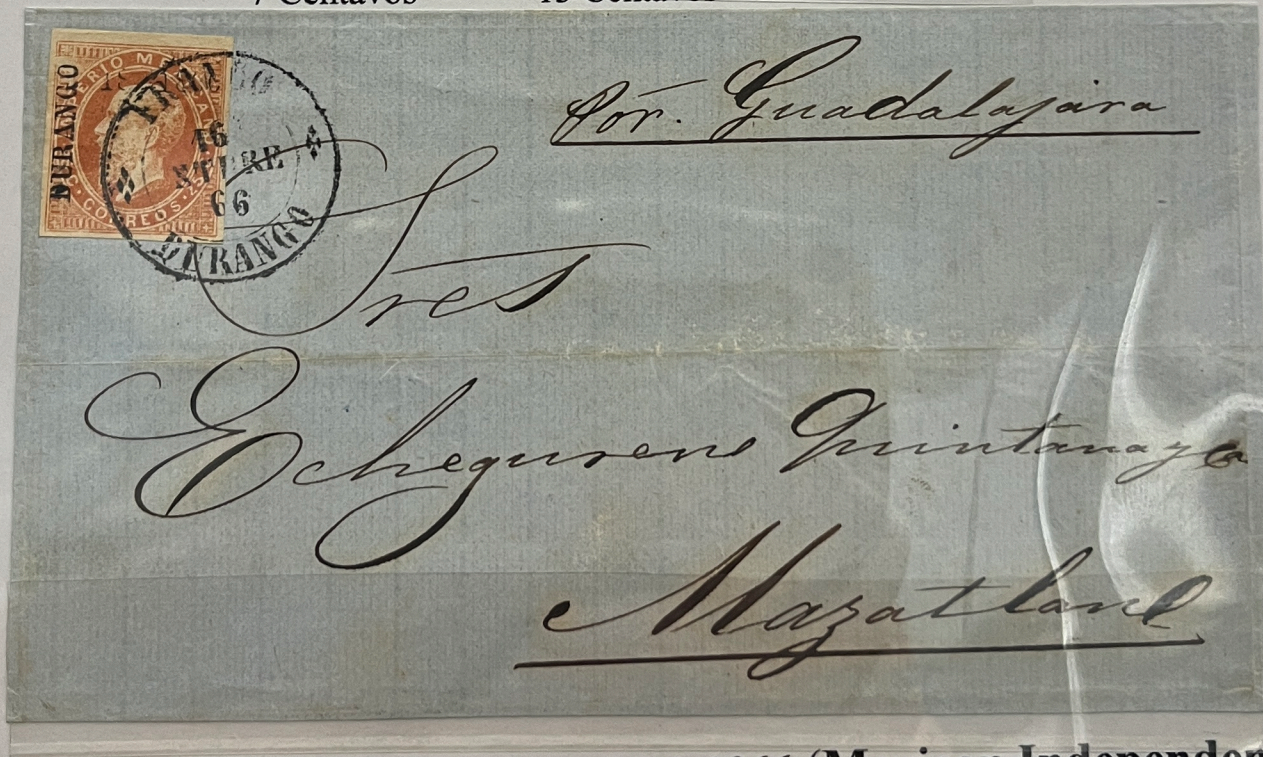
