STAMPS OF HAWAII

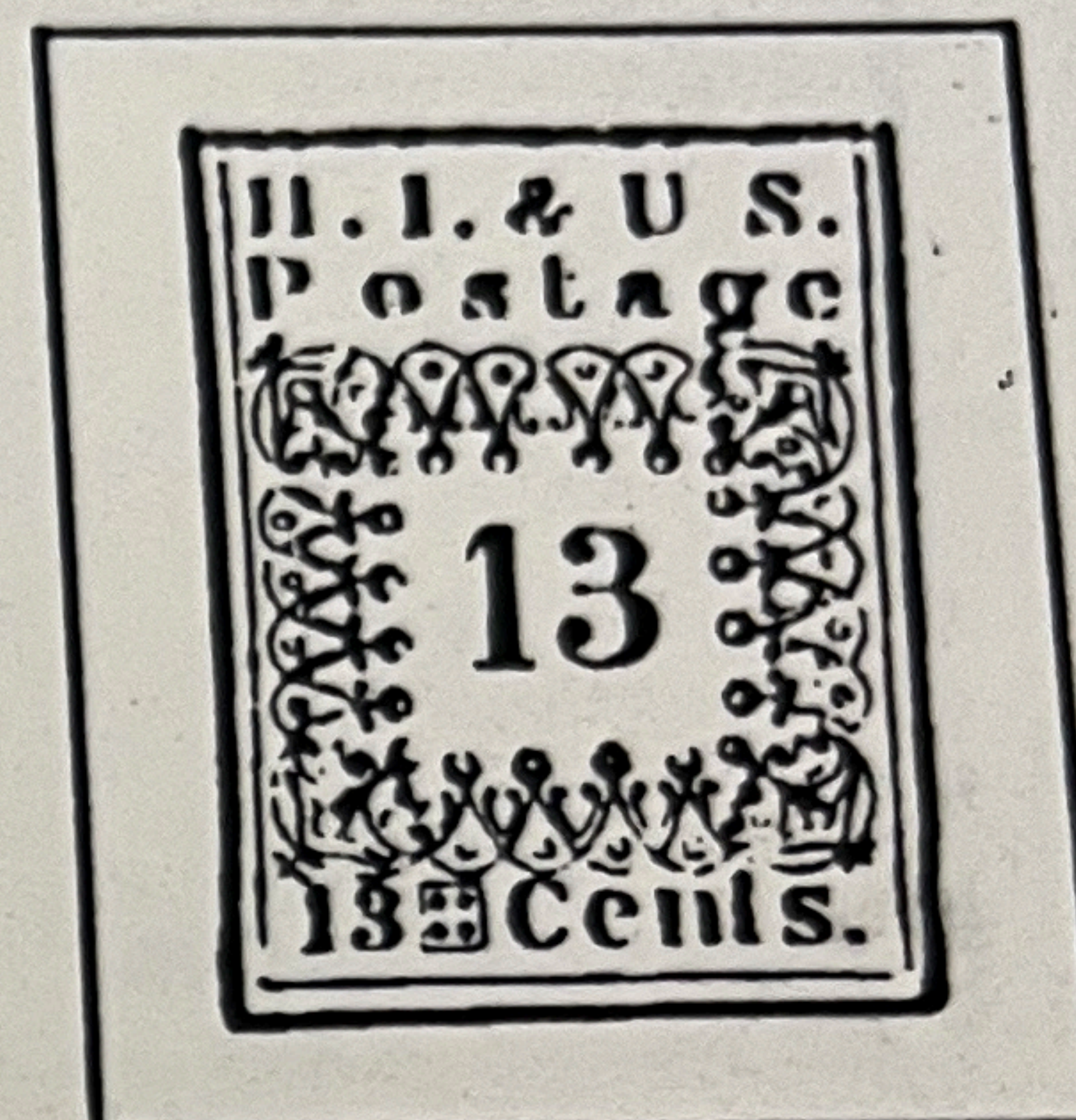
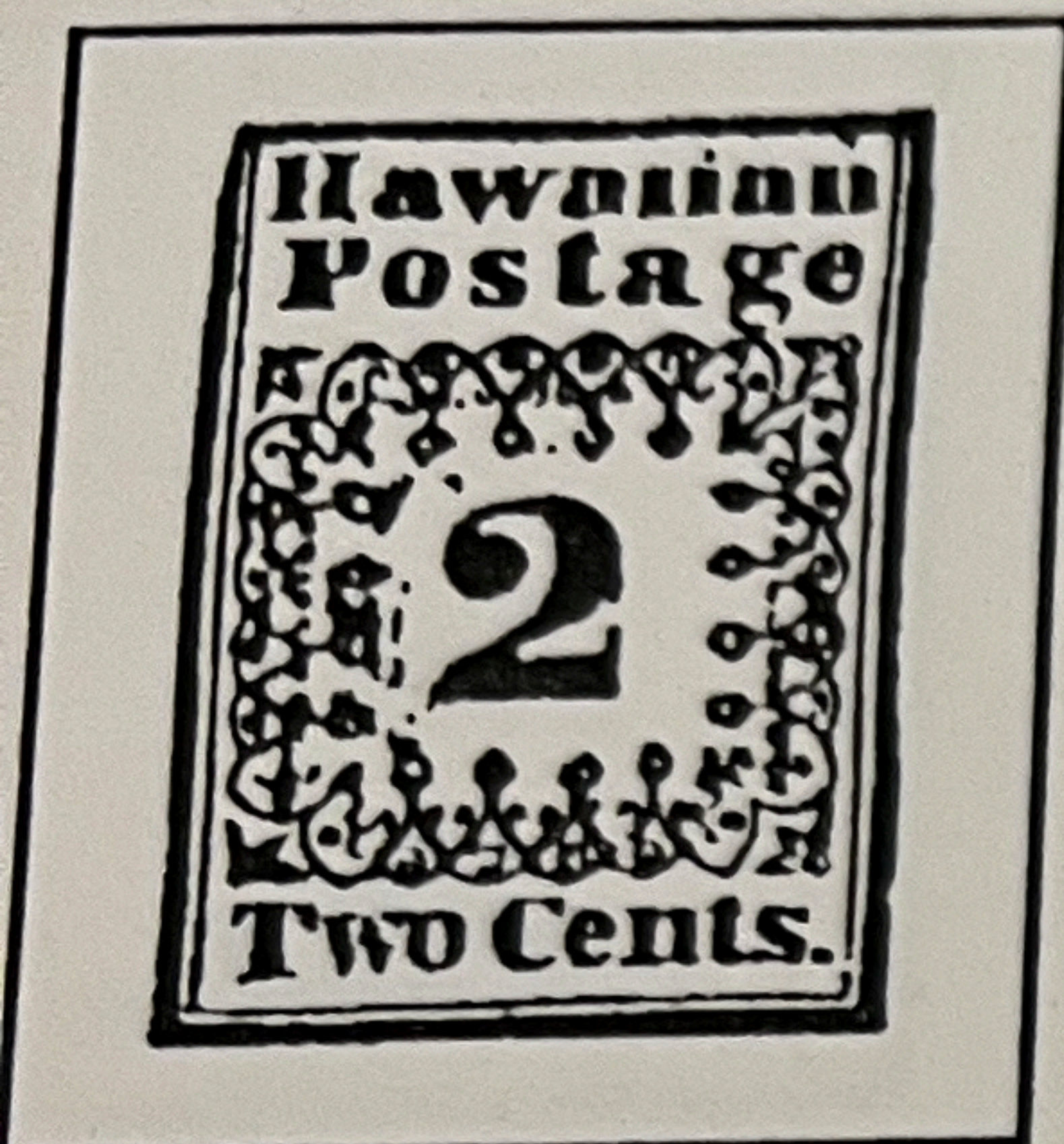
Until 1893, Hawaii was an independent kingdom. From 1893 - 1898 it was a republic. At the request of the inhabitants, Hawaii was annexed to the United States in 1898. Hawaiian stamps remained in use through June 13, 1900, and were replaced by U.S. stamps on June 14. In 1959 Hawaii became the 50th State of the Union. Hawaii consists of about 20 islands in the Pacific, about 2,000 miles southwest of San Francisco. The area is 6,434 square miles and the population was estimated at 150,000 in 1899. Honolulu is the capital.*
