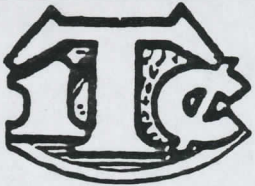
The 5¢ to 50¢ values were overprinted 'WAR / TAX' in two lines and released on February 12, 1915. These were intended for fiscal use, the tax on postal matter being only 1¢. A few were postally used.

In Die I there is a long horizontal coloured line under the foot of the "T", and a solid bar of colour runs upwards from the "1" to the "T".

In Die II this solid bar of colour is absent, and there is a short horizontal line under the left side of the "T", with two short vertical dashes and a number of dots under the right-hand side.
