## REVENUE

### STAMPS

1873 to 1946

It is interesting to note that the population of Reunion circa 1850 consisted of 112,000, composed of 30,000 whites, 9500 French, 5000 Indians, and 68,000 slaves. The population did not grow much by the time adhesive revenues were first issued in 1873. The capital, St. Denis, had a general population of approximately 20,000. The highest elevation on the island is slightly over 11,000 feet. Discovered by a Portuguese explorer, it quickly came under the French. It was briefly occupied by the British in 1810 but returned to the control of France where it has remained.

The revenue stamps used in 1873 were produced in Reunion and were used on notes, bonds, promissory notes, receipts, etc. In 1878 the format again changed. Taxes were proportional to the value of the document. In 1881 tax rates changed. The use of manuscript overprinting was authorized since they did not have the correct stamp denominations. The official cachet, using dual currency, became available a short time later. In 1884 the revenue stamps were again revised: this time using dual currency as part of the design. By 1907 overprinting of postage stamps for revenue usage became common once again due to scarcity of stamps to fill the need. In 1908 French revenue stamps were introduced "overprinted" with the island name. This usage of overprinted French revenues was in use up through 1946.
