FLIGHTS OF THE SACHSEN (LZ-17)

Flown "SACHSEN" card with the 5 pf. imprinted stamp, the on-board cancellation and on an official Gustav Eyb airship card. Cancelled and flown on May 25, 1913. Sieger #8X.



Close examination of this card reveals an interesting story. The sender had originally prepared this card to be sent on the Viktoria Luise on the flight of October 13, 1912. However as this was a special flight for the National Flight Fund, only official Flight Fund cards were allowed.

Thus the card was not dispatched until the following May when the sender added the word "Sachsen" over the word Luftschiffes, added the remark that the Zeppelin was at a time over the town of Esslingen and added the date, May 25, 1913, in his handwriting.

The card was properly flown from Baden Oos to Stuttgart and then back to Oos.

FLIGHTS OF THE "SCHWABEN" (LZ-10)

To raise funds for the associated Hessian charities special flights carrying souvenir mail were made by the "Schwaben" in June 1912. Special cards with appropriate inscriptions were printed and sold. A series of six semi-official air mail stamps were issued.
