GOVERNMENT—A Danish possession ceded to the British in 1814. Until 1890 was a British colony. In that year it was formerly ceded to Germany and since 1892 has formed a part of the Prussian province of Schleswig-Holstein. German stamps superseded those of Heligoland in 1890.

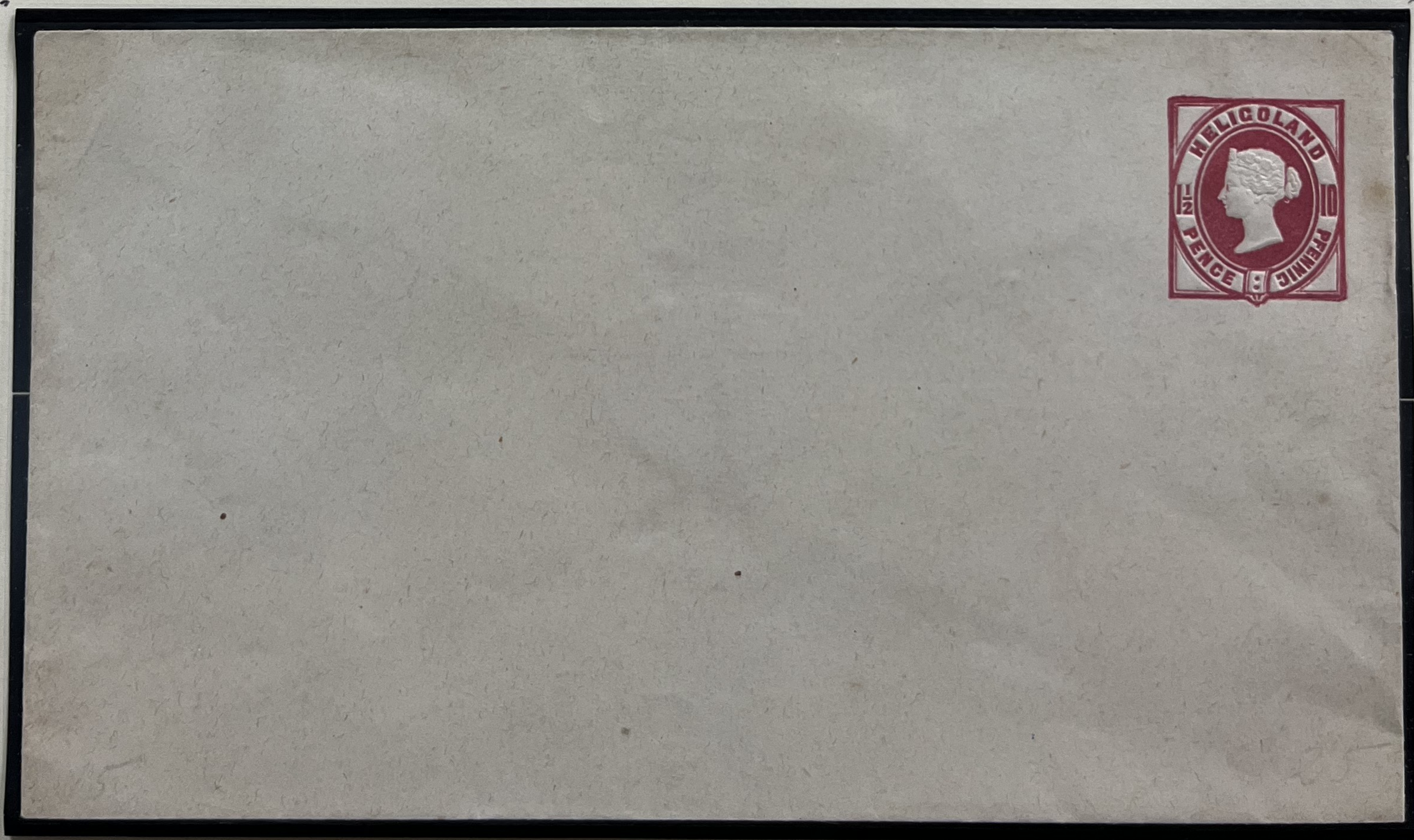

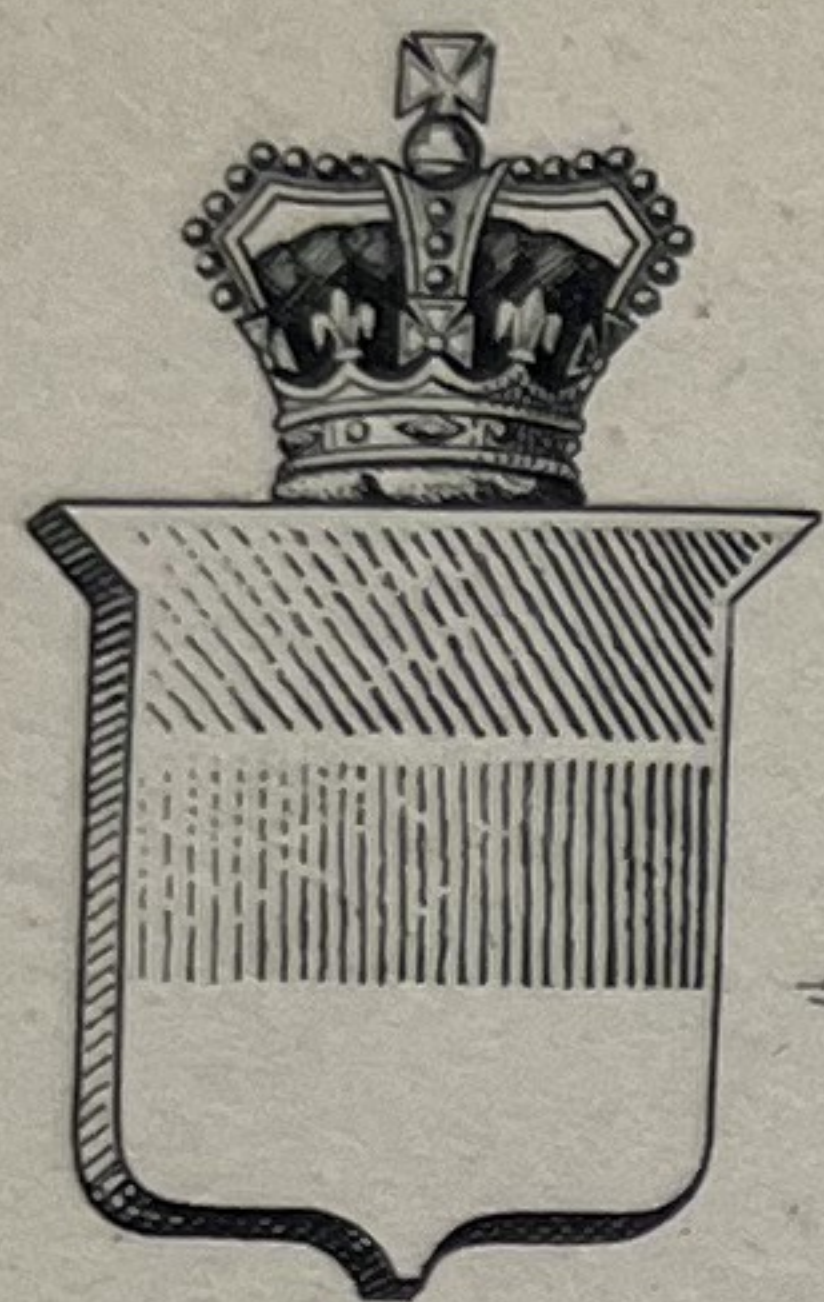
