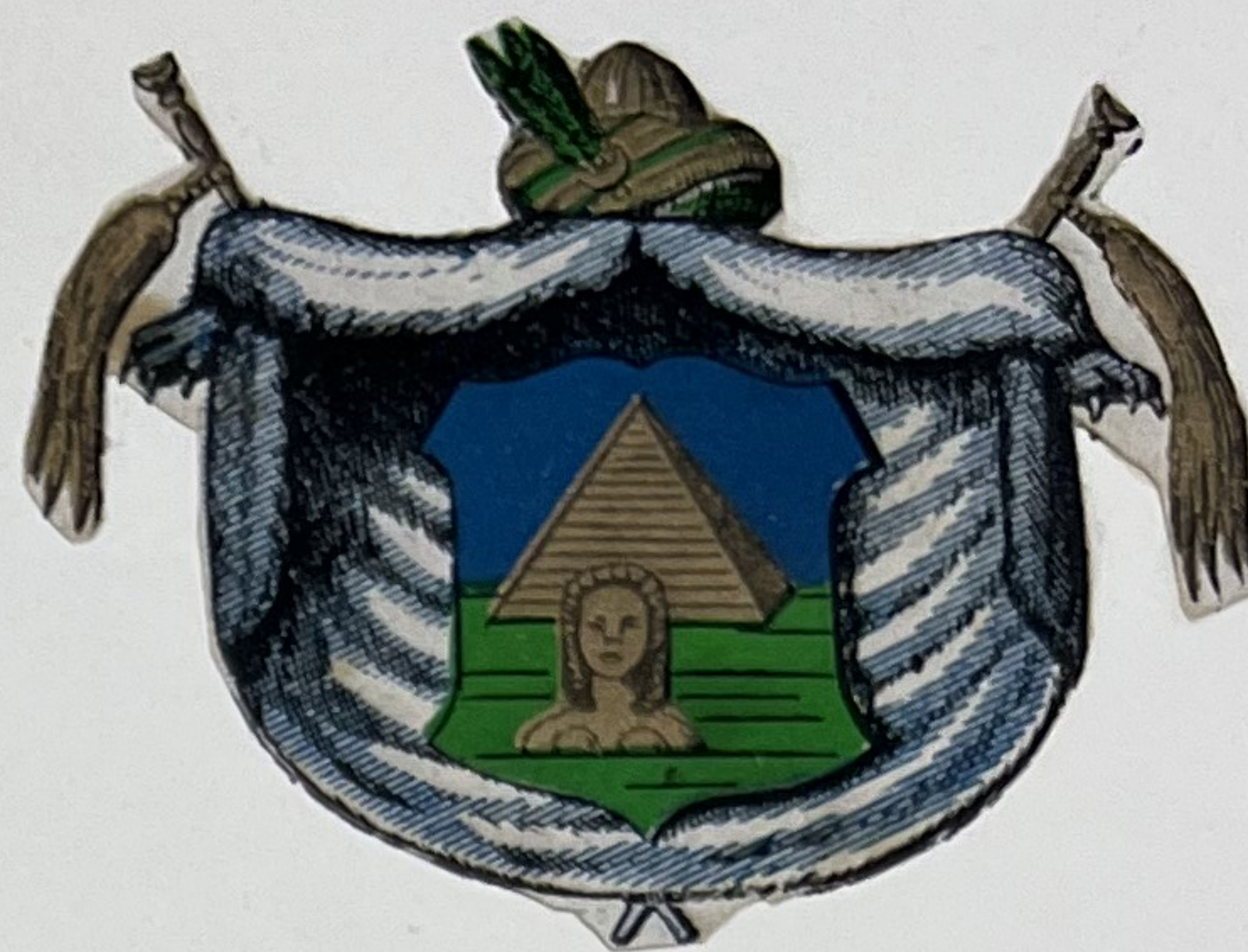


EGYPT

GOVERNMENT—Kingdom; prior to the war, a Khedivate under the suzerainty of Turkey. Announced as a British protectorate when Turkey declared war against the Allies. Recognized by Great Britain as a sovereign State in 1922. CAPITAL—Cairo.
 COINAGE—40 paras=1 piaster. 1000 miliemes=100 piasters=1 pound.

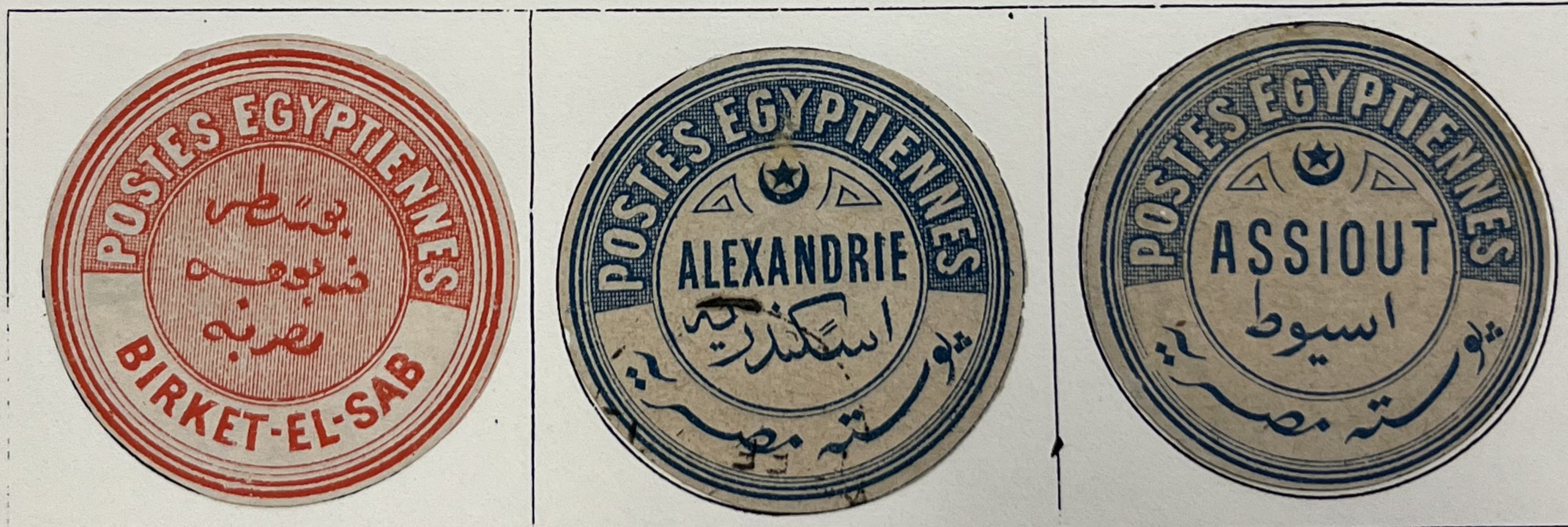
