CA SIDEWAYS

LEEWARD ISLANDS

GOVERNMENT—British colony comprising a group of islands in the West Indies. They derive their name from being less exposed to the north east trade winds than the adjacent Windward Islands. The islands are under one governor and comprise a single colony divided into five presidencies; Antigua (with Barbuda and Reonda), St. Kitts (with Nevis and Anguilla), Dominica, Montserrat and the Virgin Islands.
 CAPITAL—St. John, Antigua.
 COINAGE—12 pence=1 shilling.

GOVERNMENT—From 1854 to 1900 an independent republic known as the Orange Free State. From May, 1900, to June, 1910, known as the Orange River Colony; and since then, under the style of Orange Free State, a province of the Union of South Africa. CAPITAL—Bloemfontein.

GOVERNMENT—Republic, formed by the Boers in 1882. Occupied by Great Britain in 1884 and annexed and incorporated in the Colony of British Bechuanaland in 1885.

GOVERNMENT—According to the Anglo-Egyptian convention of 1899, an Anglo Egyptian condominium was established over the Sudan and administration placed in the hands of a governor-general to be nominated by the British government and appointed by royal decree of Egypt.
