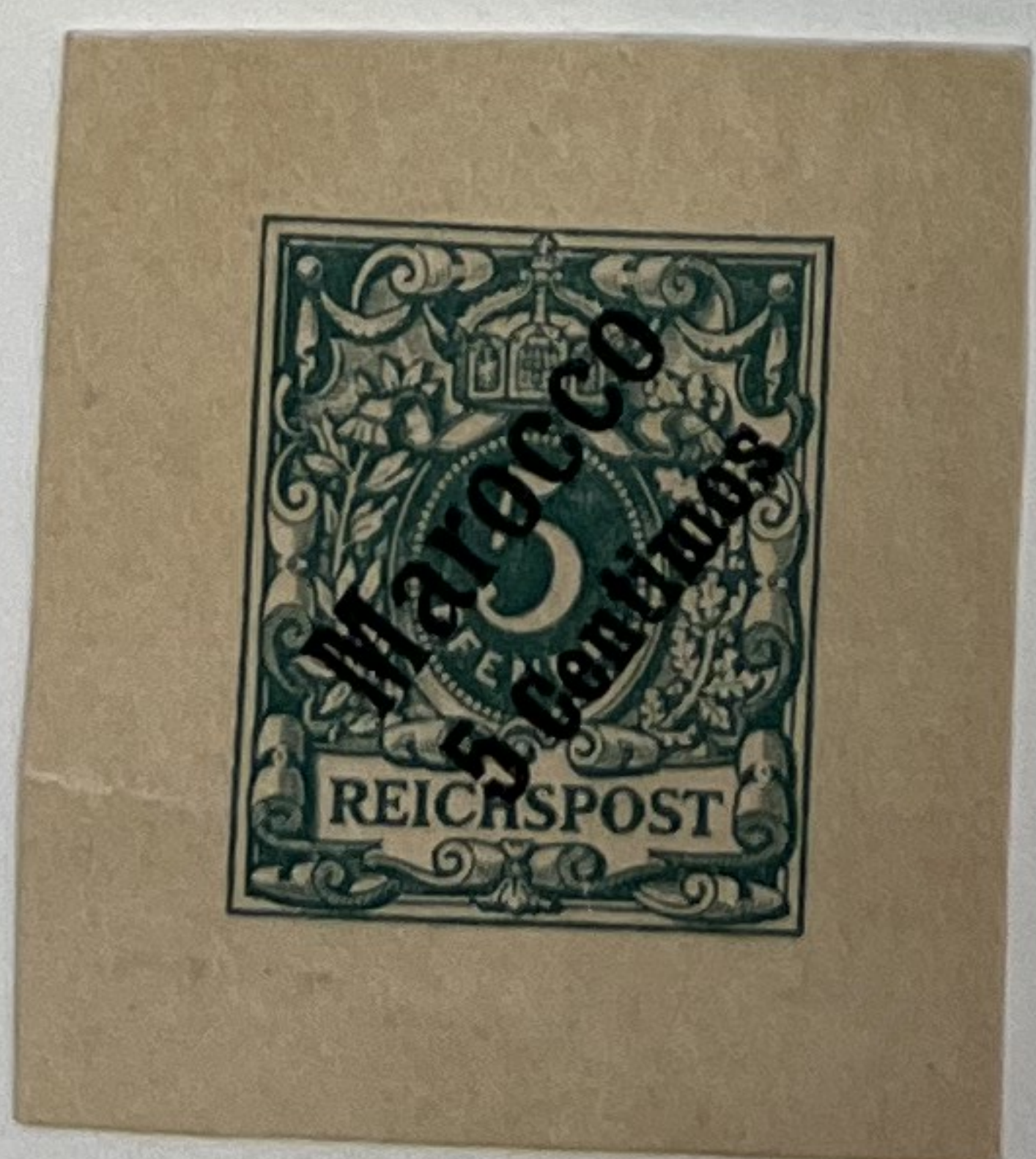

CAMEROONS

GOVERNMENT—Mandated Territory. Formerly German Colony. Lying on the west coast of Africa at the equator. Mandated to France and Great Britain by the Supreme Council July 20, 1922. France receiving portion now known as Cameroons. CAPITAL—Yaunde.
COINAGE—100 pfennig=1 mark. 12 pence=1 shilling. 100 centimes=1 franc.

CAROLINE ISLANDS

GOVERNMENT—Mandated Territory. Formerly German possession. An archipelago in the Pacific Ocean east of the Philippine Islands. Mandated to Japan by Versailles Treaty. Came into world prominence by the Island of Yap controversy.
 COINAGE—100 pfennig=1 mark. SEATS OF GOVERNMENT—Yap and Ponape.

GERMAN EAST AFRICA

GOVERNMENT—German colony on the east coast of Africa. CAPITAL—New Lagenburg.

COINAGE—64 pesas=1 rupie. 100 hellers=1 rupie. 100 centimes=1 franc. (Belg.) 12 pence=1 shilling. (British.) 100 cents=1 rupee.

G. E. A. was conquered by Belgium and British troops in the world war. The mandate to administer the country was given to Great Britain in May, 1919, but, by agreement of September, 1919, the part known as Ruanda Urundi was transferred to Belgium, and the Kionga triangle Portugal. The British mandate which comprises the largest portion is now known as Tanganyika.

GERMAN NEW GUINEA

GOVERNMENT—German colony, comprising the north east portion of the Island of Papua and the Bismarck Archipelago.

SEAT OF GOVERNMENT—Herbertshöhe.

COINAGE—100 pfennigs=1 mark.

Since the world war G. N. G. became a part of British New Guinea which is a dependency of Australia.

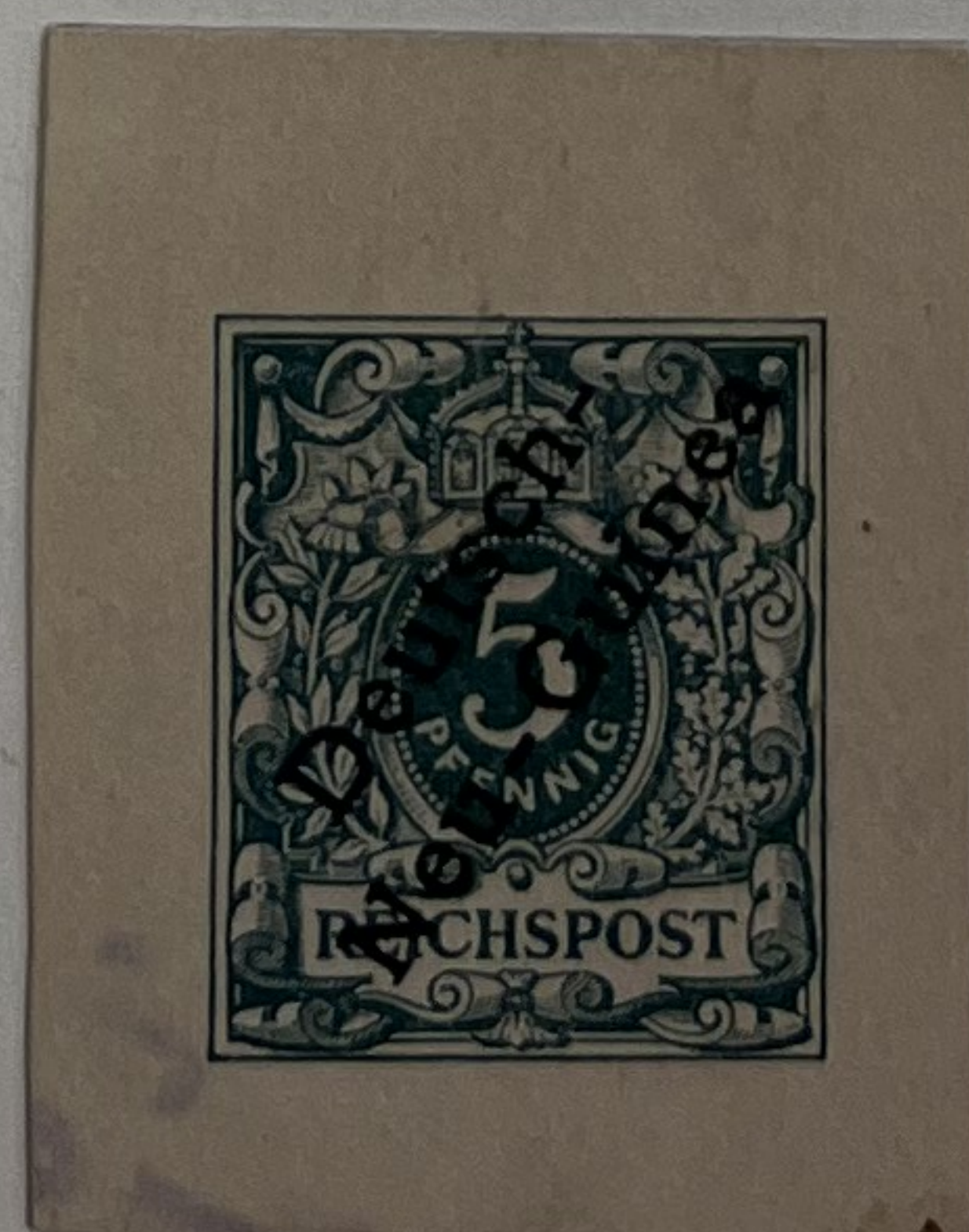

GERMAN SOUTH WEST AFRICA

GOVERNMENT—German colony until July, 1918, on the south west coast of Africa. CAPITAL—Windhoek. Surrendered to troops of the Union of South Africa on July 9th, 1915. Was administered from that date until the end of 1920 by martial law. On December 17th, 1920, was mandated to "His Britannic Majesty's Government" on behalf of the Union of South Africa.
 COINAGE—100 pfennig=1 mark (German).

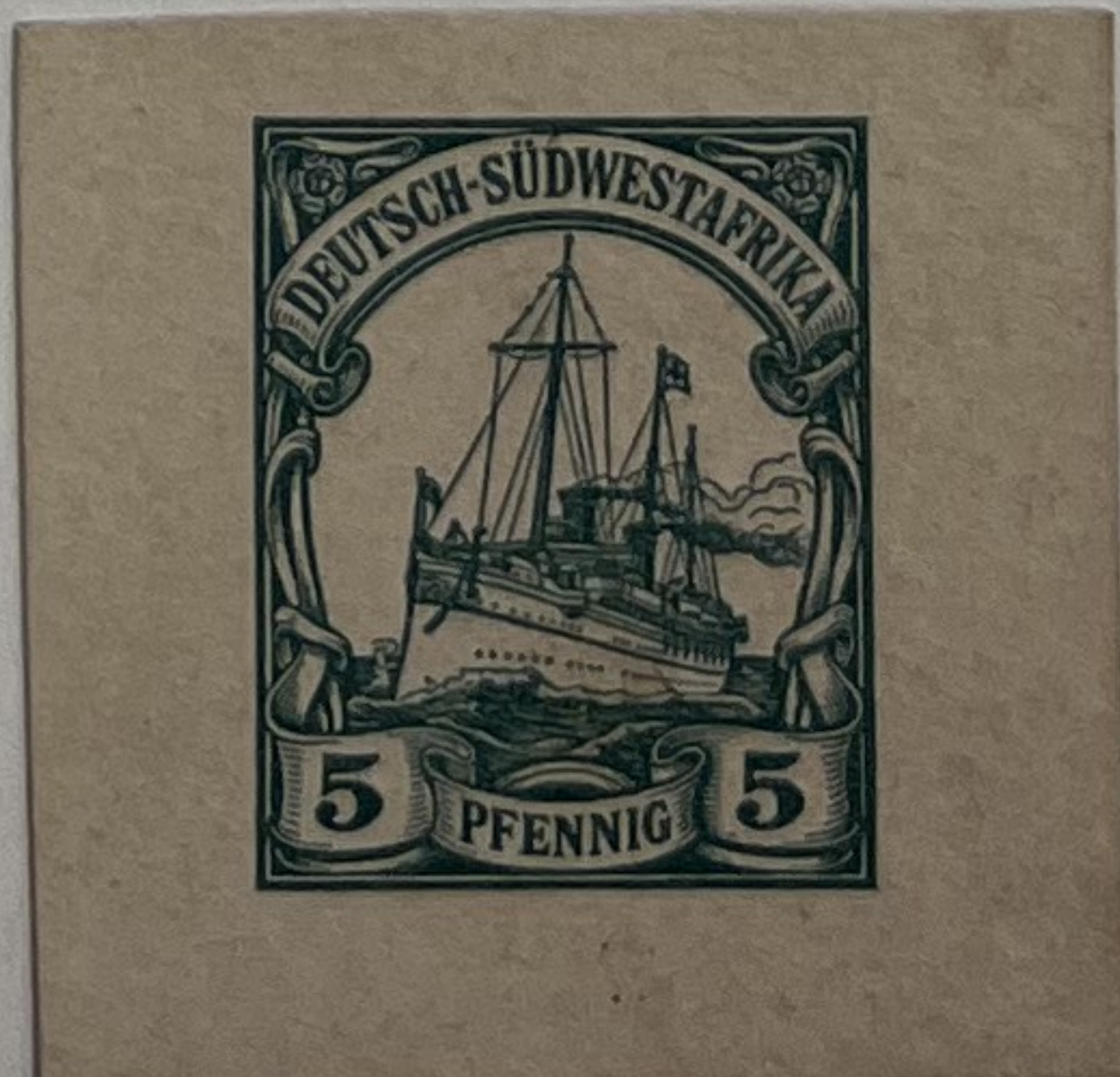
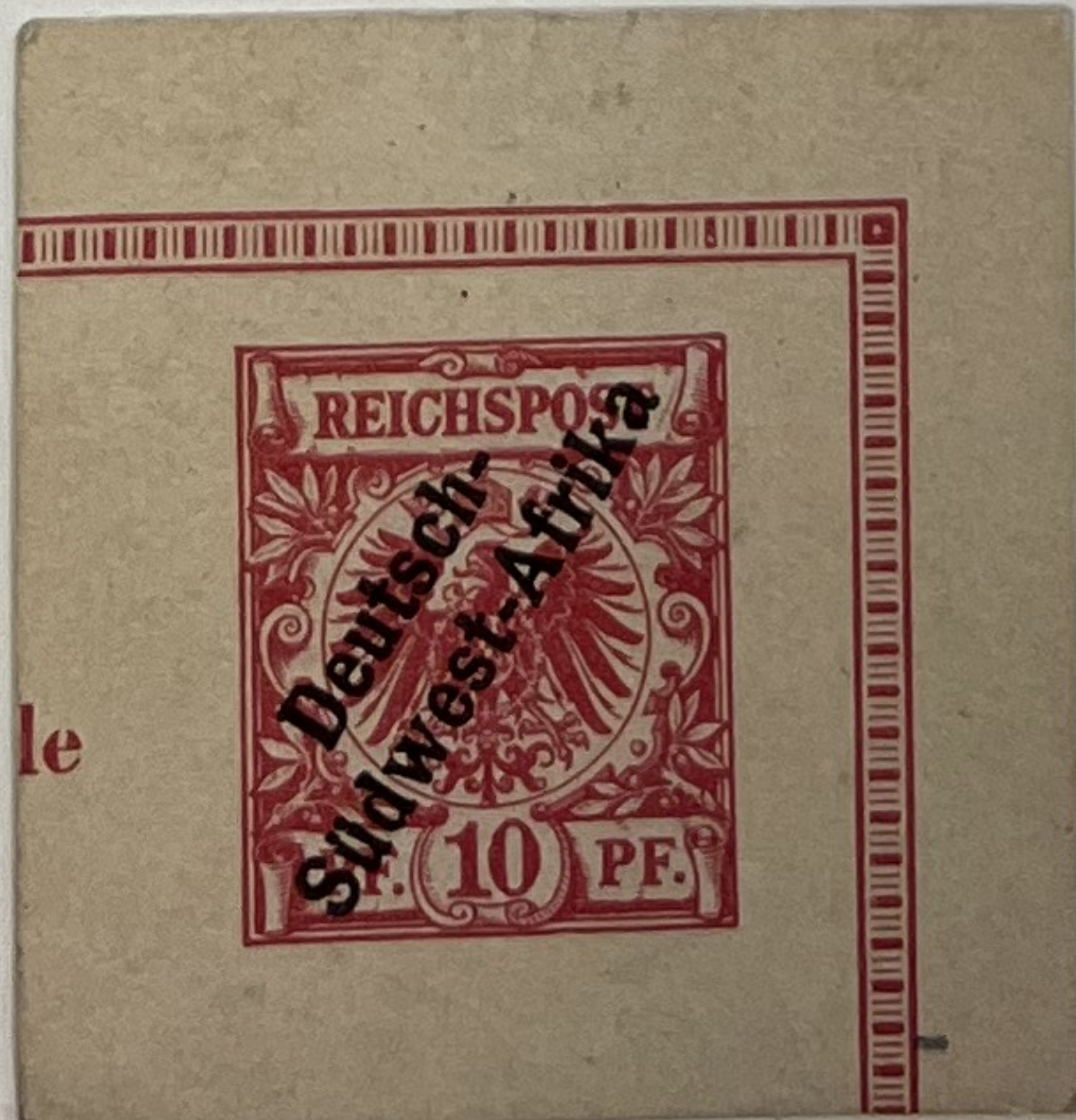

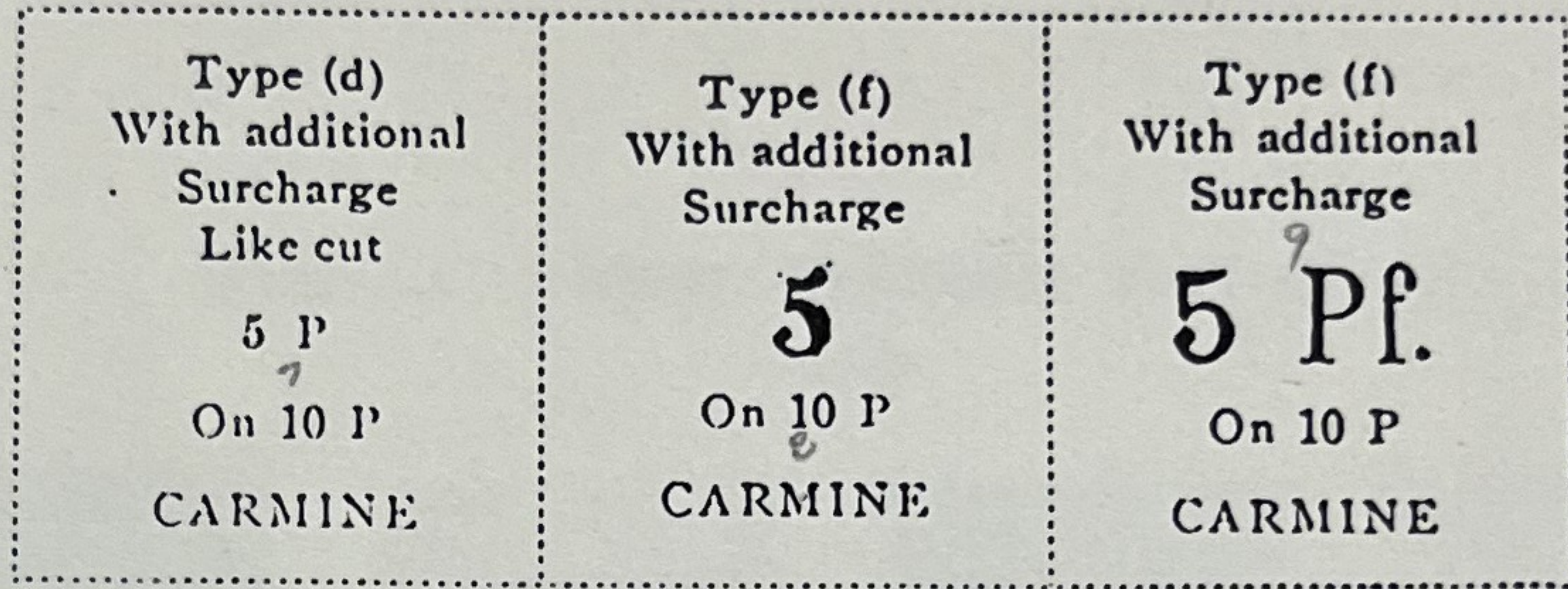

MARIANNA ISLANDS

GOVERNMENT—Spanish colony from 1668 to 1899. German colony 1899 to 1914, when it was seized by Japan. The mandate to Japan was recognized by the so-called "four power treaty," signed by the United States, Great Britain, France and Japan in 1921. CAPITAL—Sipan.

COINAGE—100 centavos=1 peso. 100 pfenning=1 mark.

MARSHALL ISLANDS

GOVERNMENT—German colony from 1885 to 1914. Was seized by Japan at the opening of the World War and recognized as a mandate to Japan by the so-called "four power treaty" signed by the United States, Great Britain, France and Japan in 1921. CAPITAL—Jaluit.

COINAGE—100 pfennig=1 mark.
