GOVERNMENT—Republic; formerly Spanish colony. In the West Indies off the coast of Florida. A member of the League of Nations. CAPITAL—Havana.

COINAGE—8 reals plata = 1 peso. 100 centimos = 1 escudo or peseta. 1000 milésimas = 100 centavos = 1 peso. 100 cents = 1 dollar. Until 1873 these stamps were used in Porto Rico as well.
