

FRENCH CONGO

GOVERNMENT—French possession in Africa comprising (1) Gabon colony, (2) the Middle Congo colony, (3) Ubangi-Shari-Chad colony. Officially renamed French Equatorial Africa in 1910. SEAT OF GOVERNMENT—Brazzaville. Separate stamps were used in Gabon since 1886. The first stamps for French Congo appearing in 1891 and discontinued in 1903 from which time stamps have appeared for the separate colonies as they have been segregated. Middle Congo, 1907. Ubangi-Shari, 1905. Chad, 1922,
 COINAGE—100 centimes=1 franc. (French)

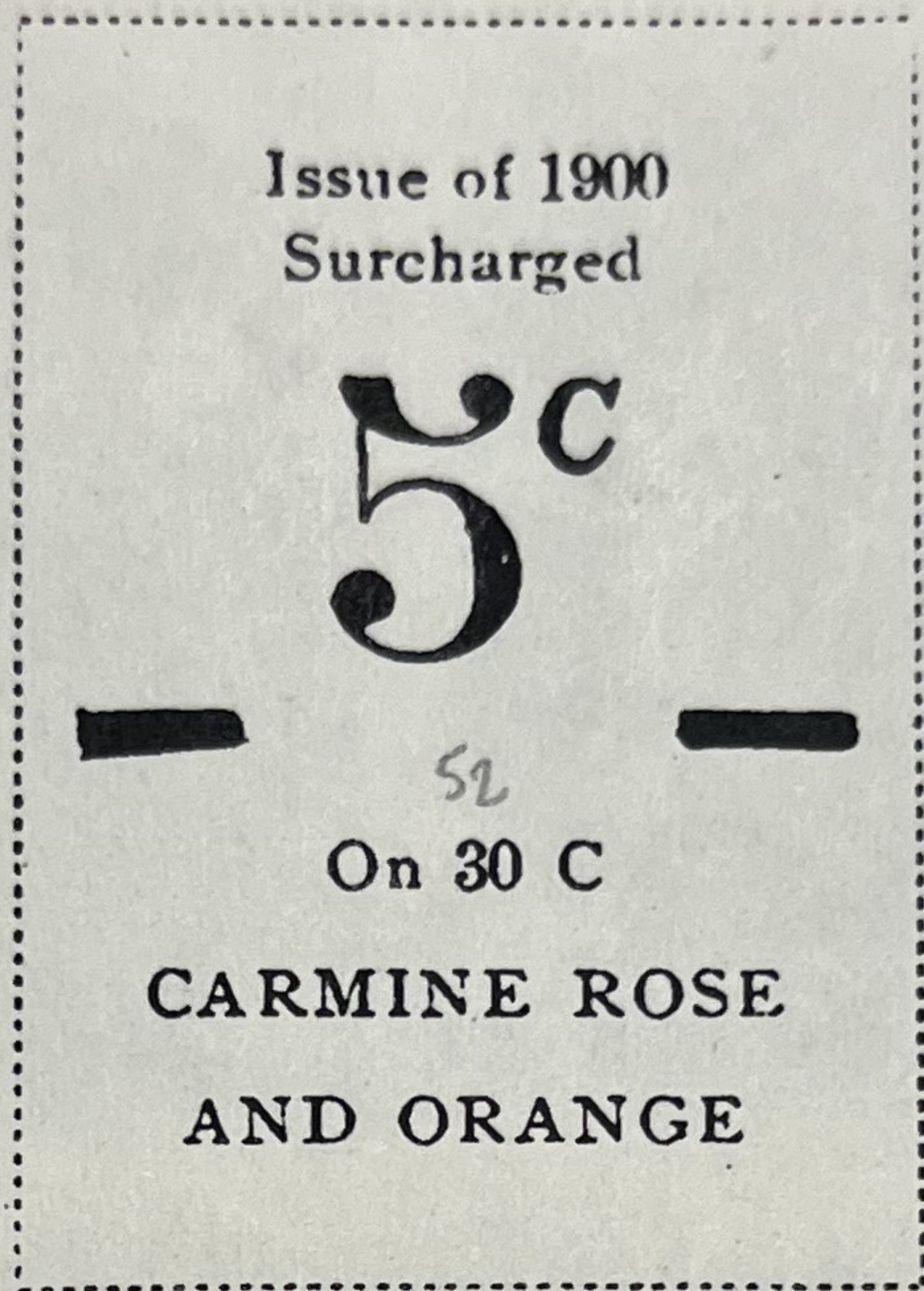
