STICK MAIL FOLD



NATIVE POSTAL RUNNERS AND COURIERS OFTEN CARRIED THEIR MAIL SECURED WITHIN THE SPLIT END OF A STICK OR BRANCH, HOLDING THE OTHER END SO THAT THEY HAD NOTHING ELSE TO HINDER THEIR RUNNING.

STICK MAIL CAN BE IDENTIFIED BEST BY THE DOUBLE VERTICAL FOLD THROUGH THE CENTER OF THE COVER, CAUSED BY THE PRESSURE OF THE WOOD AND THE FLAPPING BACK AND FORTH OF THE COVERS DURING JOURNEY.

THE RUNNERS OFTEN HAD BELLS ON THE ENDS OF THEIR STICKS, OR SEWED ON THEIR CLOTHING TO FRIGHTEN AWAY ANY ANIMALS THEY MIGHT ENCOUNTER.
