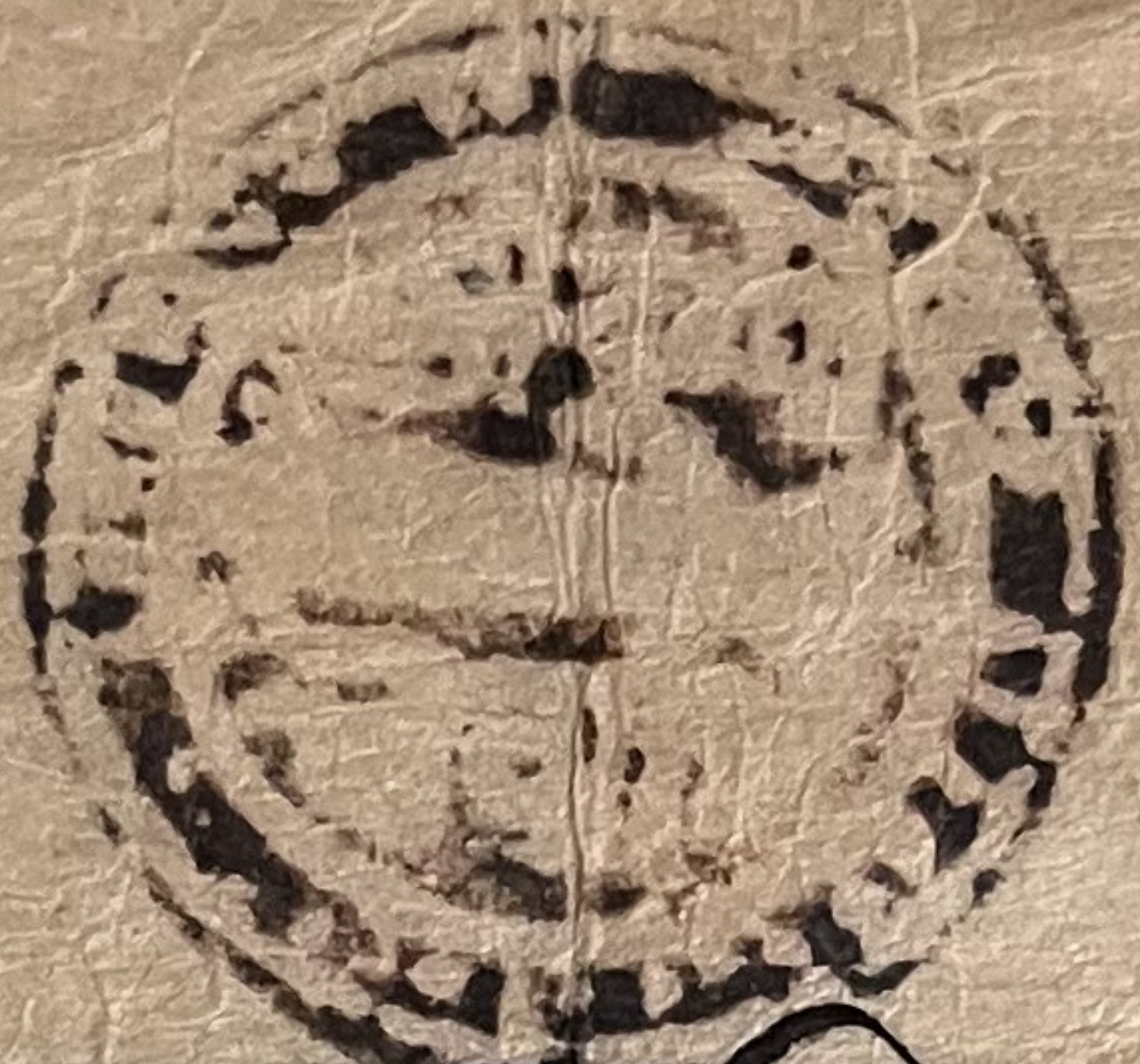

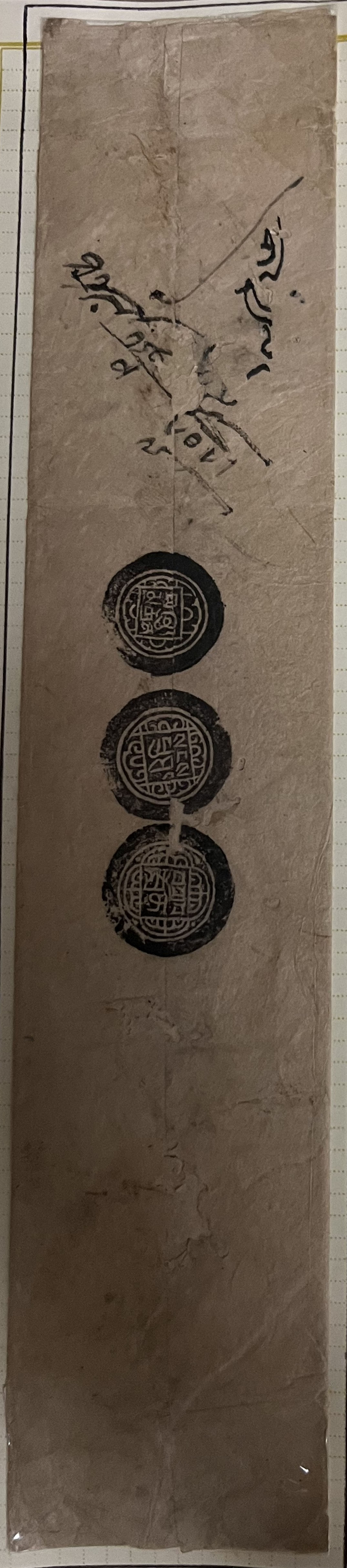

EDGED SWORD) AND TWO SMALL CRESCENTS
IN THE CENTER. THE INSCRIPTIONS ARE
"SRI DURGA" (NEPALESE GODDESS) AT TOP,
AND "BAWANI" (FEMALE) AT BOTTOM.

LOUDH WAS AN EAST INDIA COMPANY

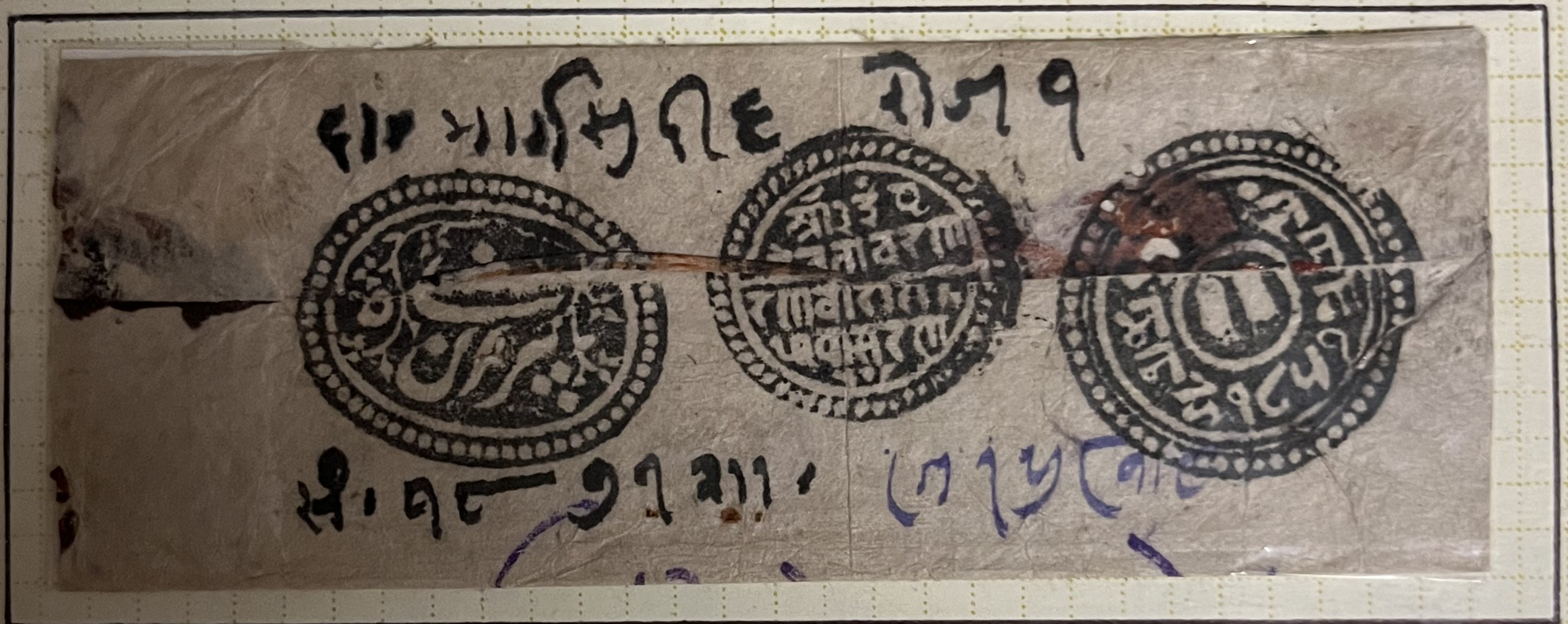
THE EARLIEST WRITTEN COMMUNICATIONS WERE DELIVERED BY TRADERS AS THEY PASSED THROUGH TOWNS WHILE ON THEIR BUSINESS JOURNEYS.

THE COMMUNICATIONS USUALLY WERE FOLDED LETTERS ABOUT 1" WIDE BY 3 1/2" LONG, ADDRESSED, IMPRESSED WITH THE SENDER'S PERSONAL WAX SEAL, AND TIED WITH PAPER STRIP. NO FEES WERE INVOLVED

THIS FOLDED LETTER WAS SENT FROM WITHIN TIBET TO KUTI SAUGAL, NEPAL IN 21812.

DEC. 21, 1814 COVER WITH THE SEALS OF
CHAUTARIA PRAN SHAH, KAJI RANABIR
SINGH AND KAJI DAL BHANJAN SHAH.

THEY WERE COMMANDERS IN THE ANGLO-
NEPALESE WAR OF 1814-1816, WHICH
HAD BEGUN 5 WEEKS PREVIOUSLY.

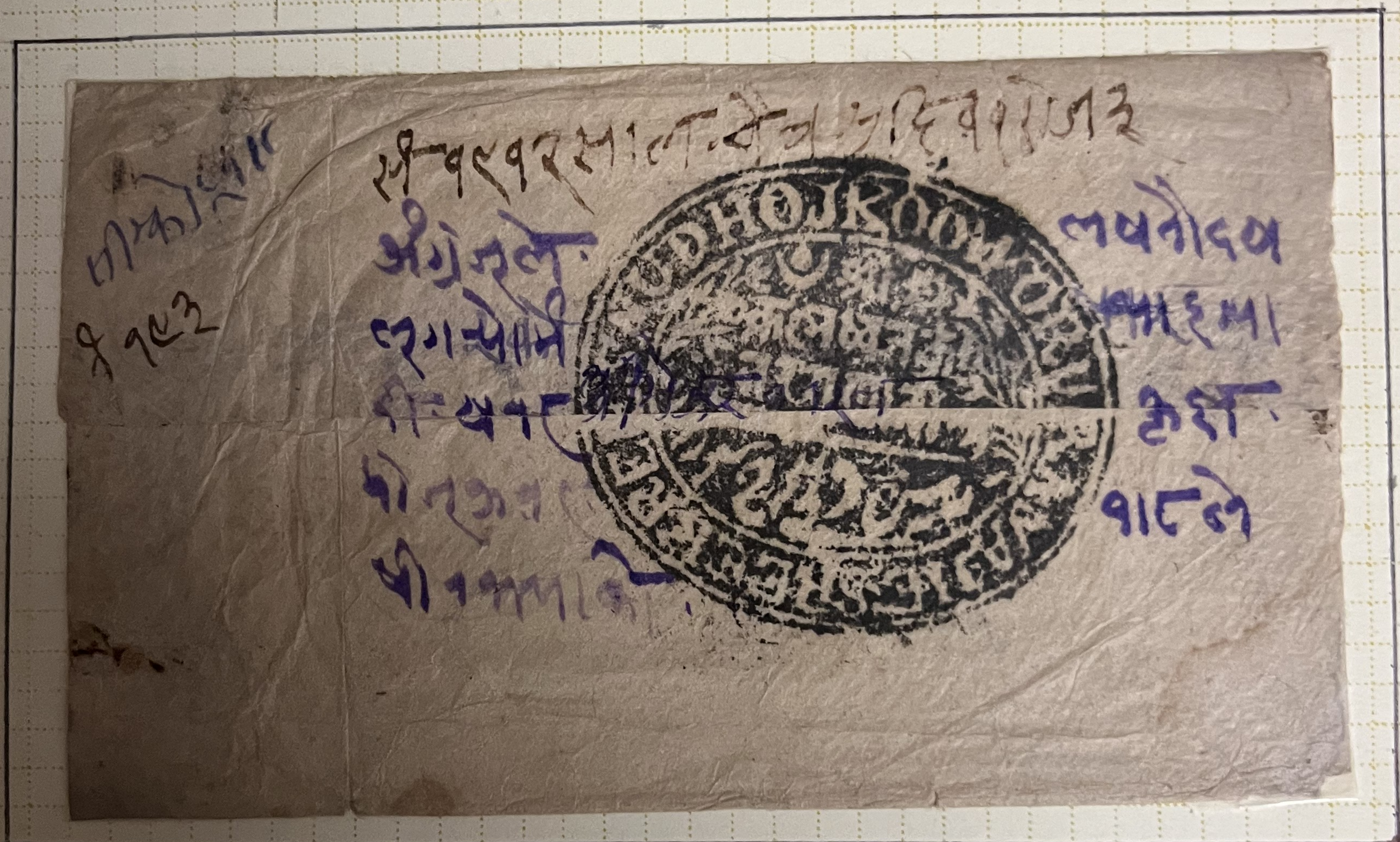

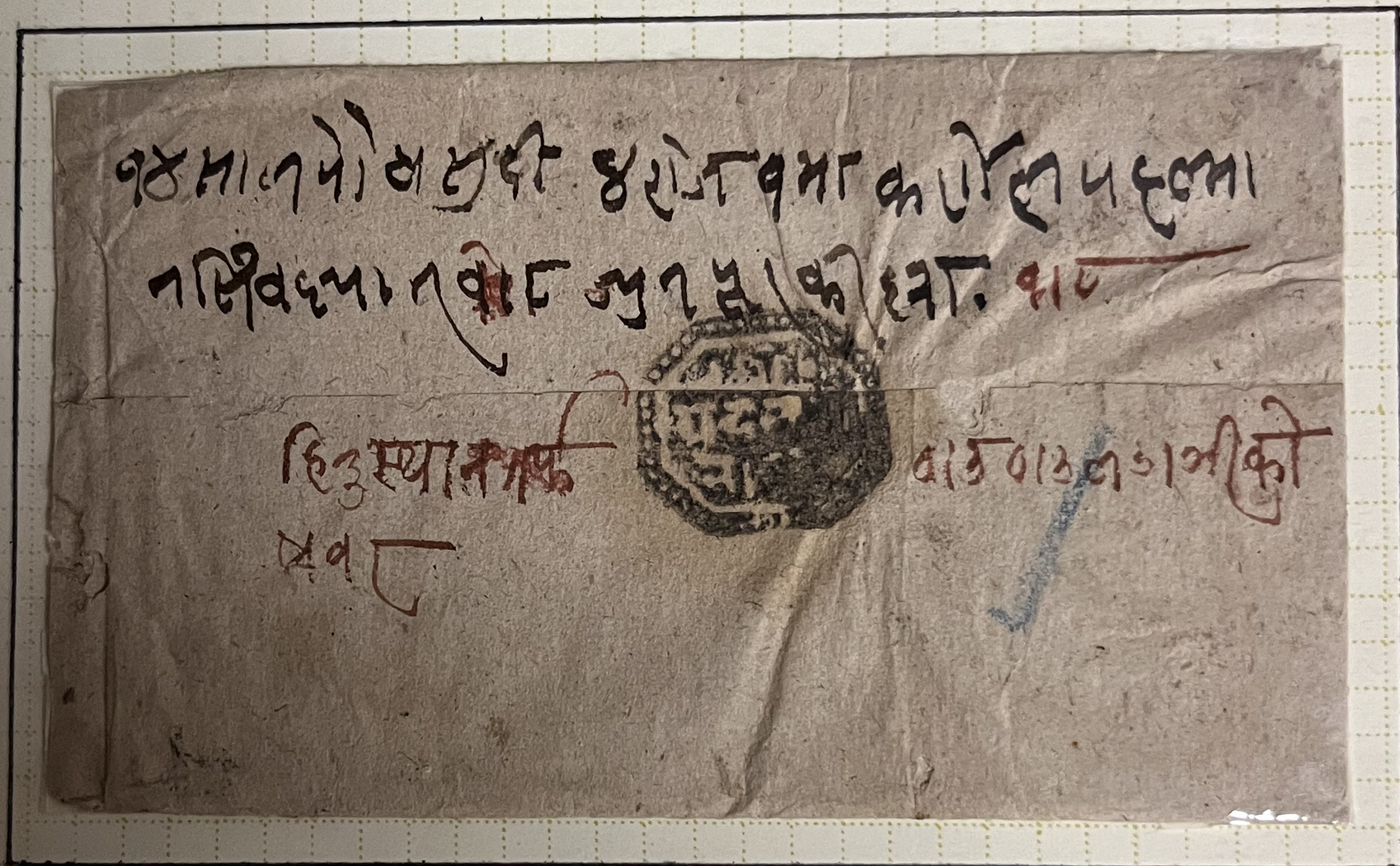

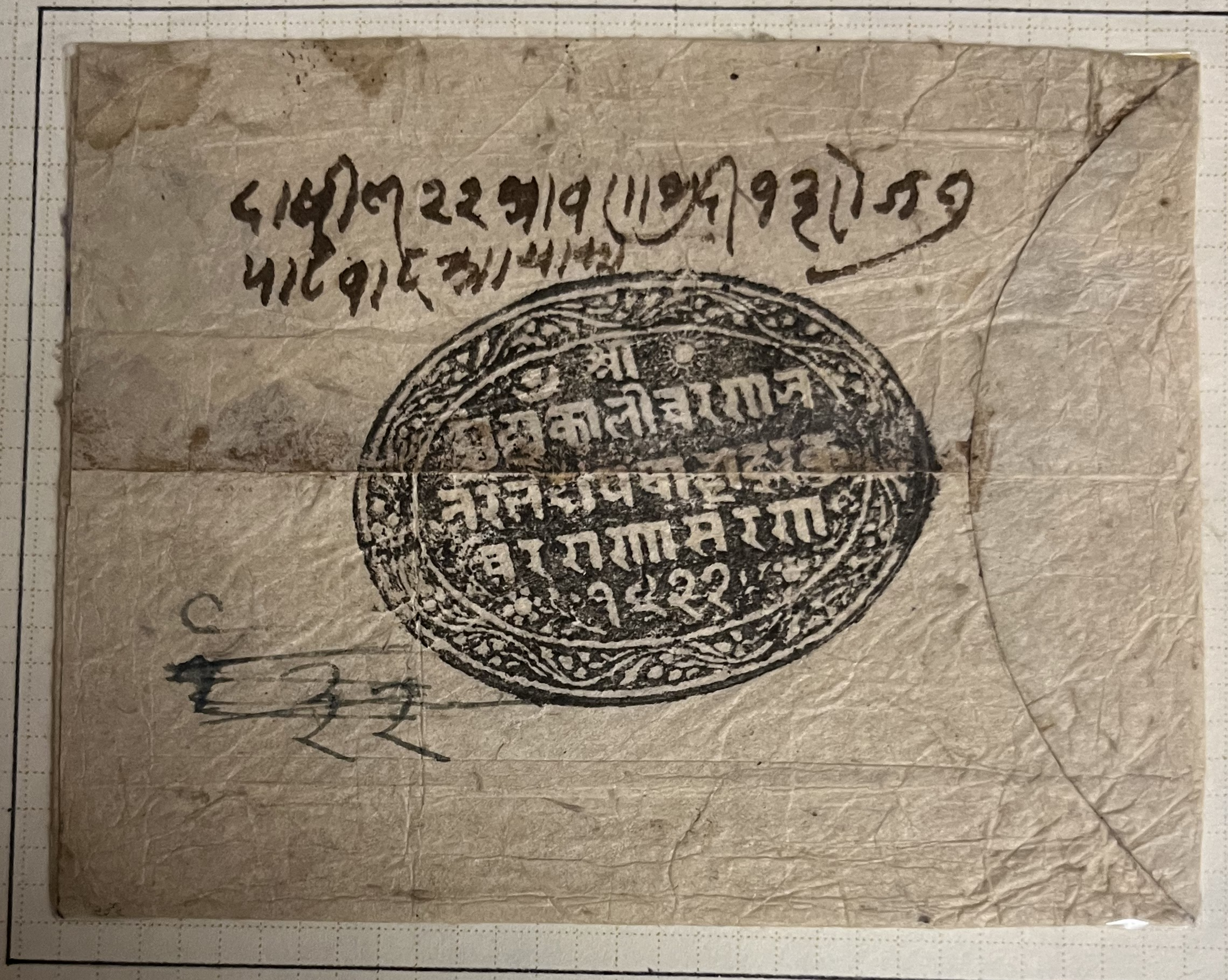

LUCKNOW FROM THERE. THE COVER
CONTAINED THE INFORMATION THAT
THE SEPOY MUTINY HAD BROKEN
OUT IN NUMEROUS PLACES IN INDIA.



JULY 1865 STAMPLESS COVER WITH OFFICIAL SEAL OF DEEP BAHADUR KUNWAR, BROTHER OF THE FIRST RANA PRIME MINISTER OF NEPAL, JUNG BAHADUR, SENT FROM PATAN, DISTRICT OF CHAINPUR, NEPAL TO HIS BROTHER, RANODIP SING, THE COMMANDER-IN-CHIEF OF THE NEPALESE ARMY.

THE COVER CONTAINED A LIST OF 4 PEOPLE FROM 1844 - 1865 WHO LEFT CHAINPUR TO GO TO DARJEELING TO SETTLE, TO TRADE, OR TO BECOME GURKHA SOLDIERS IN THE BRITISH ARMY.

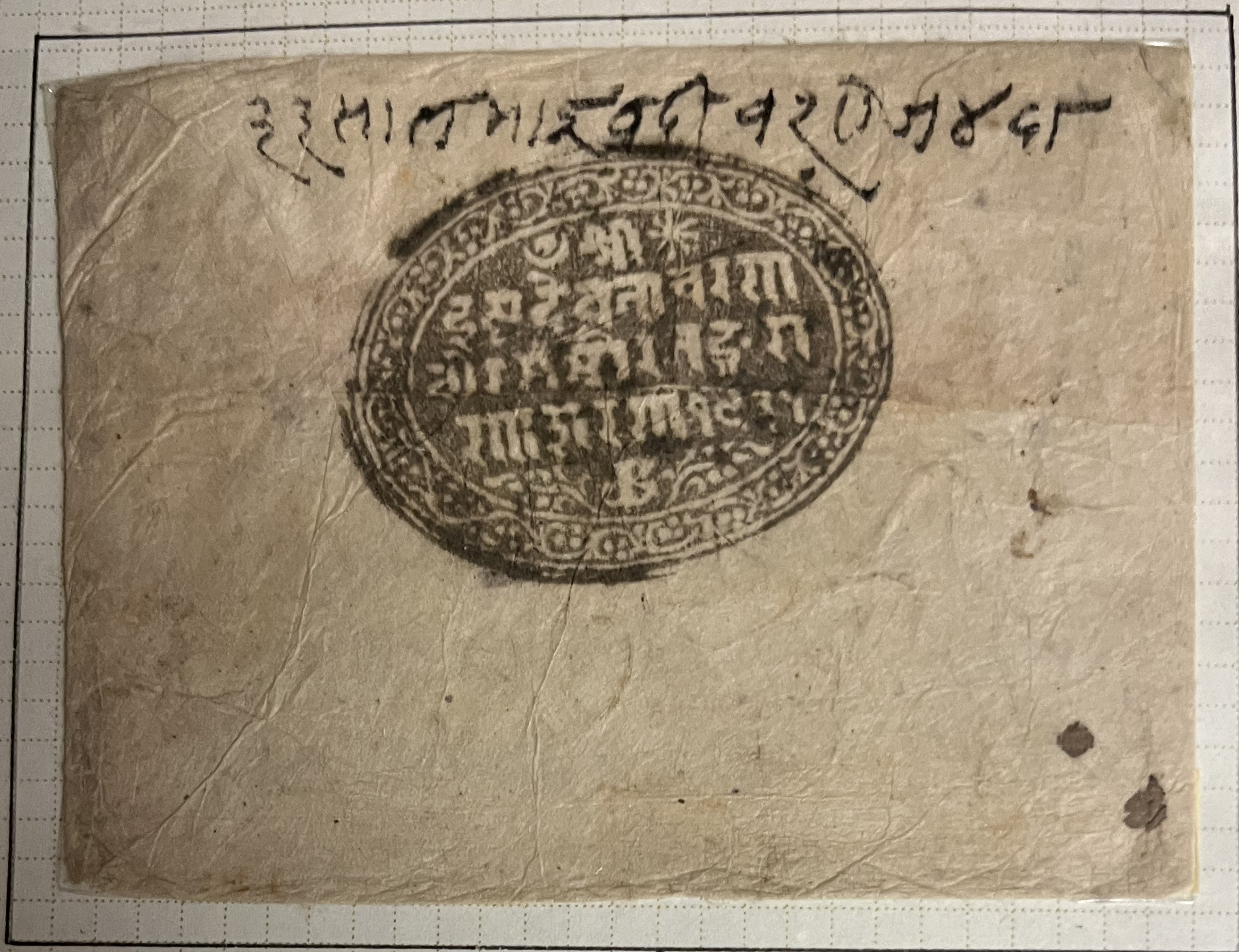

JUNG BAHADUR ASSUMED THE PRIME-MINISTERSHIP IN 1846. HE ESTABLISHED A POLICY OF RULE AND A SYSTEM OF POLITICS THAT PREVAILED UNTIL THE END OF THE RANA ERA IN 1951.

HIS RULES OF SUCCESSION, WHERE THE PRIME-MINISTERSHIP PASSED TO THE ELDEST BROTHER, RATHER THAN TO THE ELDEST SON, KEPT THE LEADERSHIP IN MATURE HANDS, AND EXPLAINS THE LONG PERIOD OF RULE BY THE RANA FAMILY.



STAMPLESS COVER DATED 1875, FROM KATHMANDU TO JAJAKOT, NEPAL. SENT BY JUNG BAHADUR, FIRST RANA PRIME-MINISTER, 1846-1877. SEAL IS THAT OF COMMANDER-IN-CHIEF, A TITLE OFTEN HELD BY THE PRIME MINISTER.



STAMPLESS COVER DATED 1876 WITH SEAL OF BIR SHUMSHER JUNG BAHADUR RANA. ADDRESSED TO RANADIP SINGH, KATHMANDU, NEPAL.

BIR SHUMSHER ORGANIZED THE 1885 THAPATHALI COUP IN WHICH RANADIP SINGH, THE PRIME MINISTER, AND THE SONS OF JUNG BAHADUR, THE FIRST RANA PRIME MINISTER WERE KILLED. D. MURDERED

BIR SHUMSHER WAS PRIME MINISTER OF NEPAL FROM 1885 TO 1901.

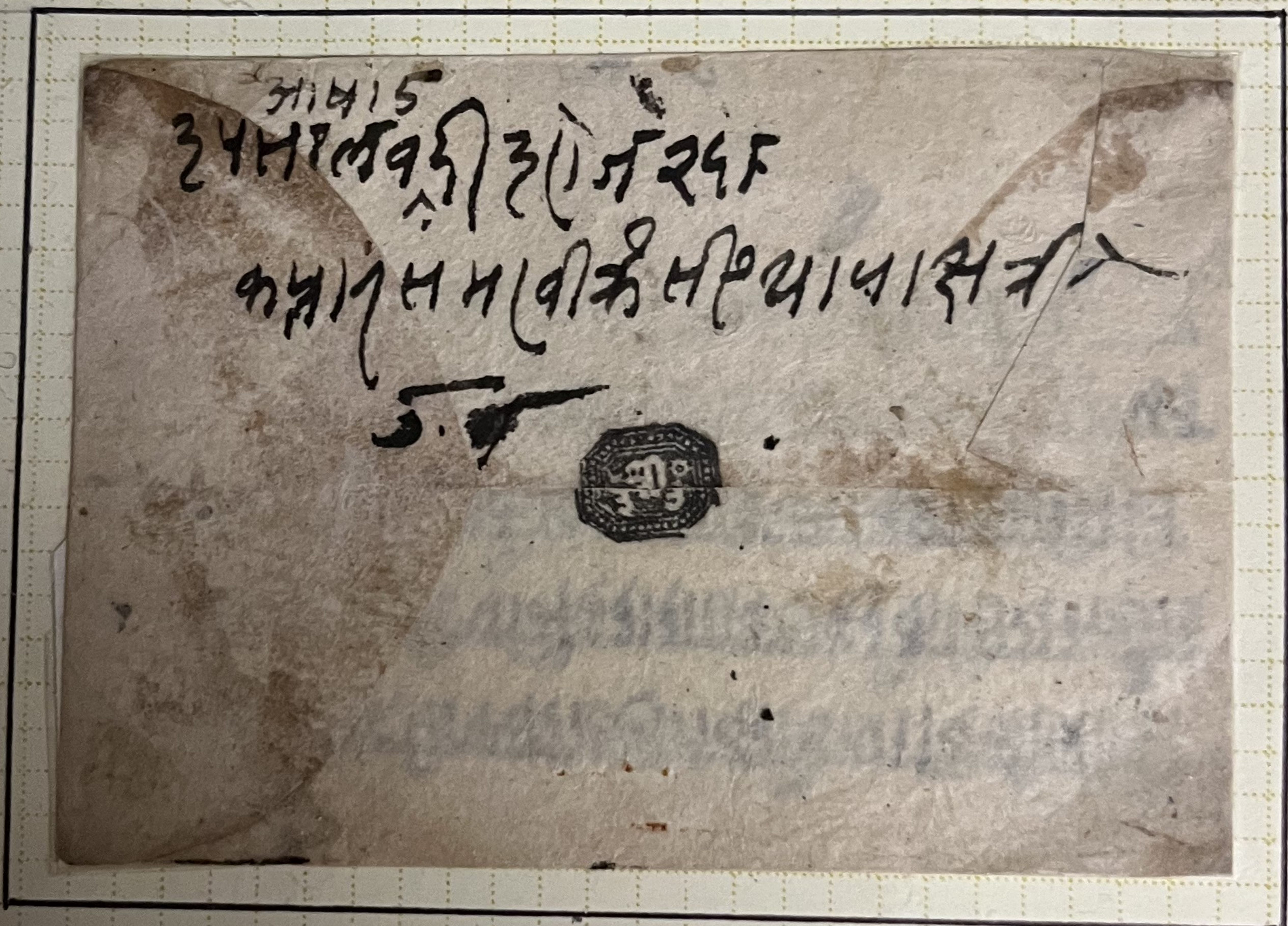
OFFICIAL STAMPLESS COVER DATED 1878, AND ADDRESSED TO PRIME MINISTER RANADIP SINGH BAHADUR IN KATHMANDU.

SEAL IS THAT OF THE ACHHAMESE NATIVE RULER IN CENTRAL WESTERN NEPAL, DAL BAHADUR SHAH. HE WAS ONE OF SEVERAL NATIVE RULERS IN NEPAL WITH TITLE OF KING, BUT ONLY WITH THE POWER OF LANDLORD.

NEPAL INTRODUCED POSTMARKS EARLY IN 1879, ABOUT ONE YEAR AFTER THIS LETTER WAS DELIVERED.

COVER BEARING SEAL OF CAPTAIN SAMAR
BIKRAM THAPA, GOVERNOR OF DHANKUTA,
NEPAL.

ADDRESSED TO PRIME MINISTER RANODIP

PRIME MINISTER RANODIP SINGH THAPA
INTRODUCED THE FIRST POST OFFICES
IN NEPAL IN MAR. 1879. HE INTRODUCED
POSTAGE STAMPS IN NEPAL IN APR.
1881. THE EARLY "HULAK" SYSTEM
(POSTAL SERVICE) WAS AVAILABLE TO
THE GOVERNMENT ONLY DURING
THE PERIOD BEFORE 1879. IT WAS
KNOWN AS THE "KAGATI HULAK"
SYSTEM (PAPER POST) FOR RAPID
TRANSIT OF LETTERS AND ROYAL
ORDER DOCUMENTS CALLED "LAL
MOHAR".

CIRCULAR SEAL IS THAT OF A MAHARANI BINDUBASINI DEVI. ADDRESSED TO PRIME MINISTER RANADIP SINGH. THE TITLE "MAHARANI" WAS USED BY THE WIVES OF THE RANA FAMILY PRIME MINISTERS.

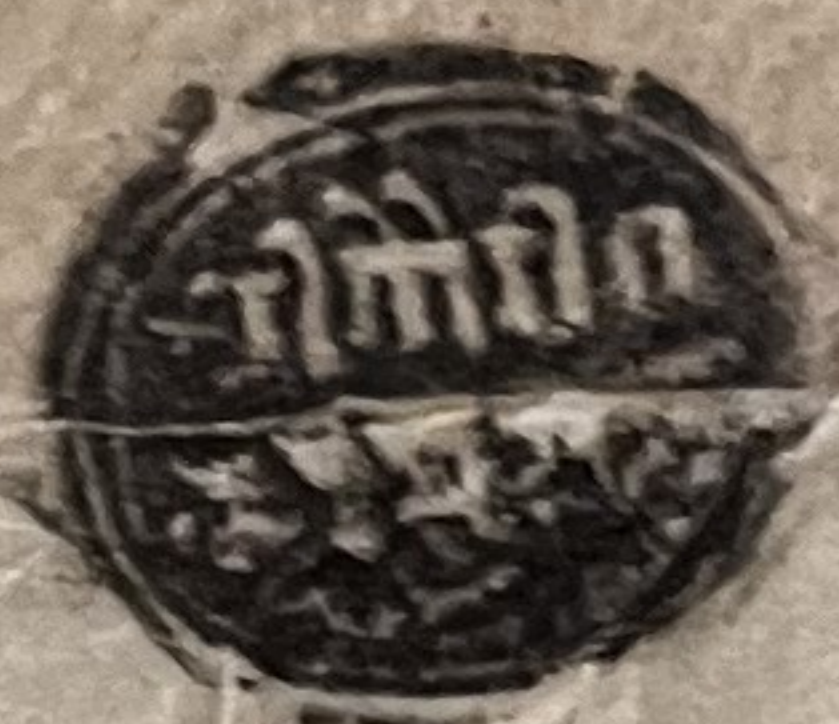

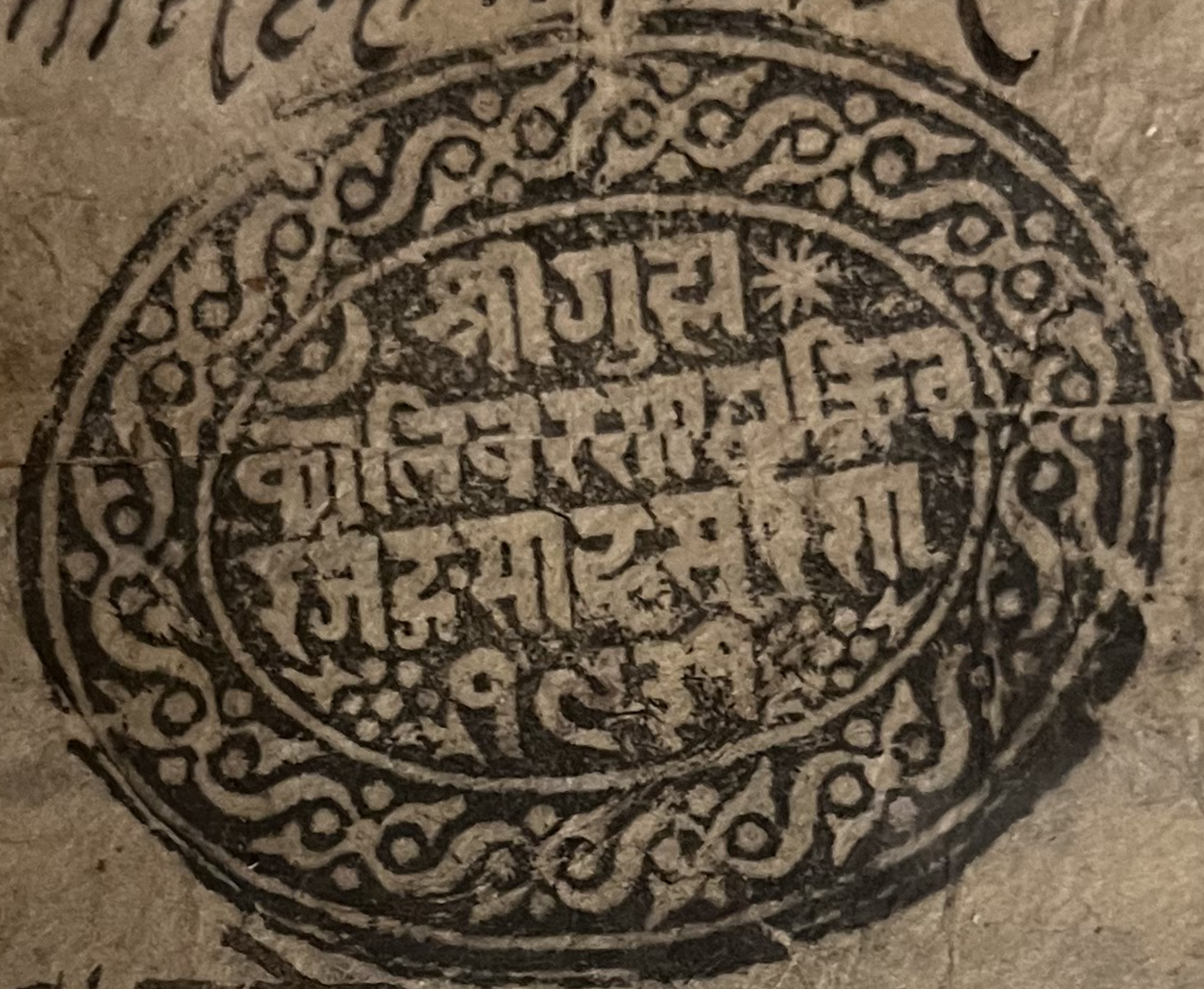

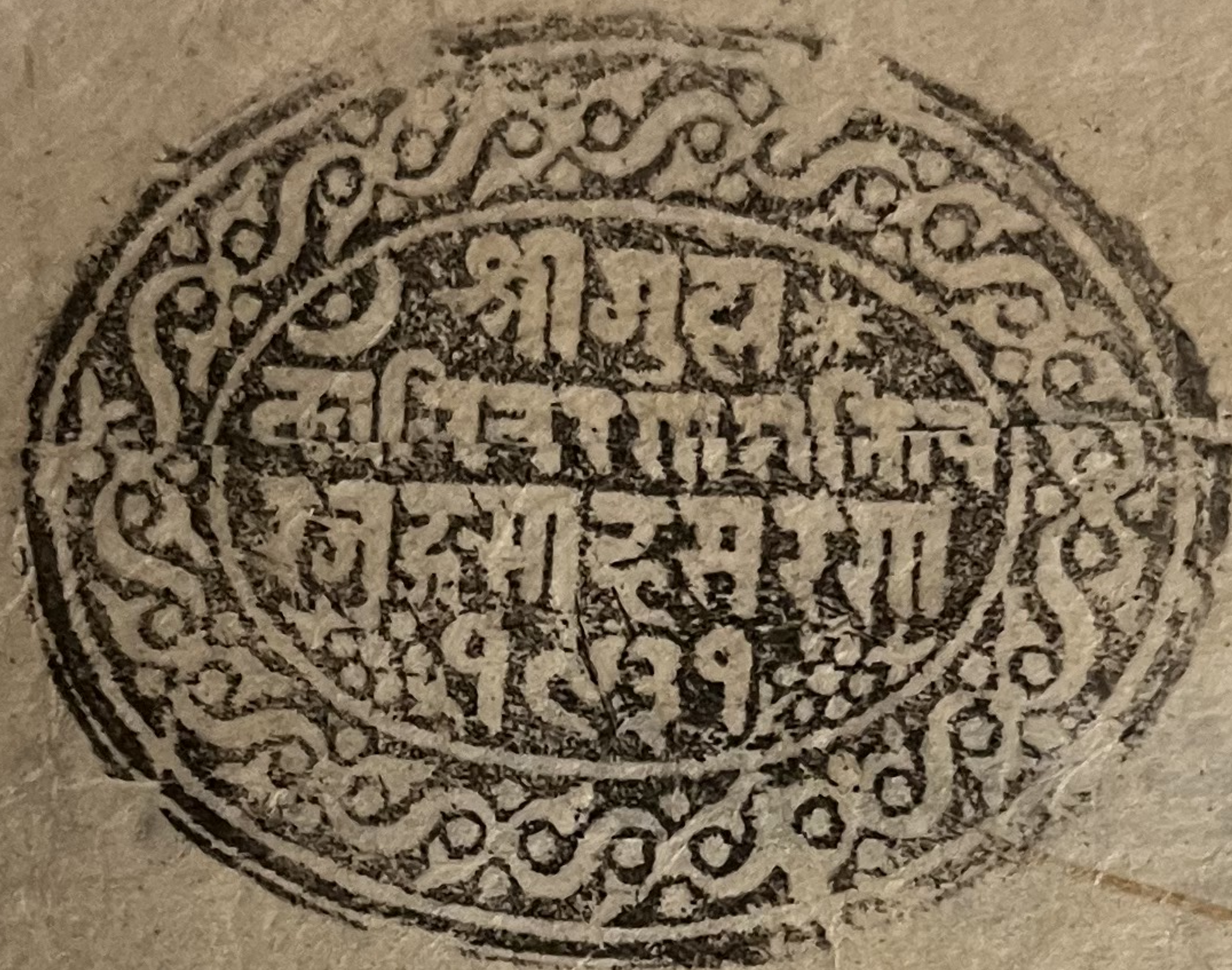
