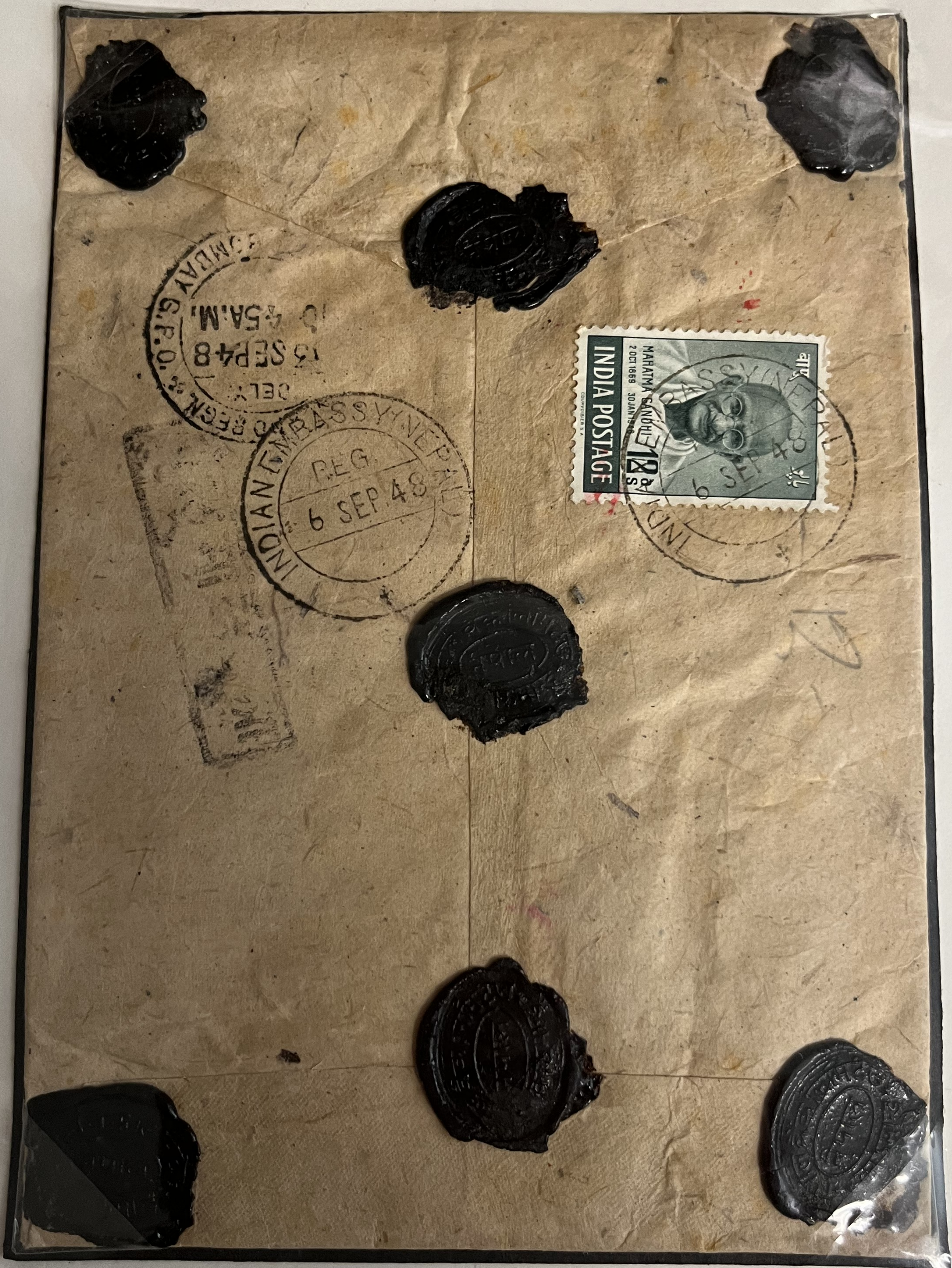

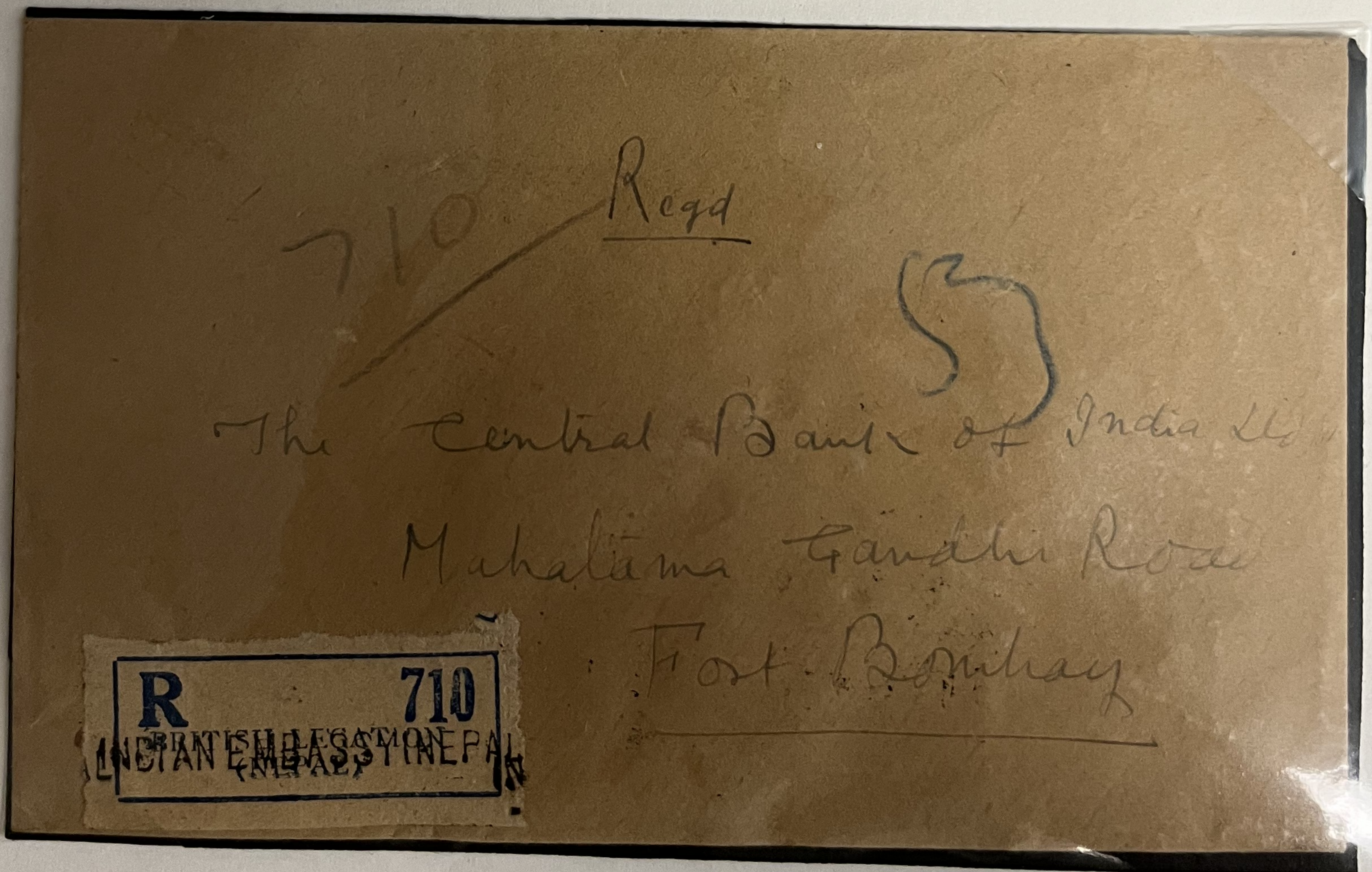

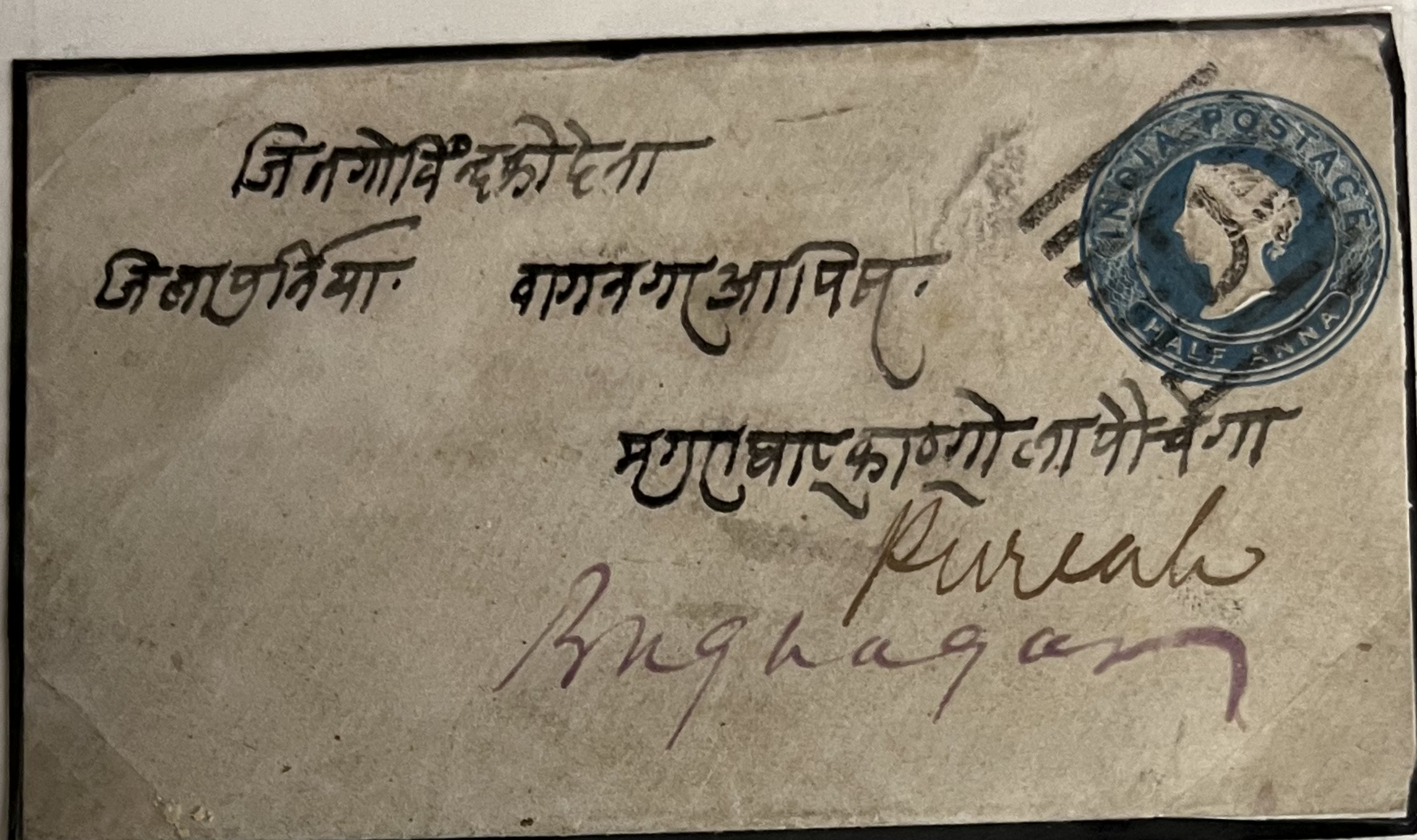

BRITISH RESIDENCY



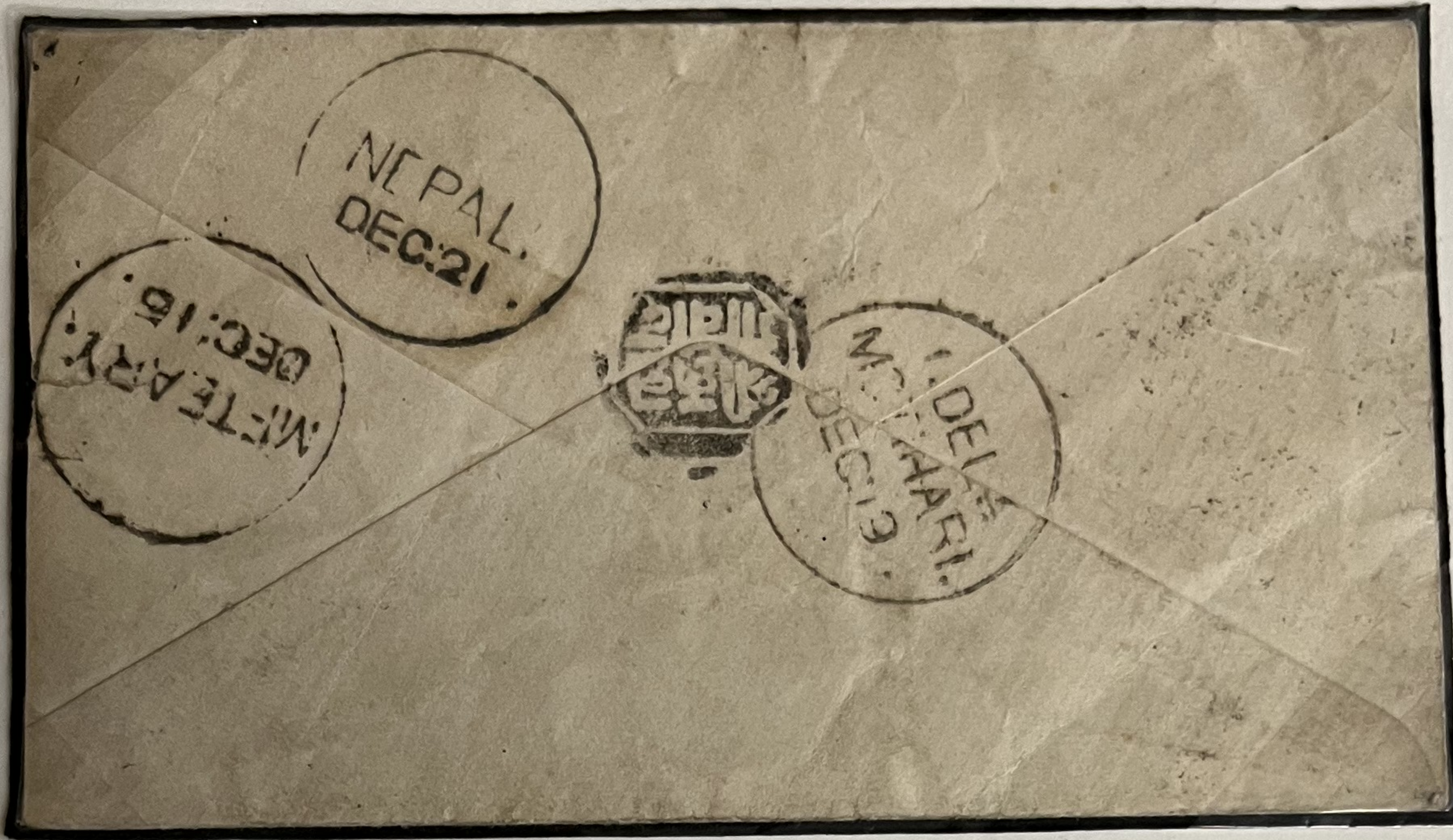
In October 1877 the Indian Post Office was transferred from the control of the Bengal Circle to the newly founded Bihar Circle. Two years later all the P.O.'s in this Circle were issued with a "D" in bars cancellor. The origin of a cover can only be determined by the backstamps or return address, as illustrated by the above cover which is from Nepal. Also during this period Indian datestamps bore no year, which makes dating difficult.

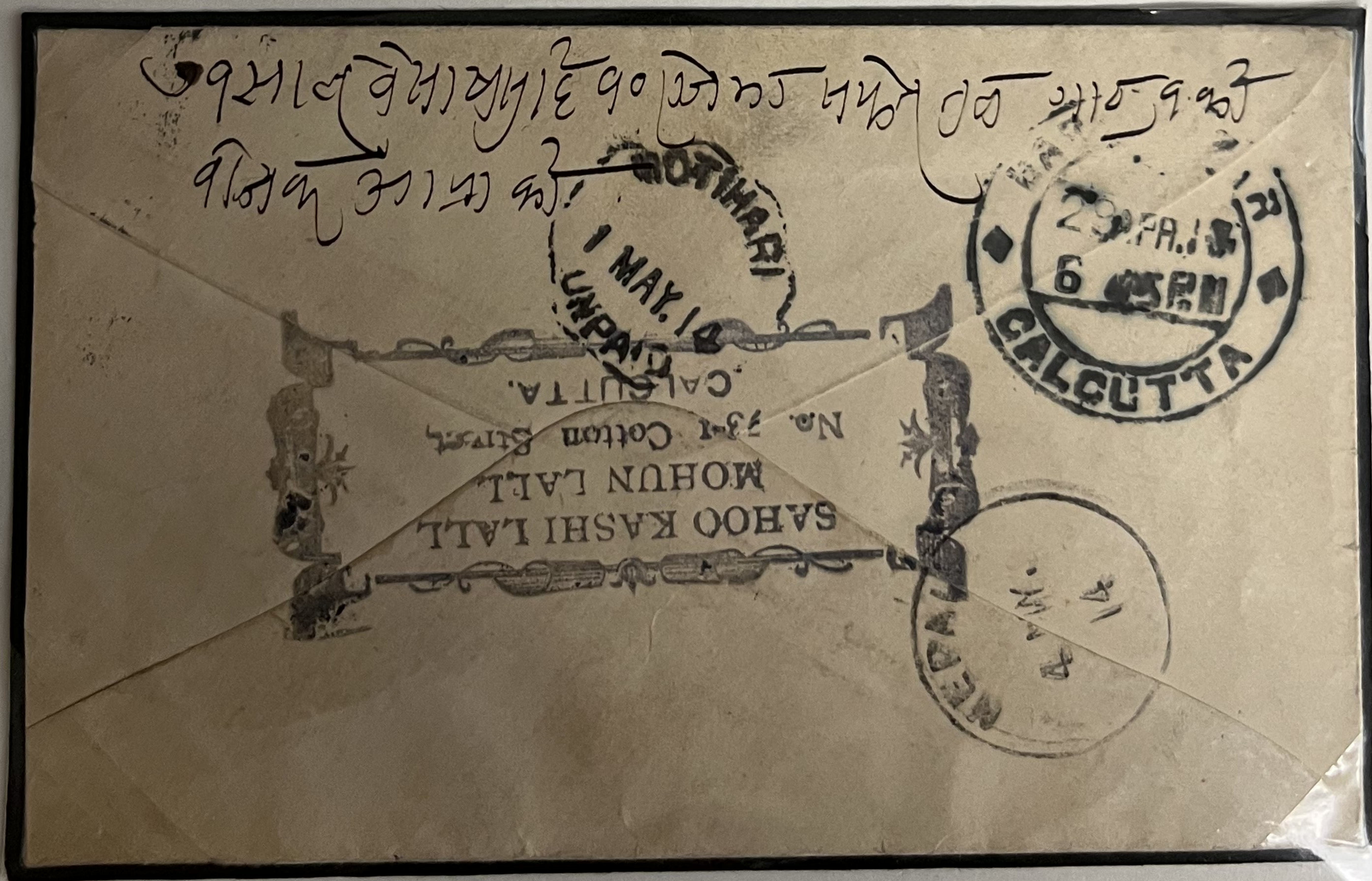

Unpaid cover from Calcutta to Patan (a town near Kathmandu) with the datestamp of the Indian Post Office used as an arrival mark. The cover would have been passed to the Native Nepalese Post Office for delivery.

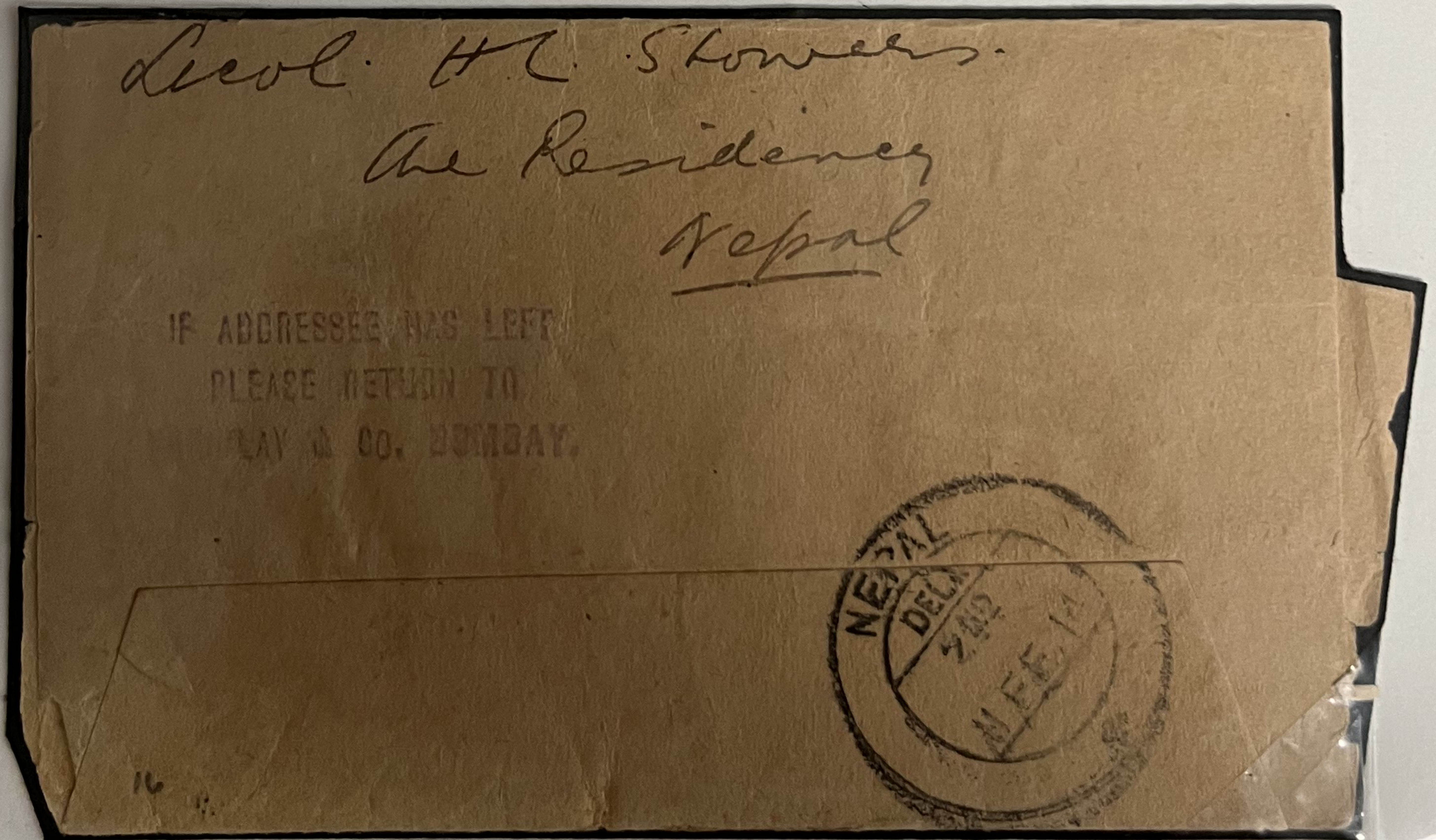
As a result of the Treaty of 1934 the Residency became a Legation under the Foreign Office in London. The delay in the change of cancellation was probably due to the fact that it took the Indian Postal Administration a long time to realise that there had been a change.

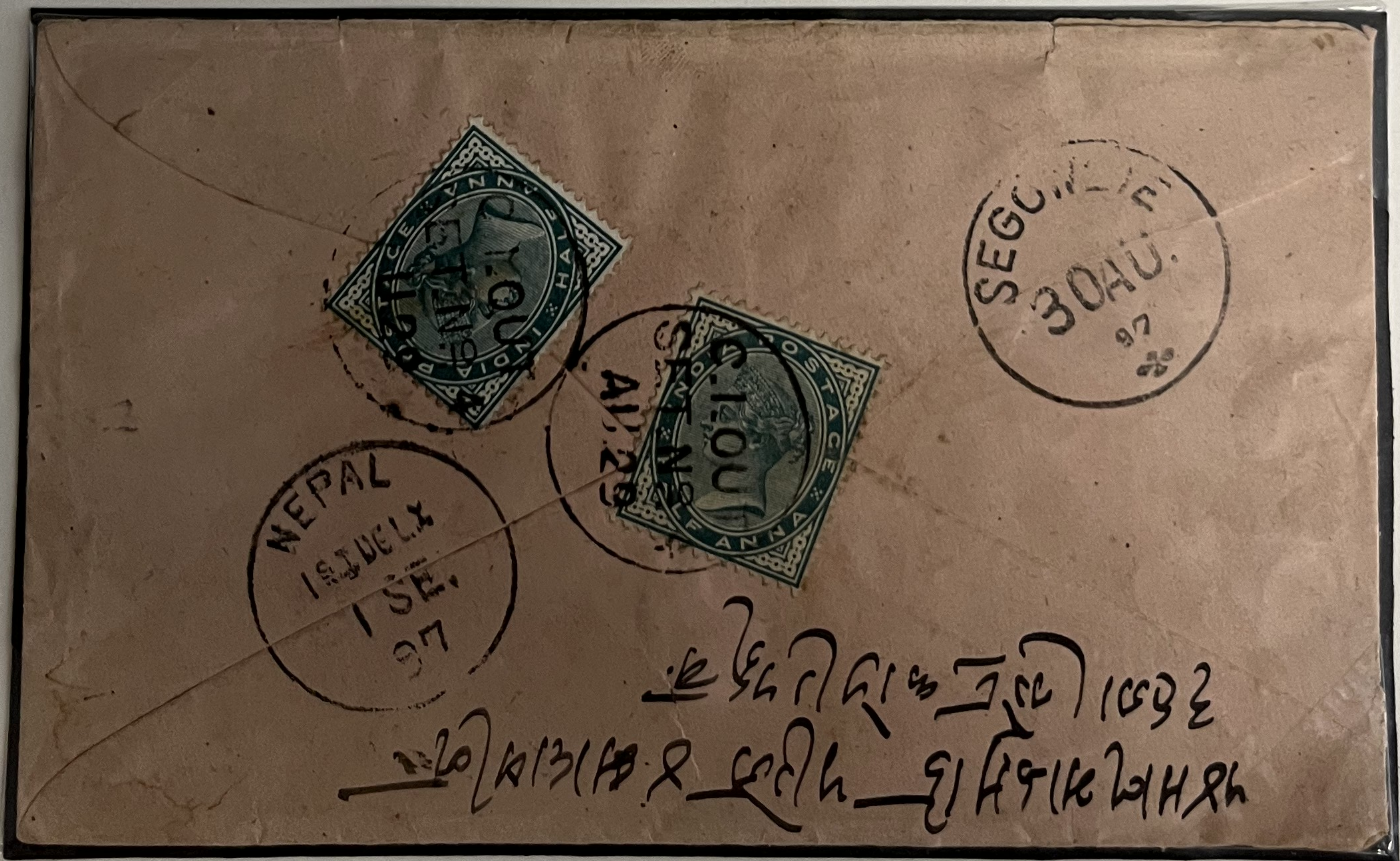
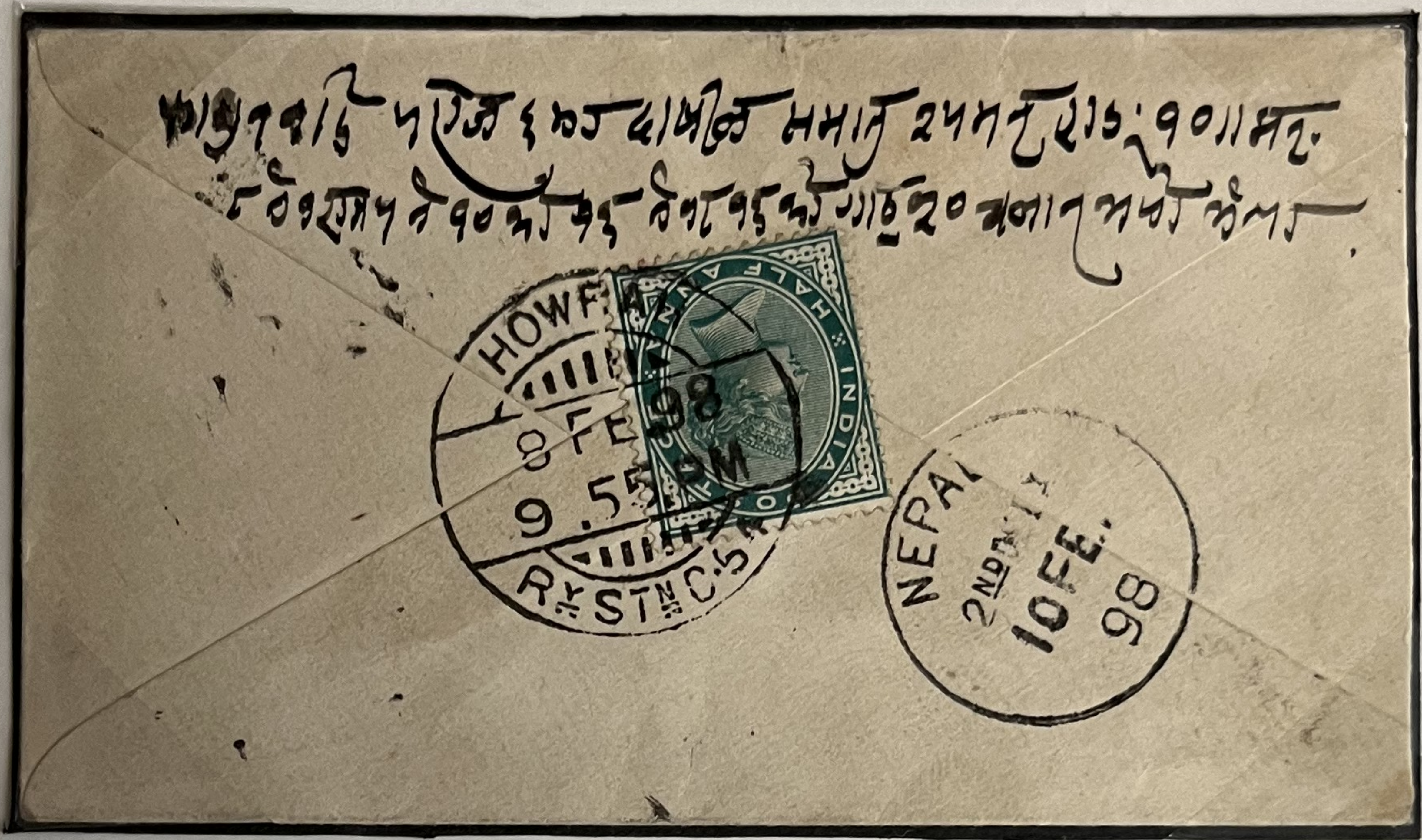

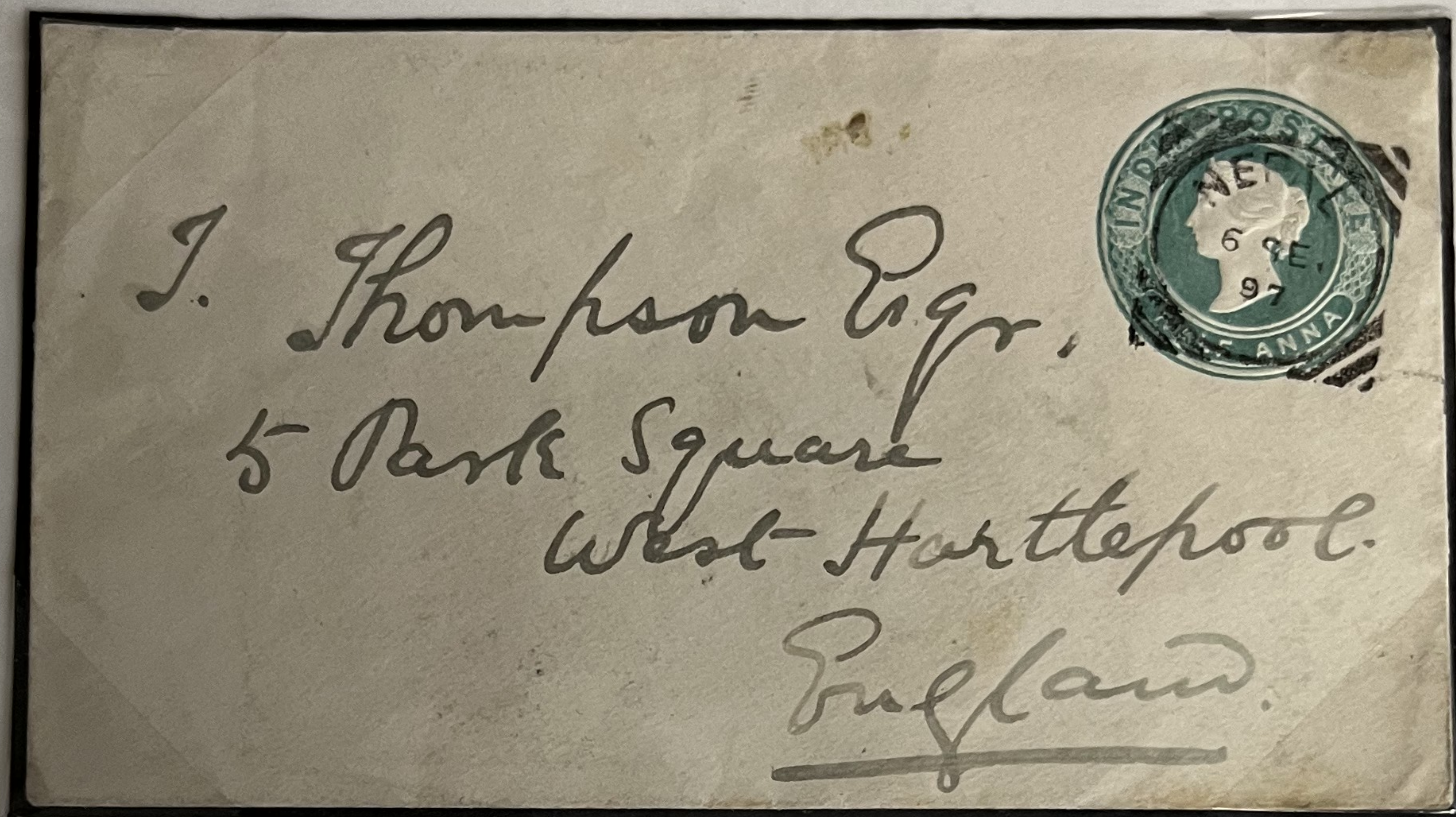

BRITISH RESIDENCY



The standard type Indian "squared circle" postmark has been recorded used in Nepal between 1895 and 1905.

This cover has two one anna stamps on the reverse to make up the U.K. rate of $2\frac{1}{2}$ annas. It travelled via Segowlie, 8 September 1897, the Bombay to Aden Sea Post Office, 10 September, to arrive in West Hartlepool on 28 September 1897 - 22 days in transit.

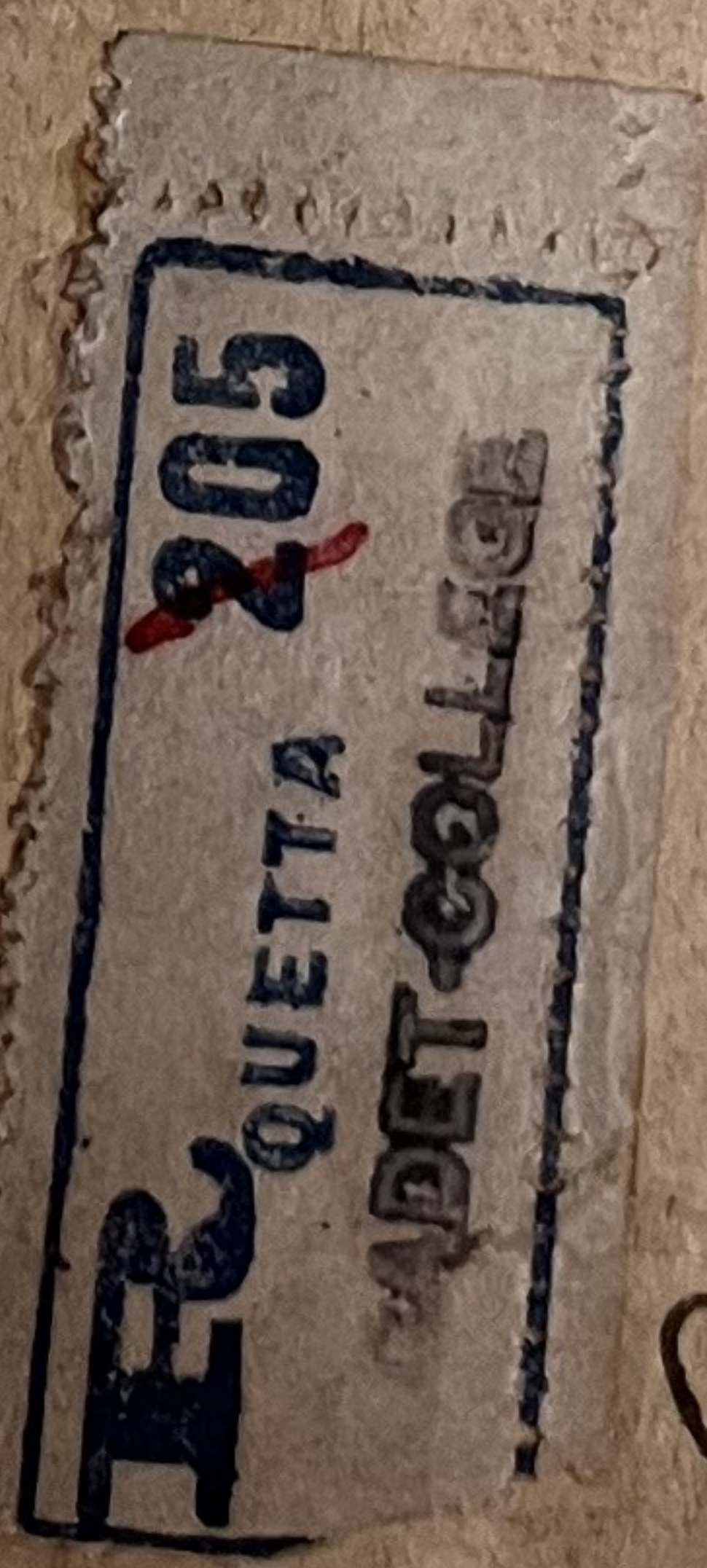

REGISTERED AND POSTMARKED CADET COLLEGE, QUETTA, WEST PAKISTAN. FROM S. SINGH OF THE 1/4th GURKHAS. QUETTA WHICH CAME UNDER BRITISH CONTROL IN 1876, COMMANDER MOUNTAIN PASSES INTO AFGHANISTAN.
