HAWAIIAN SHIPPING ARTICLES.

WE, whose names are hereunto affixed, do hereby agree and bind ourselves to serve in the capacity set opposite our respective names, on board the Haw. Bark. called the Thos. R. Foster, of Honolulu whereof F. W. Rugg is at present Master, now lying in the port of Honolulu and bound to Pit Townsend W. I. to load at Pot or Vote on Puget Sound and back to Honolulu months, or until the said Bark Thos. R. Foster shall return to these Hawaiian Islands, provided that takes place before the expiration of said term of (6) Six months. And we further agree that during said voyage we will perform our duty faithfully, whether on board said Bark Thos. R. Foster or in her boats, whether by night or day, as good and obedient seamen. It is also agreed by the Master of said Bark. Thos. R. Foster that at the end of the voyage, we shall each of us be paid the amount of compensation per month set opposite our respective names in the column marked "Wages." In witness of which agreement, the Master hath hereto first set his name. And we bind ourselves to be on board said vessel at or before the hour of 7 A. M on the 23rd day of May A. D. 1885.
