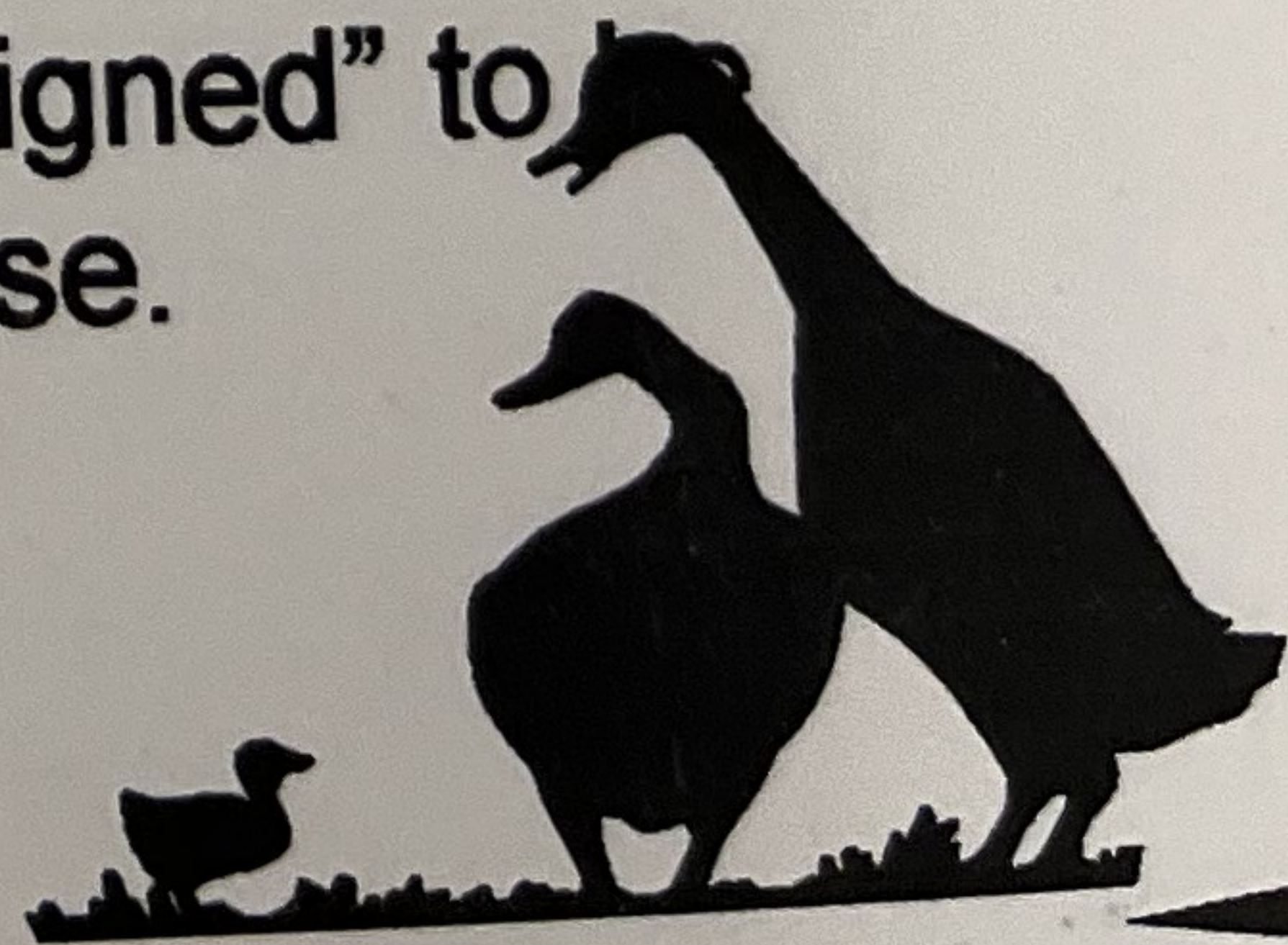

Jay Norwood "Ding" Darling . . "Ding" Darling Refuge was named after one of the pioneers of the conservation movement. "Ding" is a shortened version Jay Norwood Darling used for his signature. This is how he signed his political cartoons for which he received a Pulitzer Prize in 1923 and 1942.

Mr. Darling headed the U.S. Biological Survey (forerunner of the Fish & Wildlife Service) under Franklin Roosevelt's administration. He is also credited as one of the key people in the establishment of the National Wildlife System.

One of Mr. Darling's most important contributions to wildlife was the initiation in 1934, of the Migratory Bird Hunting Stamp or "Duck Stamp Program." He designed the first stamp and every year since, a new stamp has been issued. The proceeds from the sale of these stamps have purchased wetlands for 186 National Wildlife Refuges.

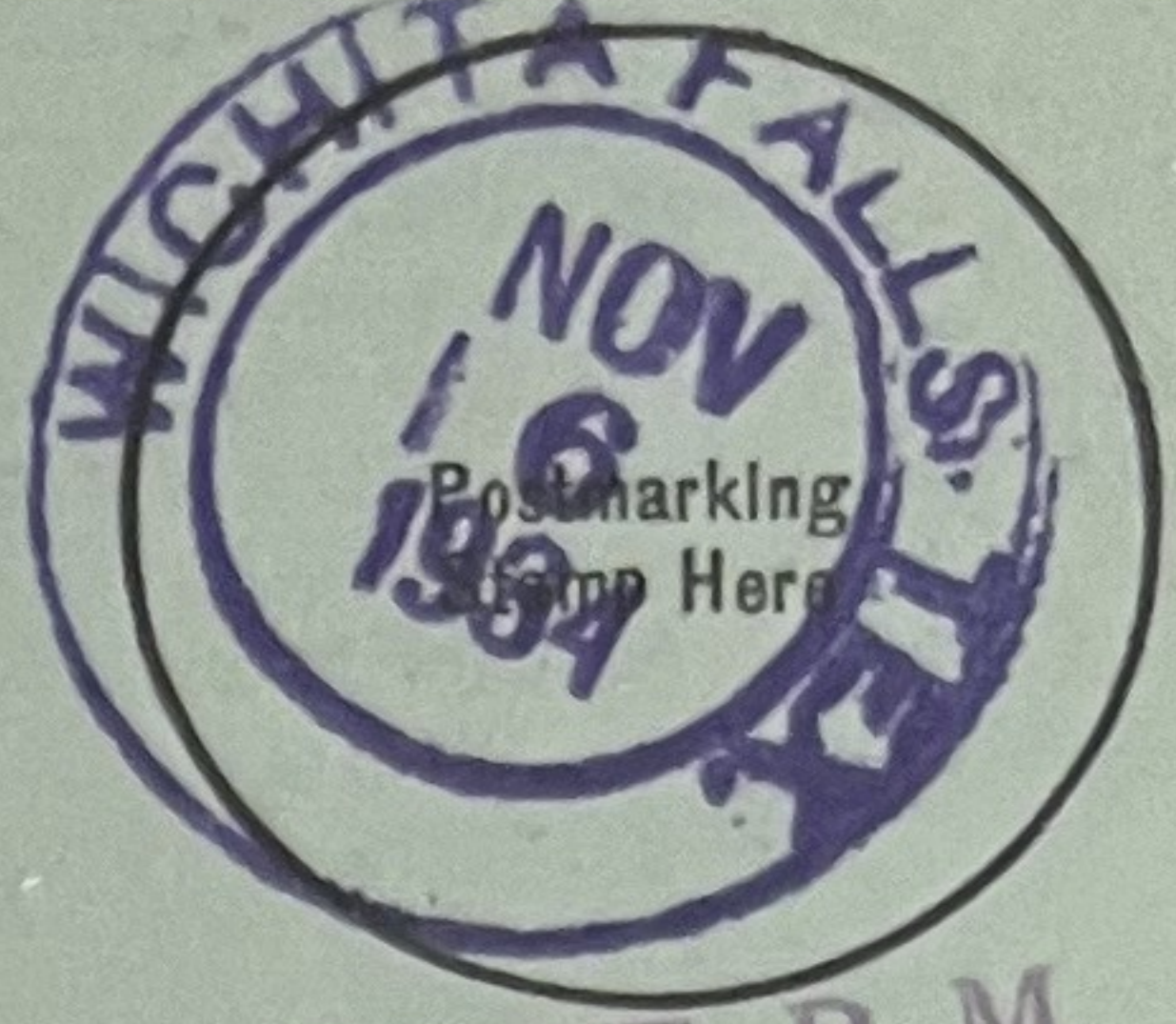
Under the Duck Stamp Act, as it has come to be known, any waterfowl hunter 16 years of age or older must possess a valid Federal Migratory Bird Hunting Stamp, or Duck Stamp, while hunting. This is in addition to a valid State Hunting License. The stamp has be "signed" to be legal. It should be attached to the State Hunting License.

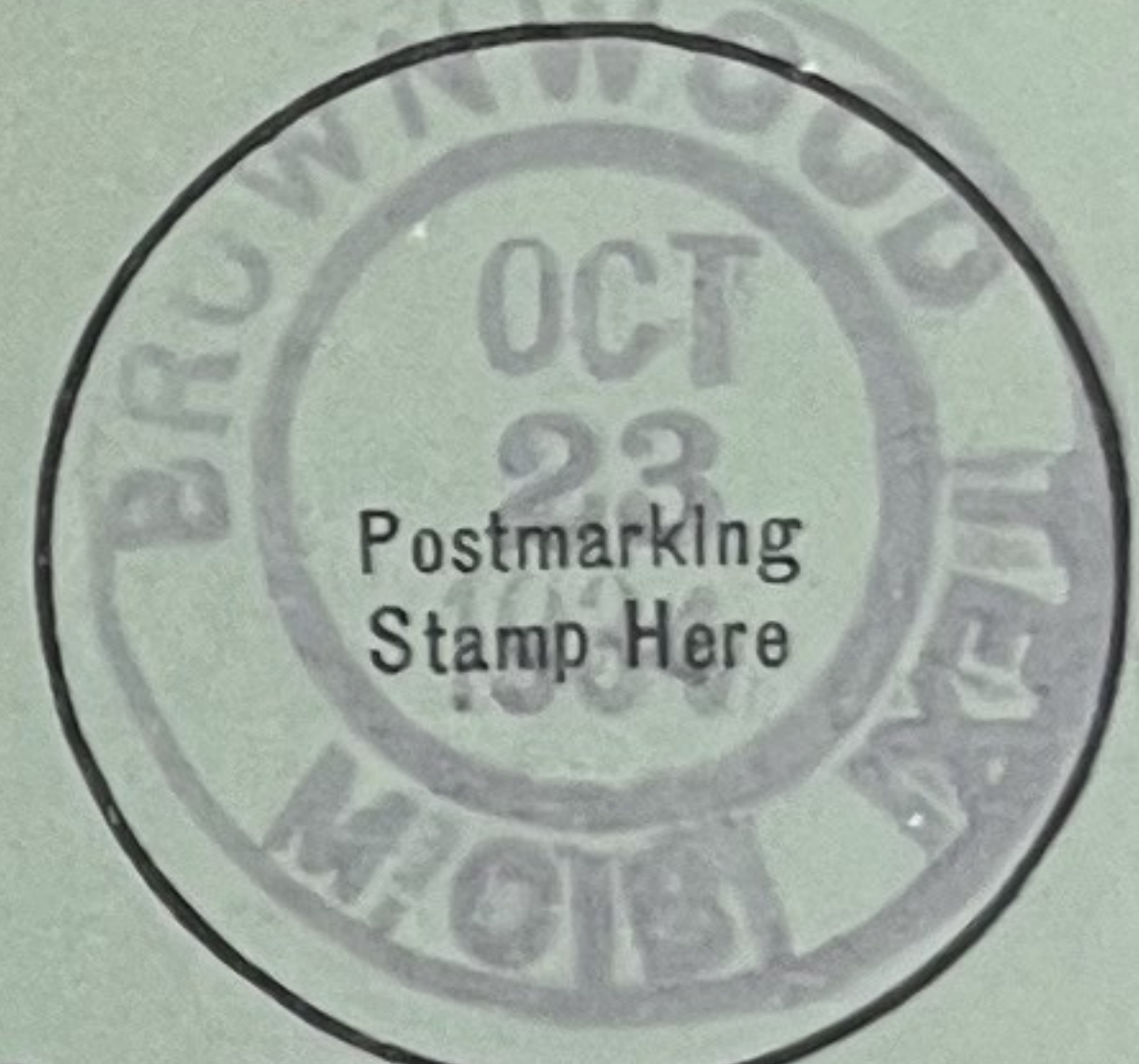

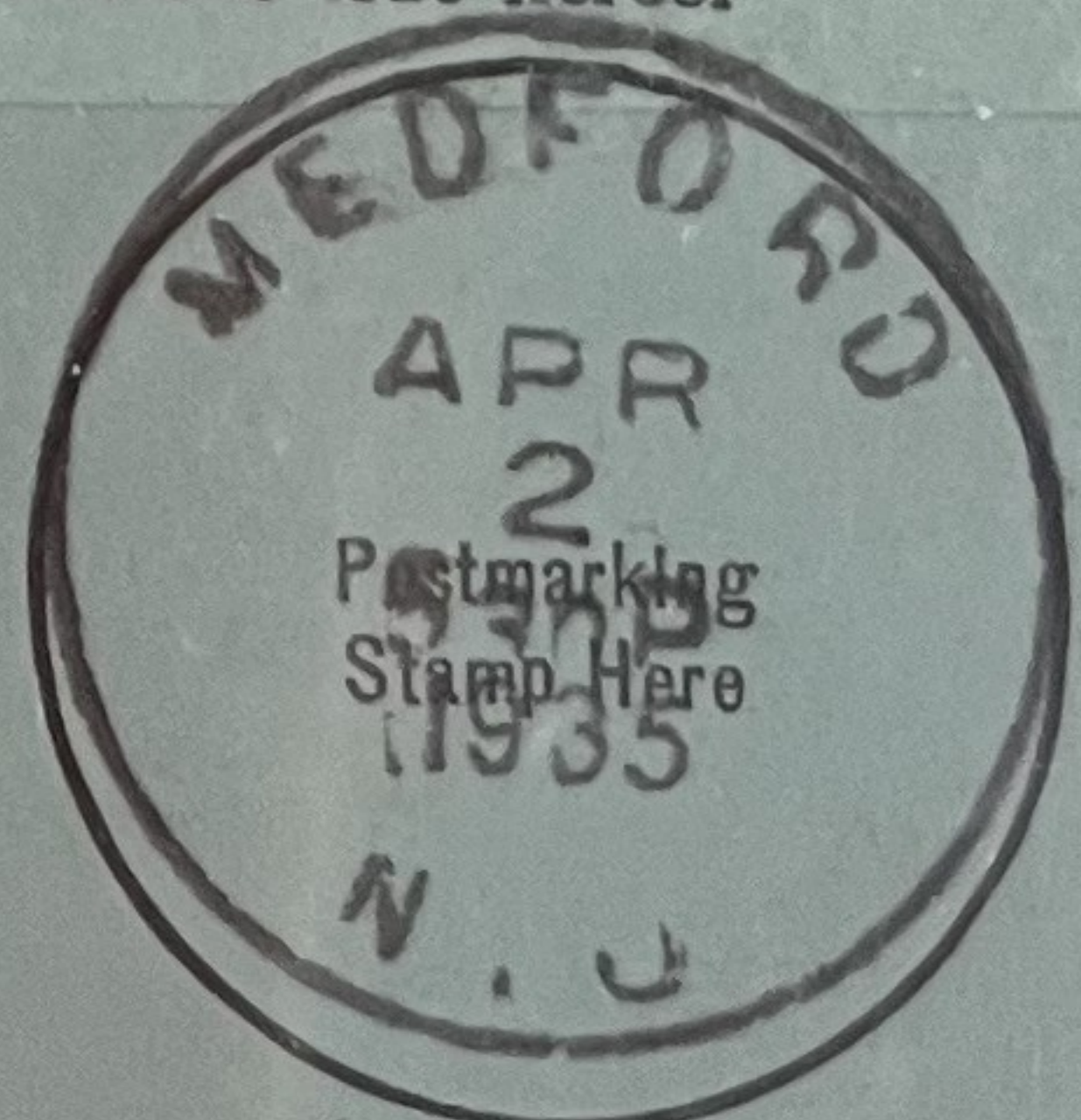

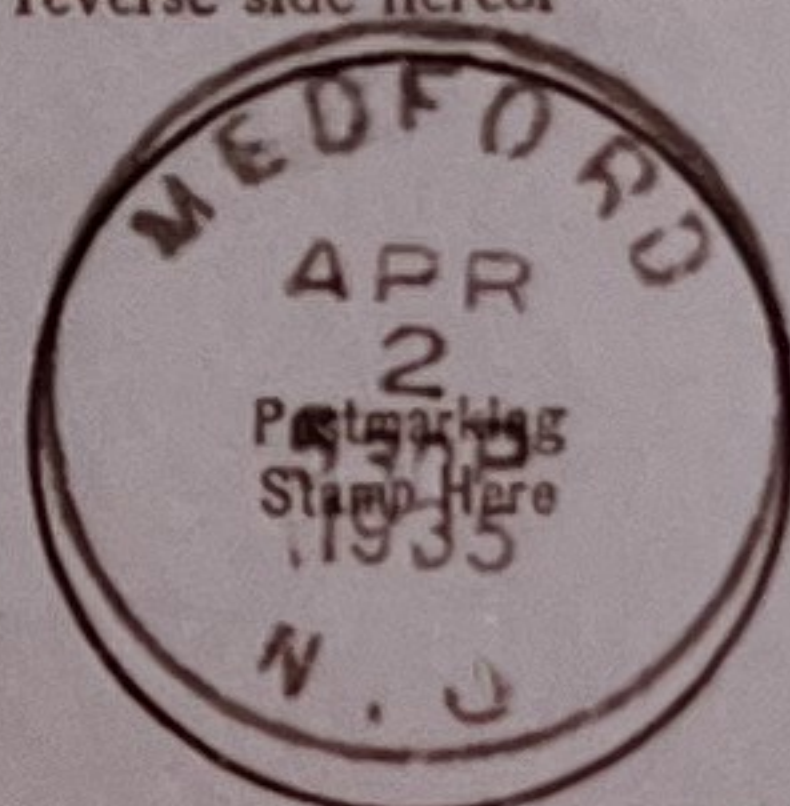

SYNOPSIS OF MONTANA FISH AND BIRD LAWS

(See Game Laws for Complete Details)

All persons of the age of fifteen and over who desire to fish or hunt in the State of Montana, must be in possession of the proper license therefor, and all persons hunting big game, regardless of age, must be in possession of proper licenses. No exceptions.

It is unlawful to shoot at or kill game animals or game birds from an automobile or from or on any public highway.

It is unlawful to hunt or shoot, drive or flush any game birds, game animals or fur-bearing animals from an airplane.

SHIPMENTS OF GAME. All shipments of game animals, game or non-game birds, fish, fur-bearing animals, or the skins of fur-bearing animals, or parts thereof, shipped out of the State, must be accompanied by a shipping permit furnished by the State Game Warden, the cost of which is 50c. All such shipments, including the skins of predatory animals, must show in plain writing on the outside of the package, its complete contents.

GAME FISH shall be taken only by angling; that is, by hook and line in hand or rod in hand.

It is unlawful for any person to catch more than 25 fish in the aggregate, with a net weight of 20 pounds and one (1) additional fish, in any one day, of the variety of fish designated as game fish, or more than 5 fish which are less than 7 inches in length, excepting Sunfish, Yellow Perch, and Ring Perch in any one day. No person shall be in possession of more than 25 fish in the aggregate or more than 20 pounds net weight and one (1) additional fish of any and all kinds of game fish at any time, whether fresh, dried or cured.

It is unlawful to fish in Georgetown Lake between the hours of 9:30 o'clock P. M. and 5:00 o'clock A.M. of the following day.

It is unlawful to catch or attempt to catch in the public waters of this State any fish whatsoever, between the 15th day of March and the 20th day of May, both dates inclusive, except in the Missouri, Yellowstone and Kootenai Rivers. The Commission may change or suspend the closed season.

It is unlawful to catch any game fish through the ice or through a hole in the ice, except in such waters as are designated under proper order of the State Fish and Game Commission.

OPEN SEASON FOR GROUSE.—Sharptailed grouse, blue grouse, ruffed grouse, commonly called pheasant or partridge, prairie chicken, sage hen, sage grouse or fool hen, September 16th to September 25th, both dates inclusive. Dates subject to change by State Fish and Game Commission. **LIMIT,** not more than five (5) in the aggregate of all kinds in any one day or in possession at any one time. Closed season may be declared by Commission.

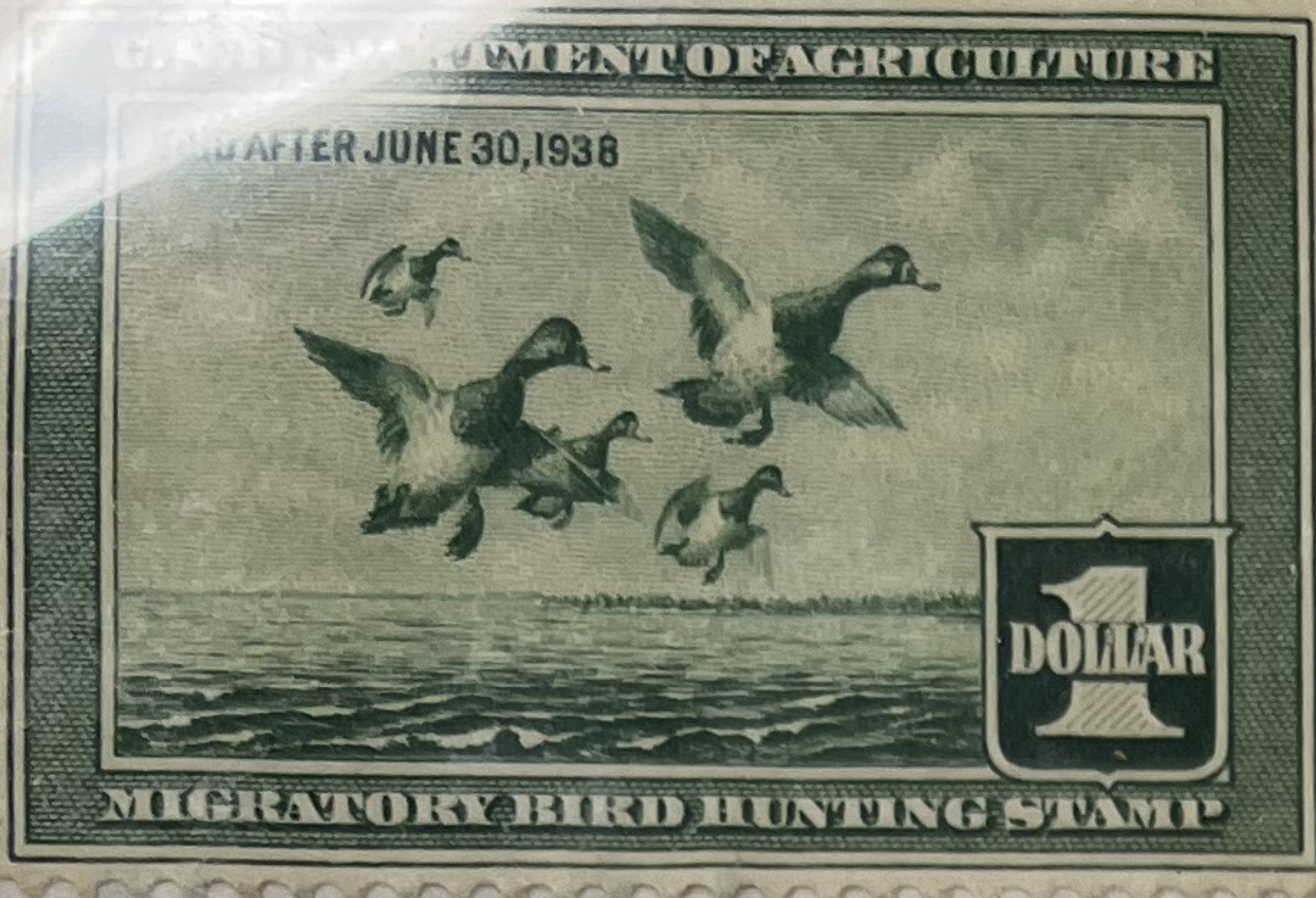

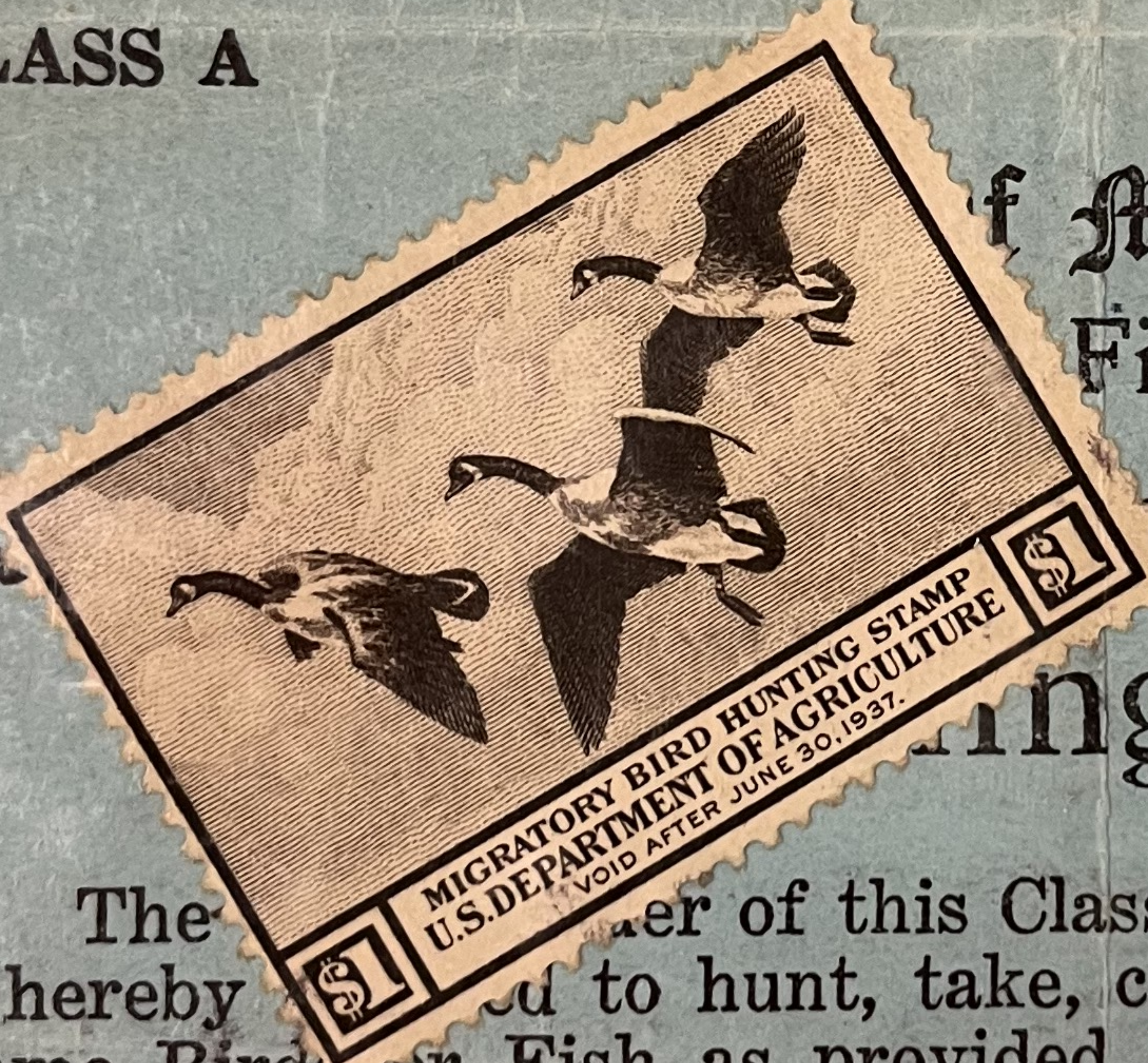

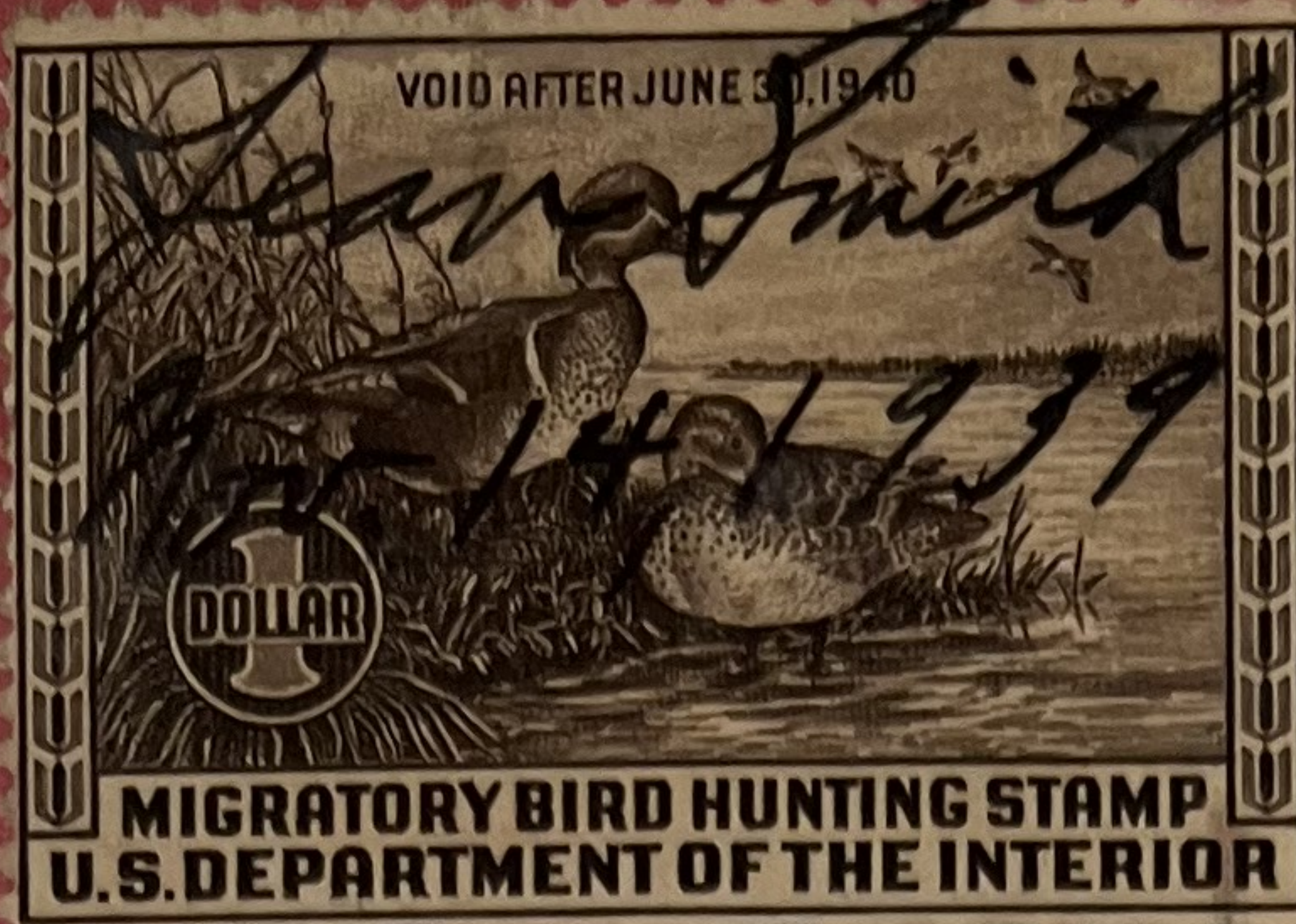

SEASON

Special county laws governing open seasons have become so numerous that there is not sufficient space for the reprint of same hereon. You may secure a digest of the laws from the Game Commission.

BAG LIMIT

BEAR, 1 a season. DEER, black tail or mule deer, 1 a season west of Pecos River; white tail, 2 a season, except in counties where season is closed. Two in the aggregate of both kinds. Must have three prongs or more. DOVES, 15 a day and not more than 15 in possession. DUCKS, 10 a day and not possess more than 10 at any one time. GEESE and BRANDT, 5 a day and not more than 5 in possession. PRAIRIE CHICKEN or PINNATED GROUSE, no open season. QUAIL and CHACHALACAS, 12 a day and not more than 36 a week. SQUIRRELS, 10 a day and not more than 20 in possession (consult law book for special county limits.) TURKEY GOBBLERS, 3 in one season.

Before hunting for migratory fowl on this license you must have a Federal stamp for this privilege. Such stamp can be procured from your local Post Office.

Persons convicted of violating the Game Laws shall forfeit their right to hunt with a gun in this State for a period of 12 months following date of conviction.

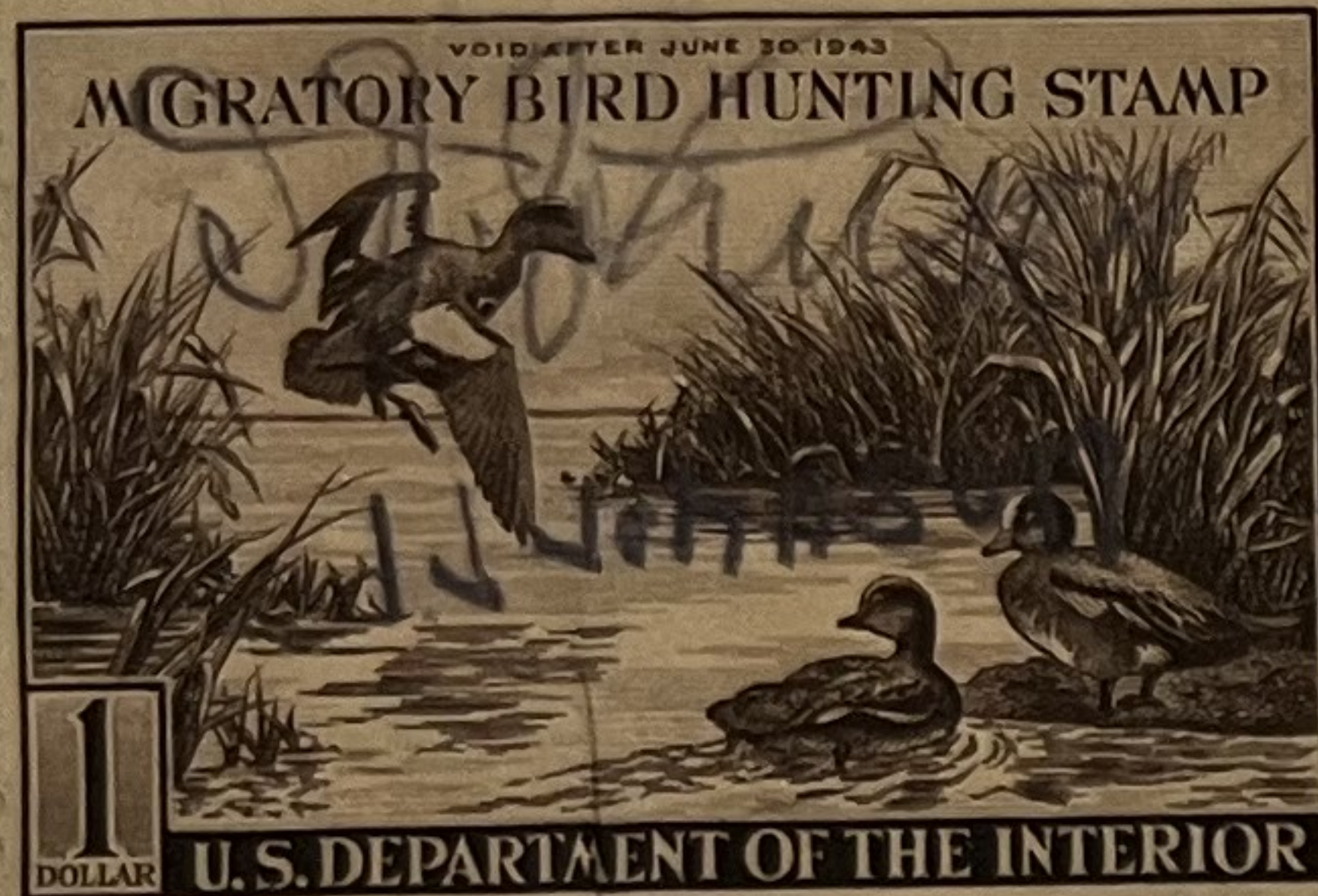

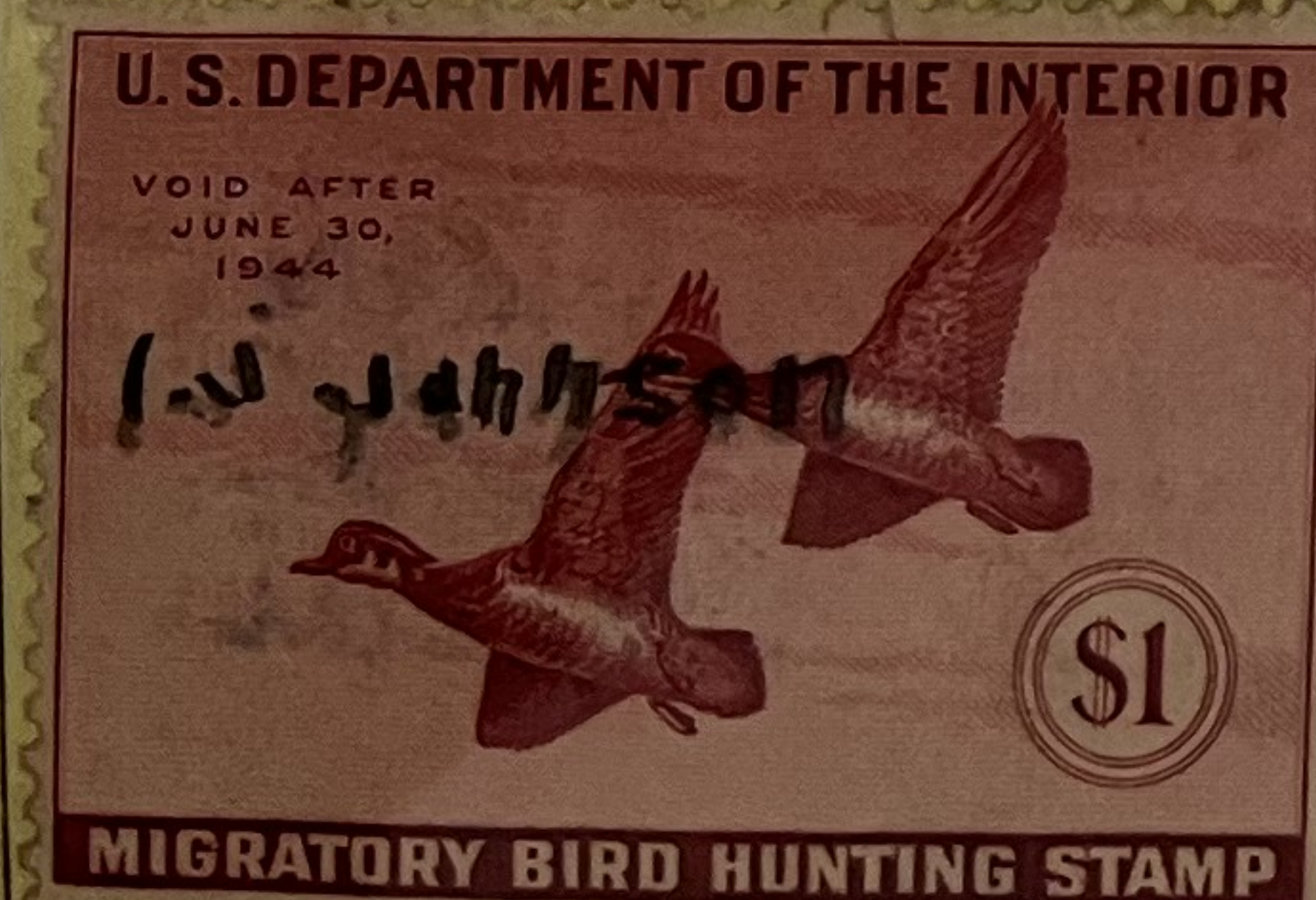

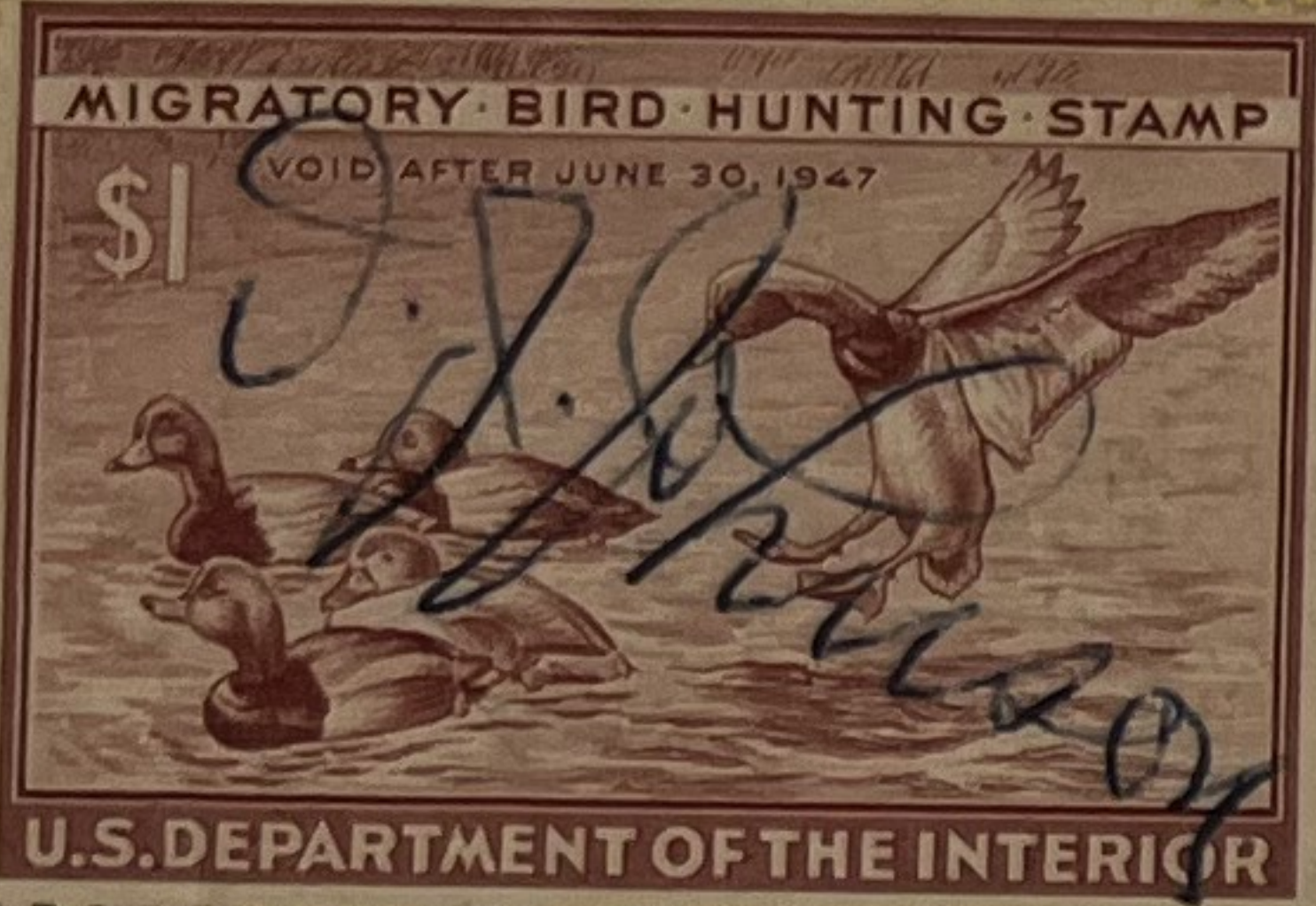

MIGRATORY GAME BIRDS

Federal regulations control bag limit and open season in respect to migratory birds. Such birds are waterfowl, cranes, rails, wild doves, and shore birds; of all species.

GROSBEC—(Night Heron). It is against Federal and State Laws to kill grosbecks or any other kind of herons or cranes at any time.

PARTIAL SUMMARY OF LOUISIANA GAME LAWS

RESIDENT GAME BIRDS

BOB WHITE (quail or partridge), 15 daily, 120 a season, open season December 1st to February 20th, possession limit 30.

WILD TURKEY—Gobblers (only) 1 per season, open season April 1st through April 15th inclusive.

OUTLAW BIRDS—May be killed at any time. Comorant (water turkey or nigger goose), turkey buzzard, black vulture (carrion crow), duck hawk, cooper and sharp-shinned hawks (blue darters), great horned owls, English sparrow, red-winged blackbird, and when destructive to crops, grackle (chock) and bobolink.

NON-GAME BIRDS

All birds not named as game birds or outlaws must not be killed, caught or kept in possession at any time, especially all song and insect-eating and other small birds.

PERMANENT CLOSED SEASON

THE CLOSED SEASON IS PERMANENT
On: Swan, Whooping and Sandhill Cranes, Kildeer, Prairie Chicken, ring-necked pheasant, upland plover or papabotte, black-bellied and golden plover, snipe, or any other shore birds (except woodcock), have no open season for hunting.

**Camp Hunting for Deer Restricted to Three (3)
No Hunting License Required for Mem**

GAME QUADRUPEDS

DEER—Bag limit on deer, (BUCKS ONLY), one daily, two a season, open season November 15th to January 1st. Unlawful to take faun or deer with horns less than three (3") inches long.

BEAR—One a day. Aggregate five (5) a season. Open season November 1st to January 1st.

SQUIRREL—10 daily, open season October 1st to January 15th.

CHIPMUNK—10 daily, open season October 1st to February 1st. (Squirrel and chipmunk 120 per season in the aggregate.)

RABBITS—No bag limit, may be sold in open season, October 1 to March 1.

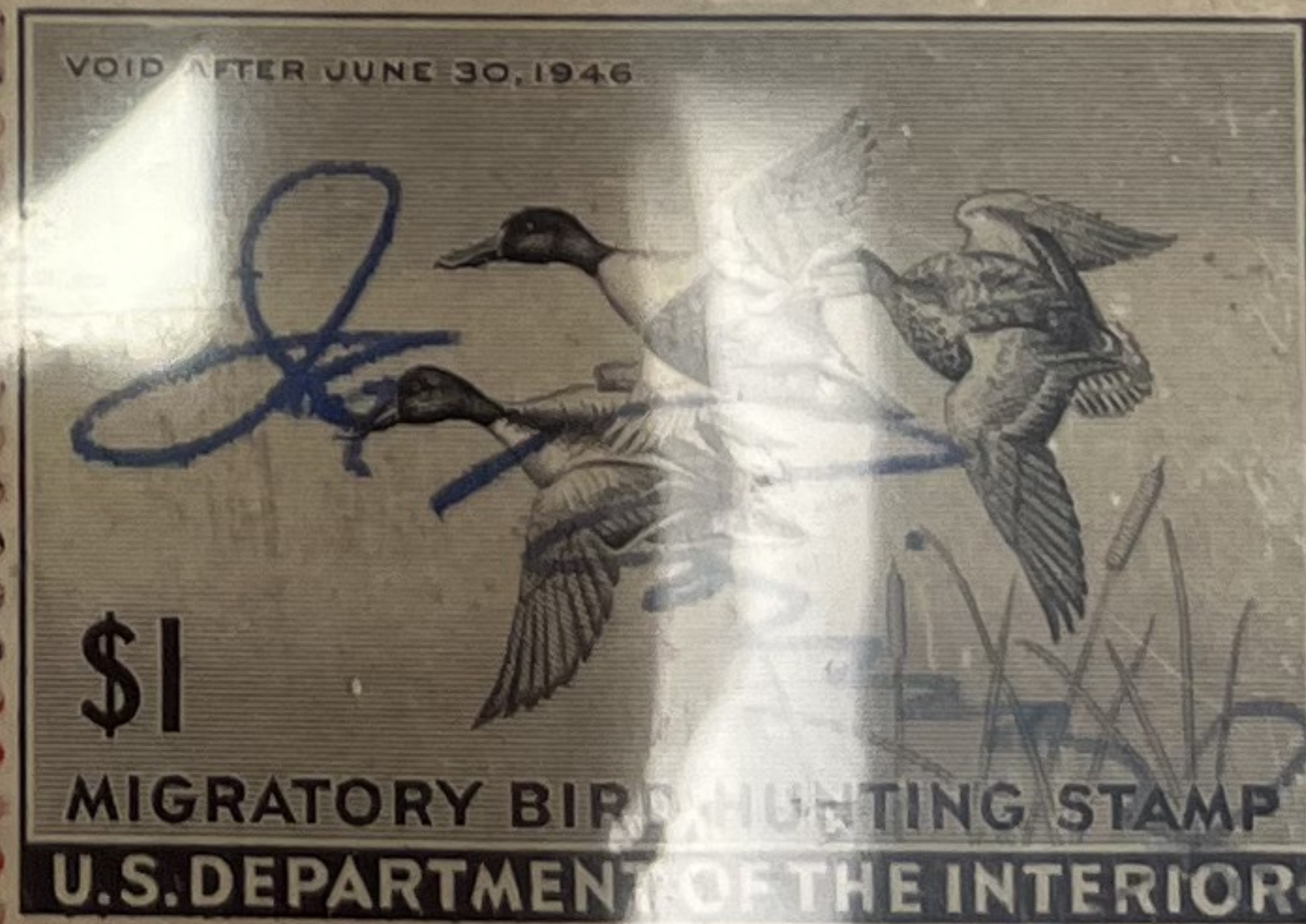
OUTLAW QUADRUPEDS

OUTLAW QUADRUPEDS—May be taken at any time. Includes wolves, wild cats (bob cats), panthers; and alligators found in the parishes of St. Tammany, St. Bernard, Plaquemines, Orleans, Jefferson, St. James, St. John, St. Charles, Lafourche, Terrebonne, St. Mary, Iberia, Vermilion, and Cameron but not alligators found elsewhere.

When RW 1 was put on sale at post offices in 1934, postmasters were required to affix the stamp to the hunter's state hunting license at the time of purchase. Any person desiring to purchase a Duck Stamp that year had to first fill out an application form (P.O. Form 3332) supplied by the postmaster before he could buy the Duck Stamp for \$1.00. The form indicated to the postmaster what he should do next because Section 2 of the Migratory Bird Hunting Stamp Act of 1934 states, "Each stamp shall, at the time of issuance, be affixed adhesively to the game license issued the applicant under state law, if the applicant is required to have a state license, or, if the applicant is not required to have a state license, to a certificate furnished for that purpose by the Post Office Department at the time of issuance of such stamp."

Persons who would not have been required to have a state license would have been those who were planning to hunt only within the boundaries of their own property in certain states, and those stamp collectors or conservationists who merely wished to purchase an example of the new stamp.

The light green certificate or card used for this purpose was Post Office Form 3333, the "Federal Migratory Bird Hunting Certificate and Stamp." Spaces were provided on the face of this form to affix the stamp and for the postal cancel.
