I have examined the cover mailed from Mexico City, 2nd May 1935, addressed to New York City, franked with two airmail stamps of Mexico: 40 cent., official, and 20 cent., Amelia Earhart commemorative issue. A photographic reproduction is attached to this certificate. In my opinion, this item - which was carried to Newark, N.Y. on Amelia Earhart's special flight - is genuine and the stamp is in perfect condition: I signed it "E. Diena". It was also franked with 3 cents and 15 cents U.S. stamps for postage to New York. It carries a signed statement by Miss Earhart. - - -
