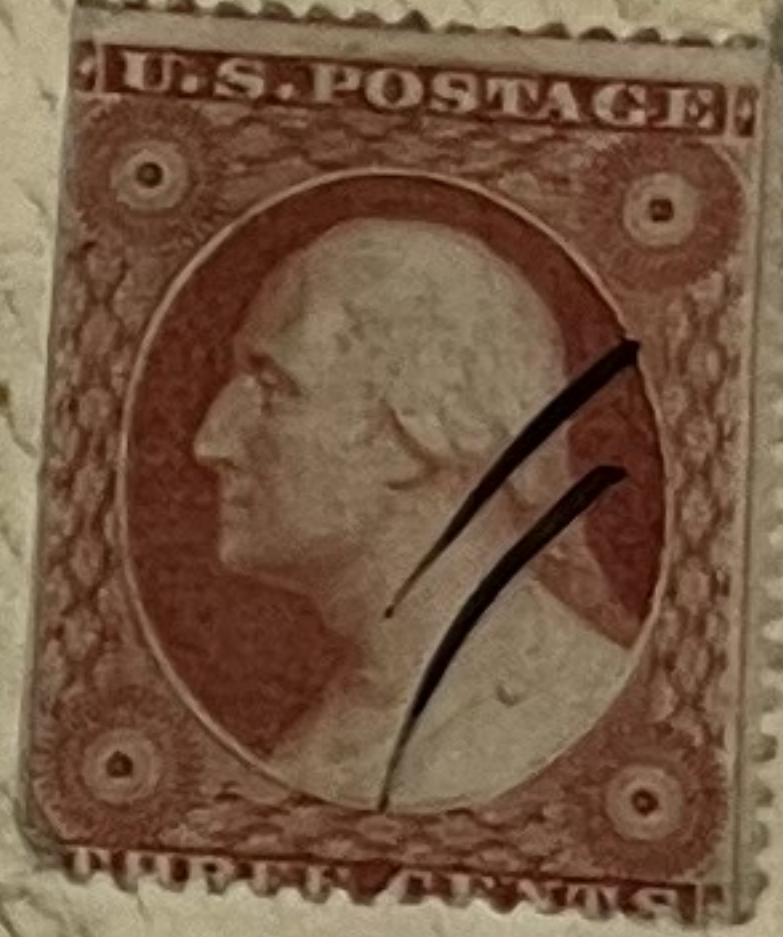
There's a Star in the skies that shall never go down,
